About the piece

‘Suite La Tirana’ is inspired in the main parts of the Feast of La Tirana: first movement recreates Andean sounds and the brass bands rehearsals before the celebration; second movement represents the welcoming songs of the faithful; third movement is a musical journey for the most characteristic dances performed at the square in La Tirana and fourth movement is a representation of the pilgrimage after the mass of the celebration day and the farewell songs of the dancers when they leave the village.

Performance notes

The piece includes the use of field recordings as a transition between the movements. The field recordings used have been attached to the score for future performances. In the third movement there is a collective solo for soprano saxophone and trombone from bar 110. The idea is that each instrument improvises four bars each increasing the dynamics until reaching a climax where they have to play simultaneously.
