Only four images include a uniformed figure, a highly articulated background complete with architectural elements, drapery and other design elements: The Marlborough Family, Field Marshall HRH the Duke of Connaught and Strathearn and the two portraits of Sir Frank Swettenham. It is possible to also include Charles Stewart, Sixth Marquess of Londonderry Carrying the Great Sword of State at the Coronation of King Edward VII, August 1902, and Mr W.C. Beaumont, his Page on that Occasion due to the architectural elements and inclusion of stained glass. However, this background is not as texturally rich as the other four portraits.

Sargent's total number of portraits containing American men is eighty-eight meaning a little over $10 \%$ have such professional attire with only approximately $2 \%$ of his American male sitters dressed specifically in military uniforms.
