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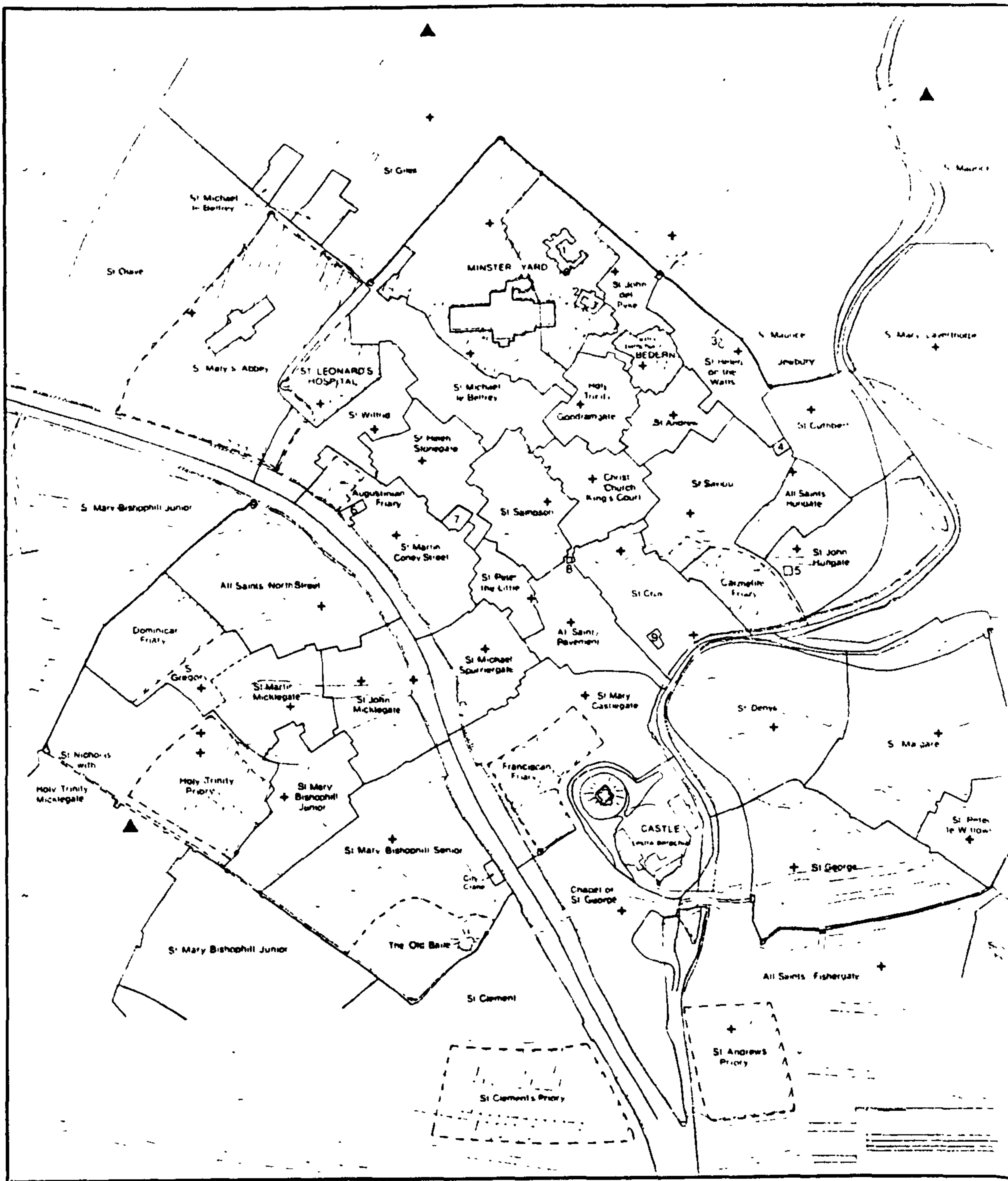
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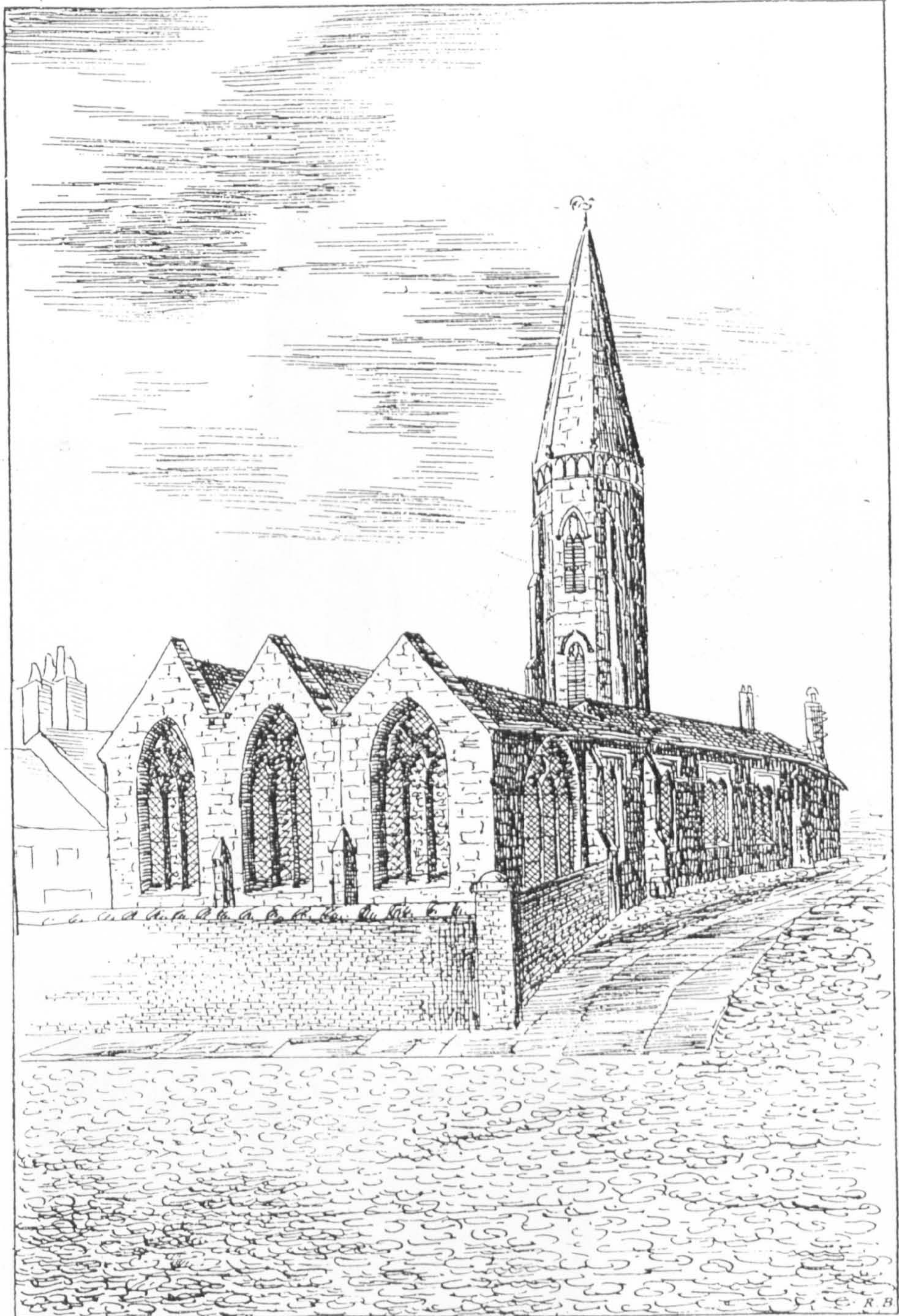

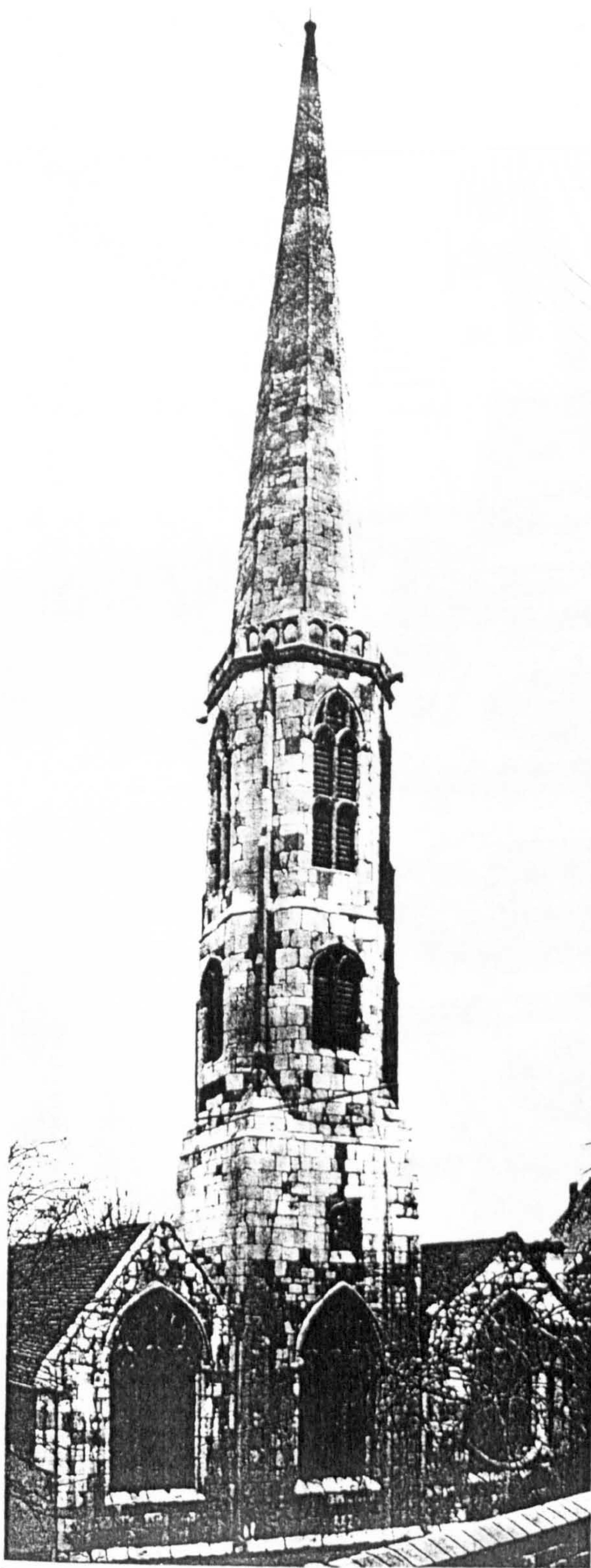

Medieval York of the 15th century. Scale 1:10,000

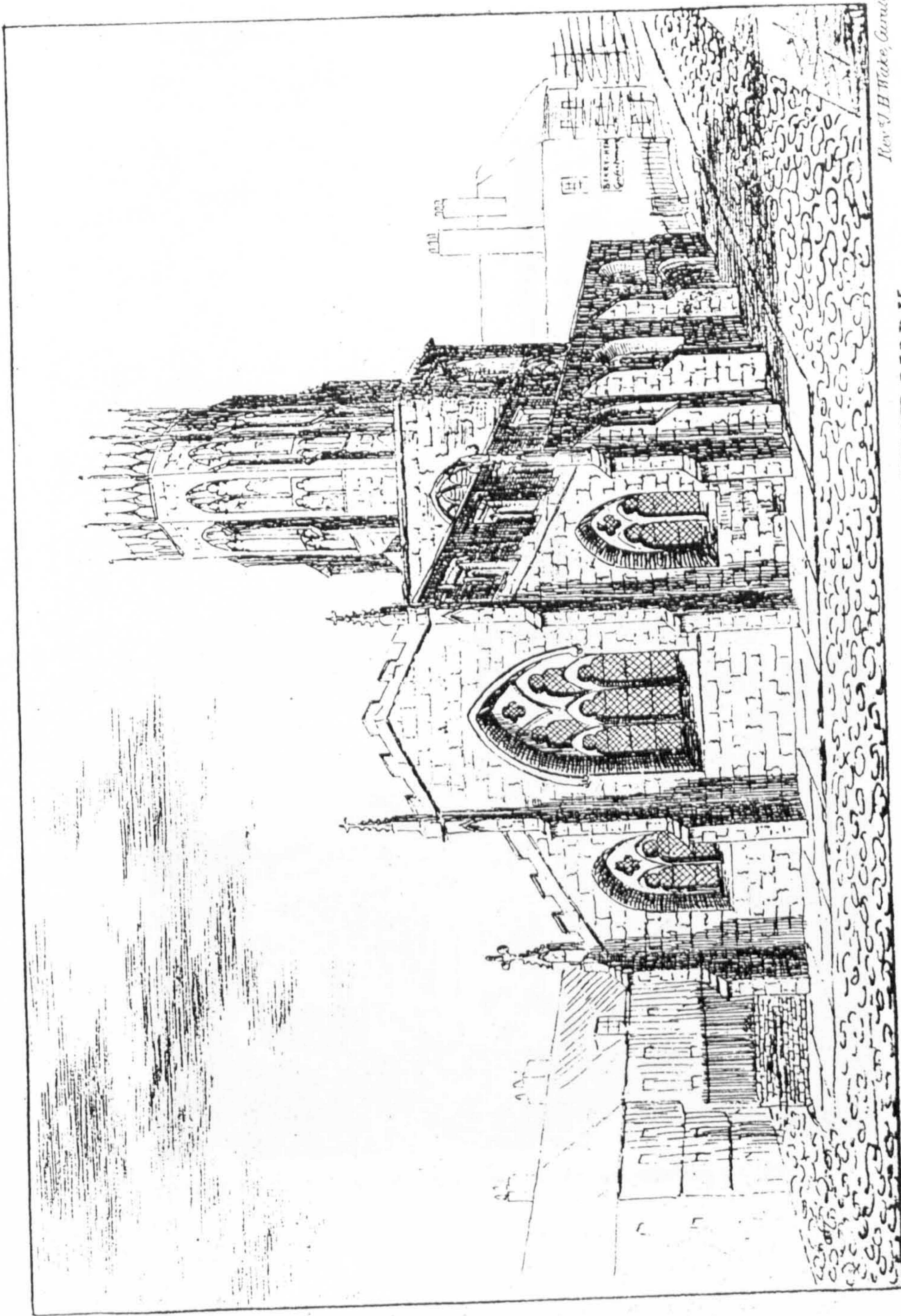

mid 15th century.

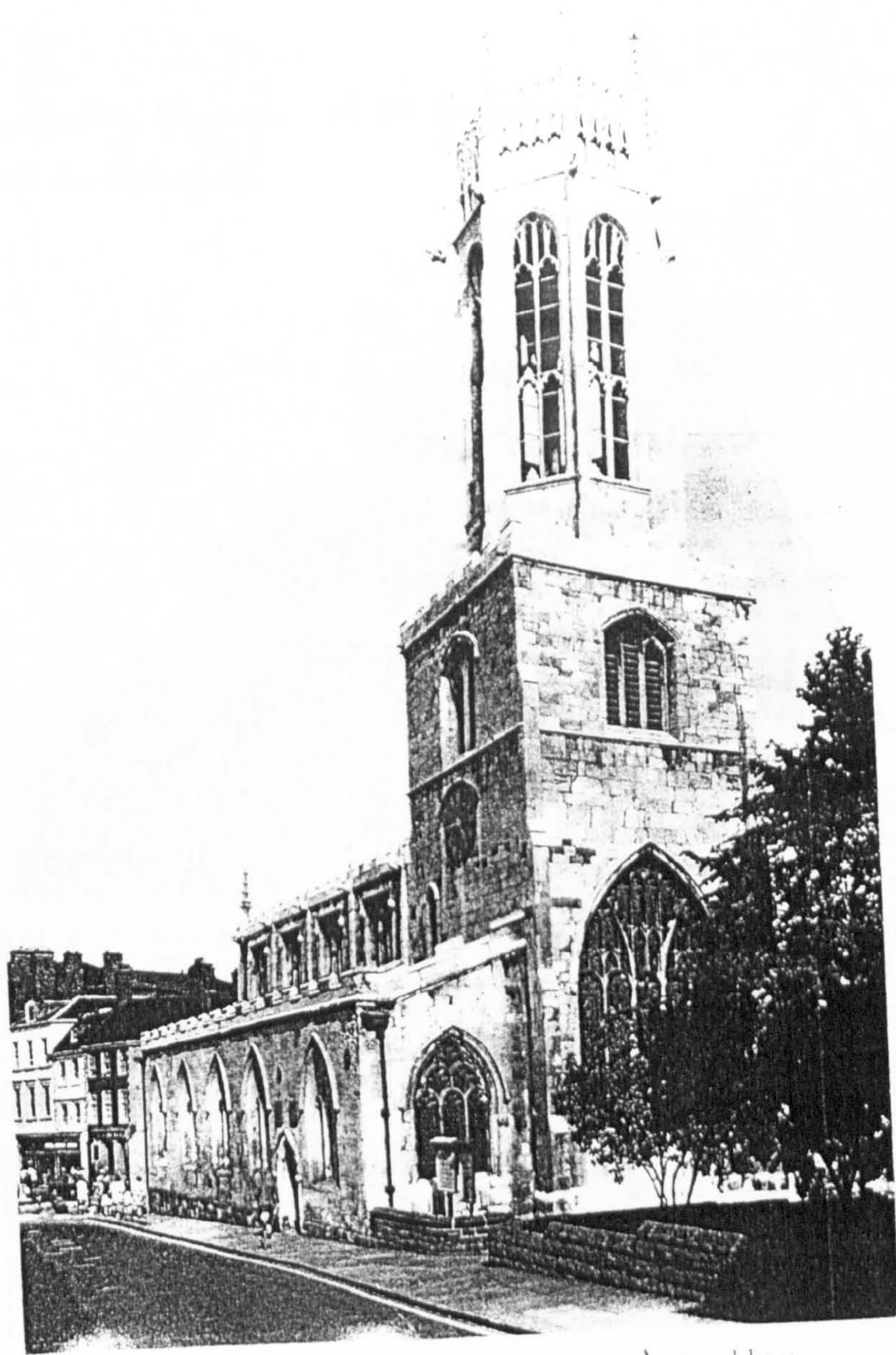

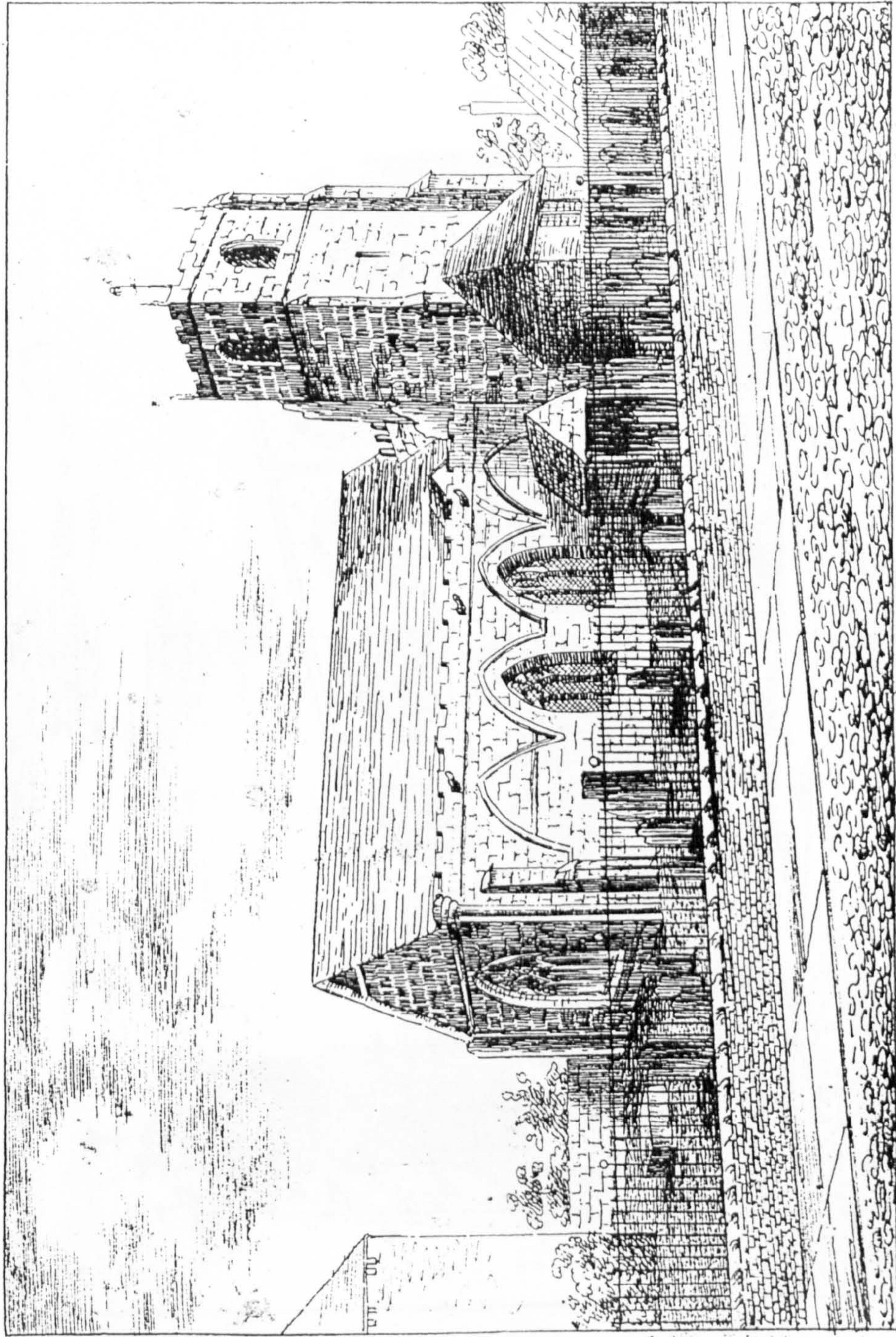
(2) HOLY TRINITY, GOODRAMGATE, from S. Mainly 14th and 15th-century.

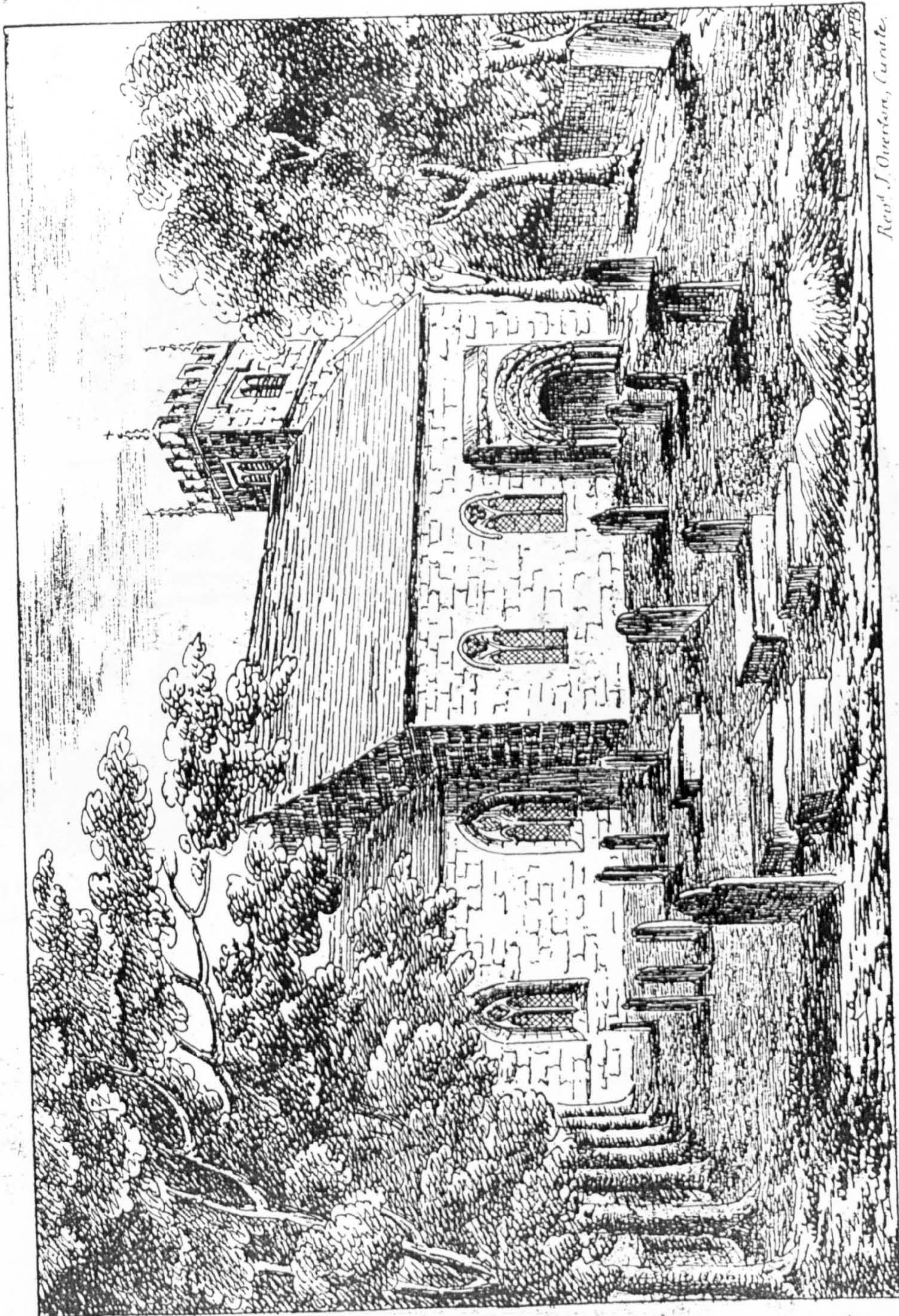

(7) PARISH CHURCH OF ST. LAWRENCE. Old church from S.E., 1776. © YAYAS. 12th-century and later.

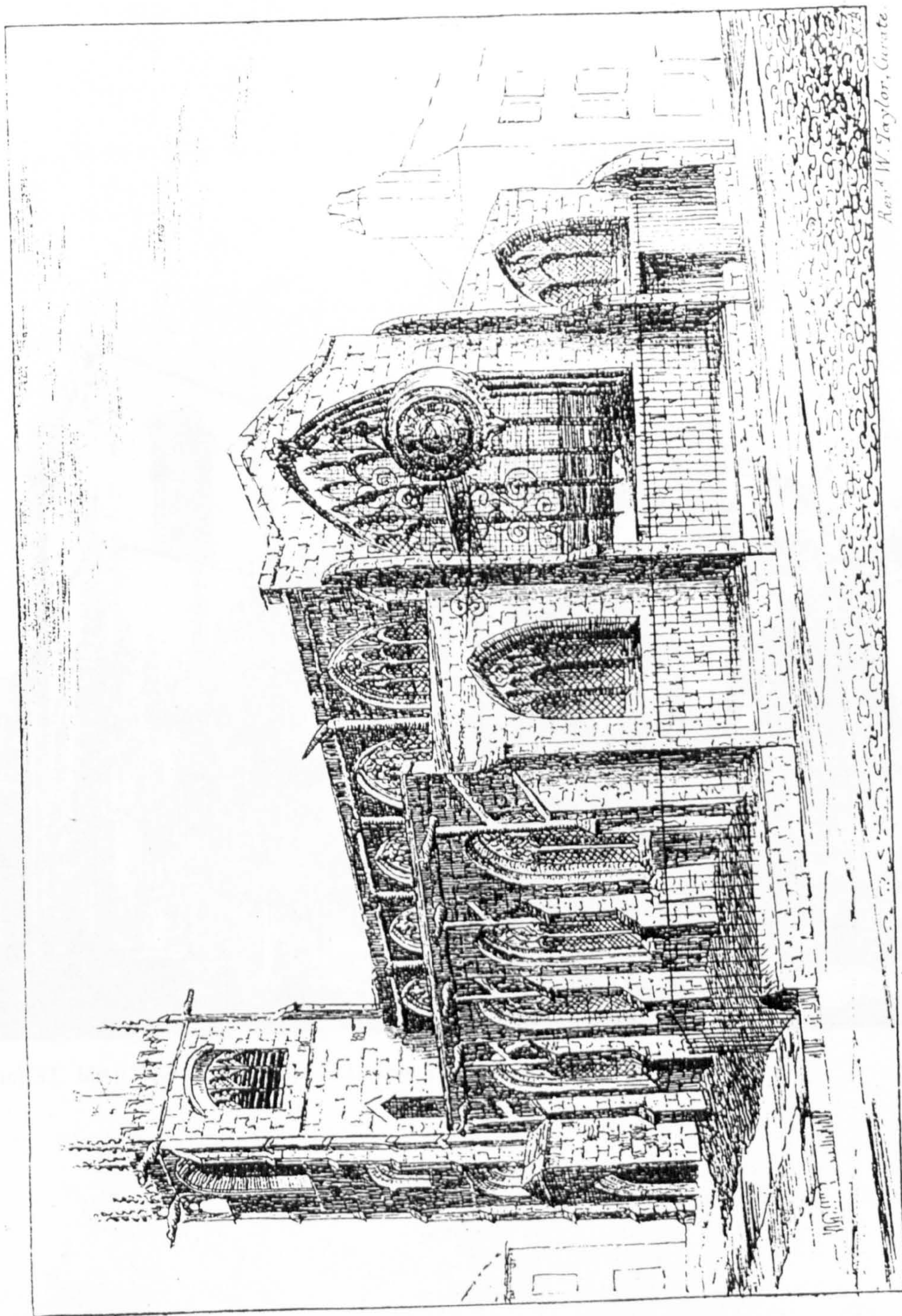

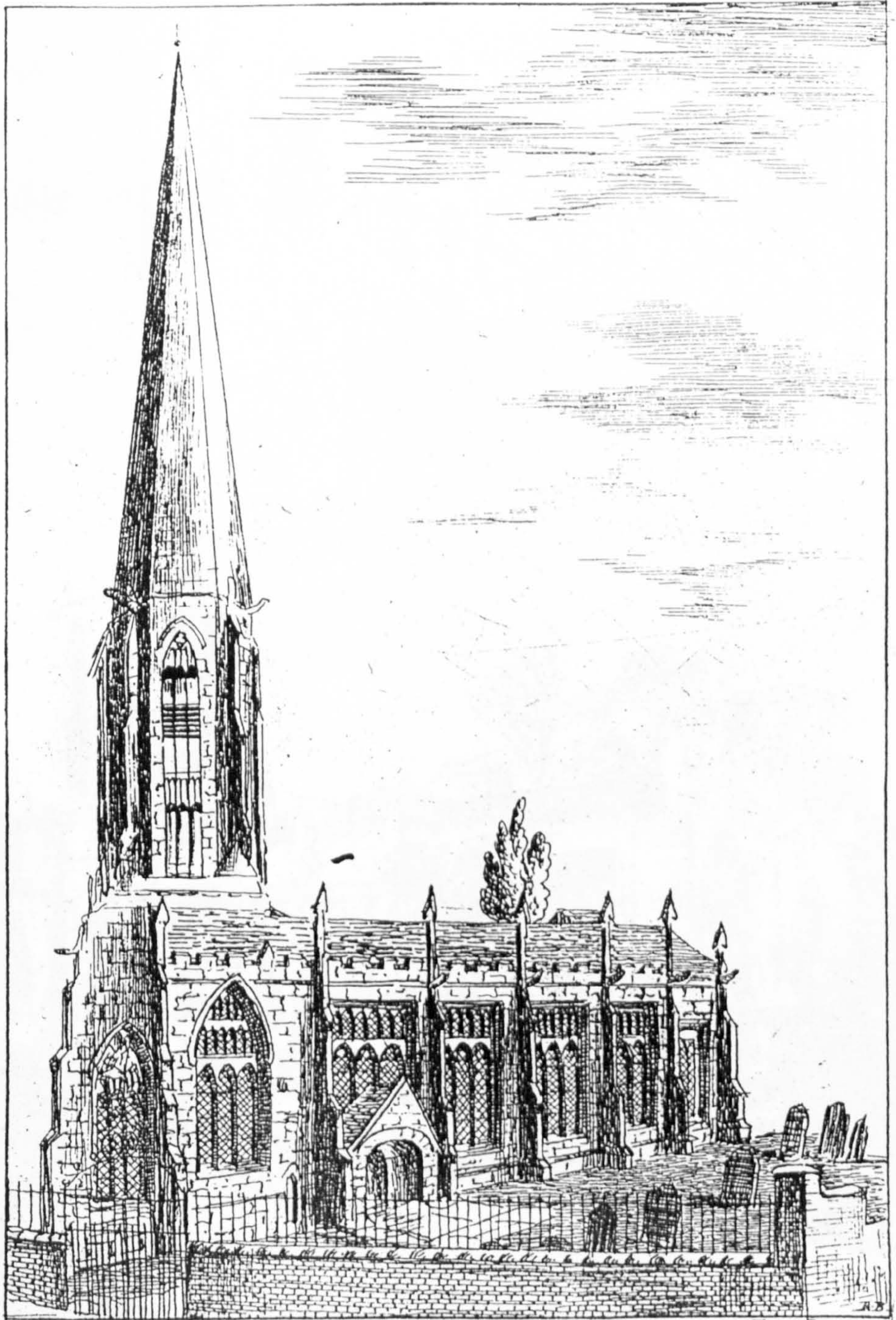
(10) ST. MARTIN, CONEY STREET, from S.E. 15th-century, reconstructed 1961-8.

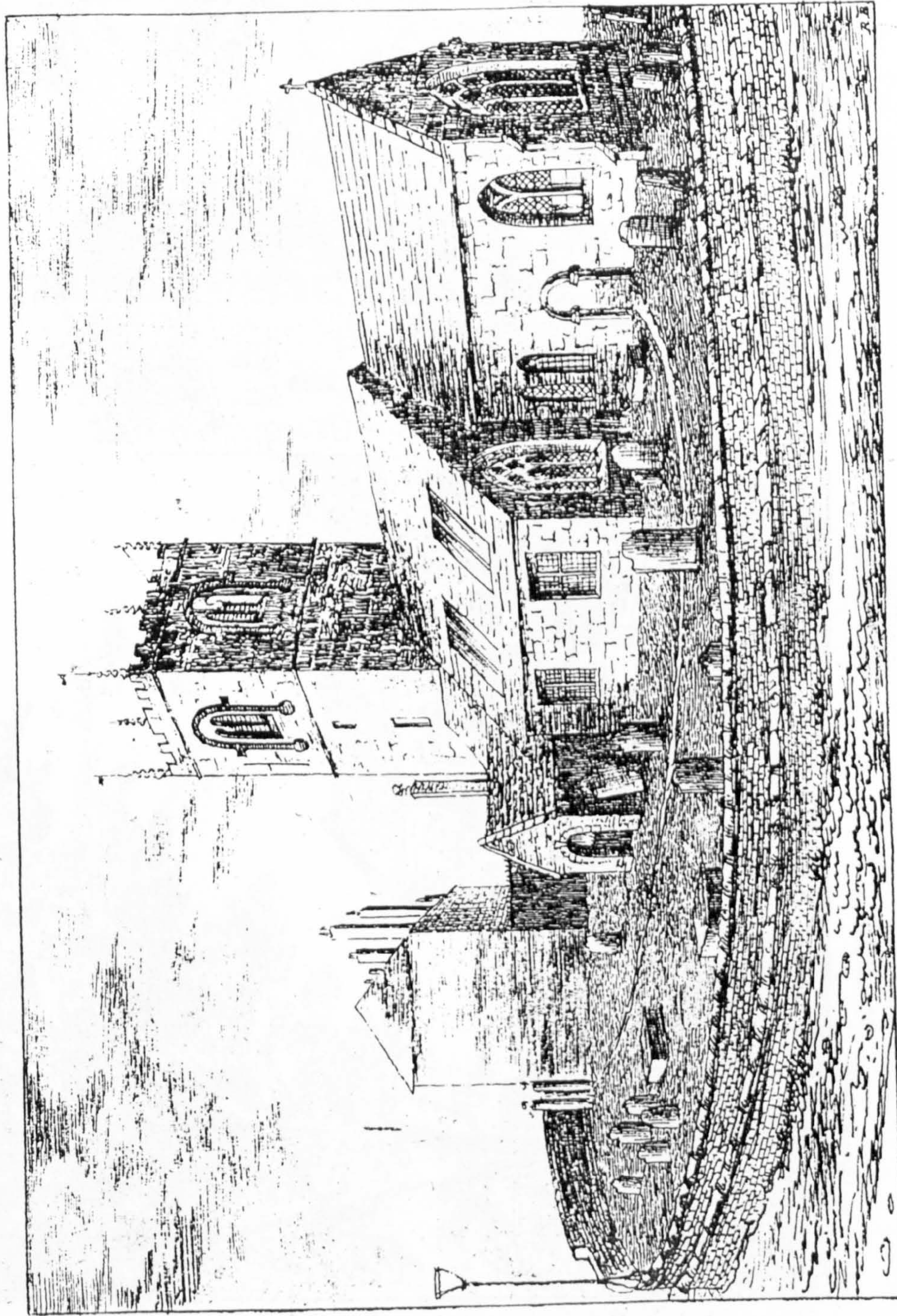

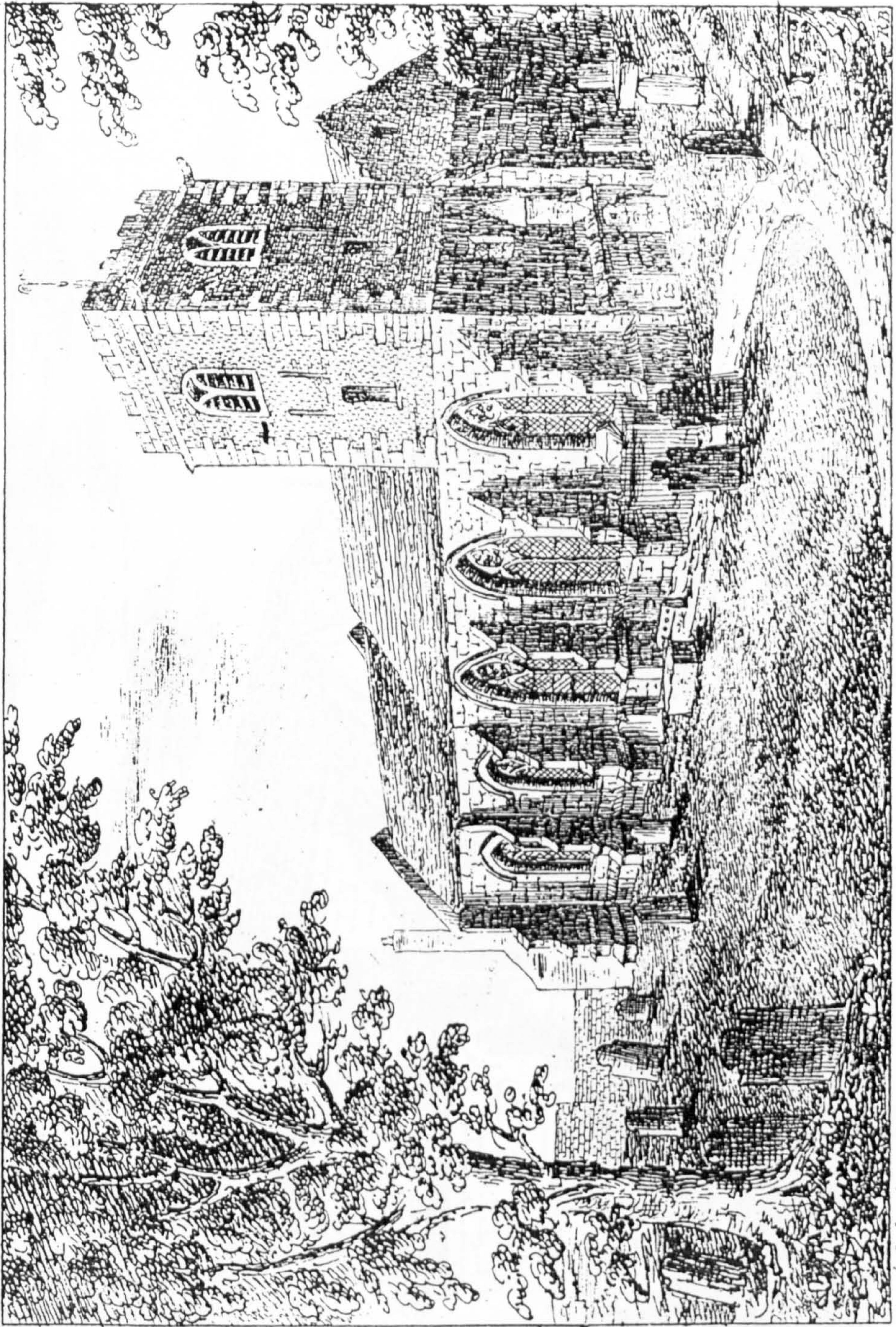


(11) ST. MARY, CASTLEGATE, from S.E. 10th or 11th-century and later, restored 19th century.

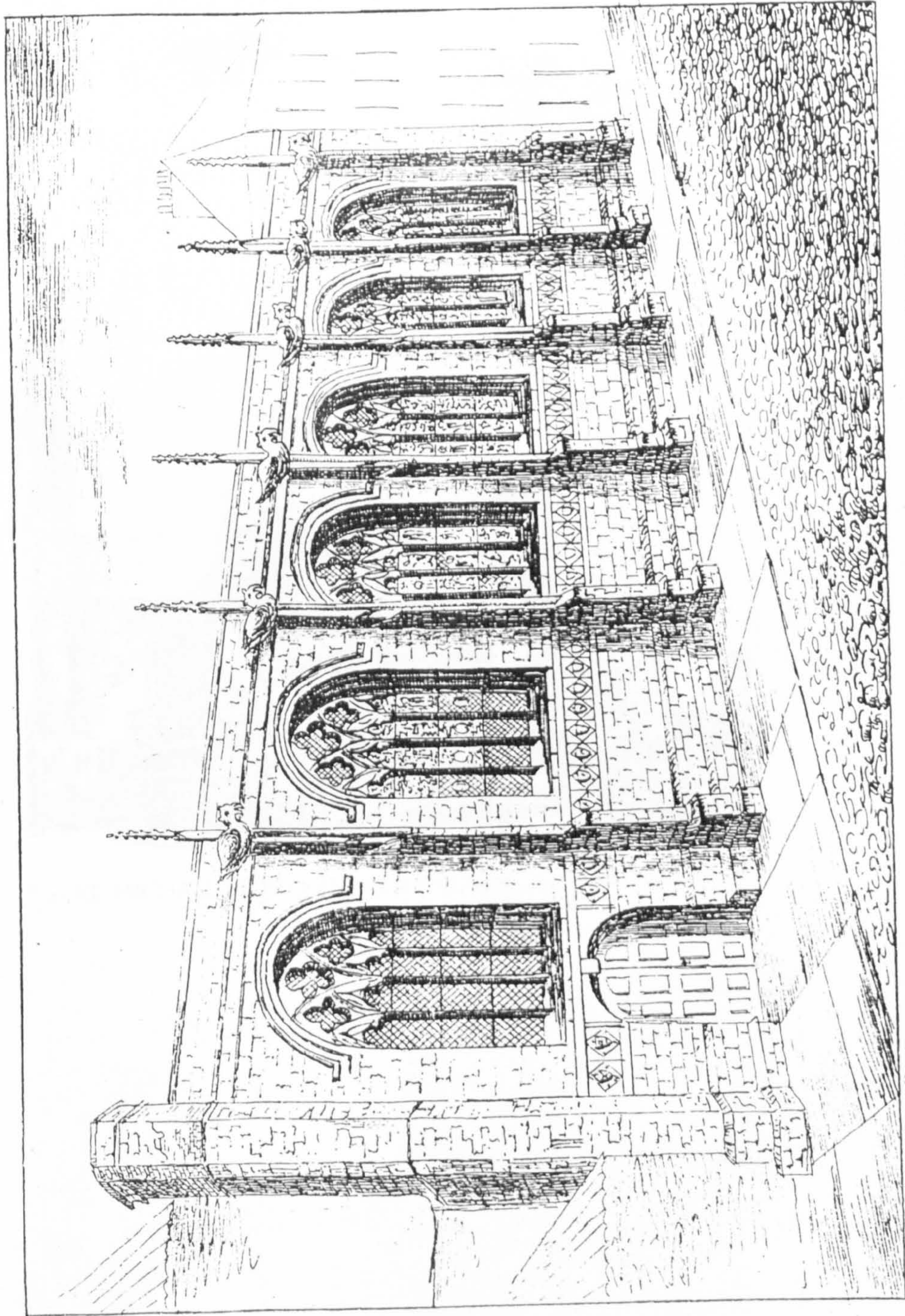


ST. MICHAEL'S CHURCH, SPURRIERGATE, YORK

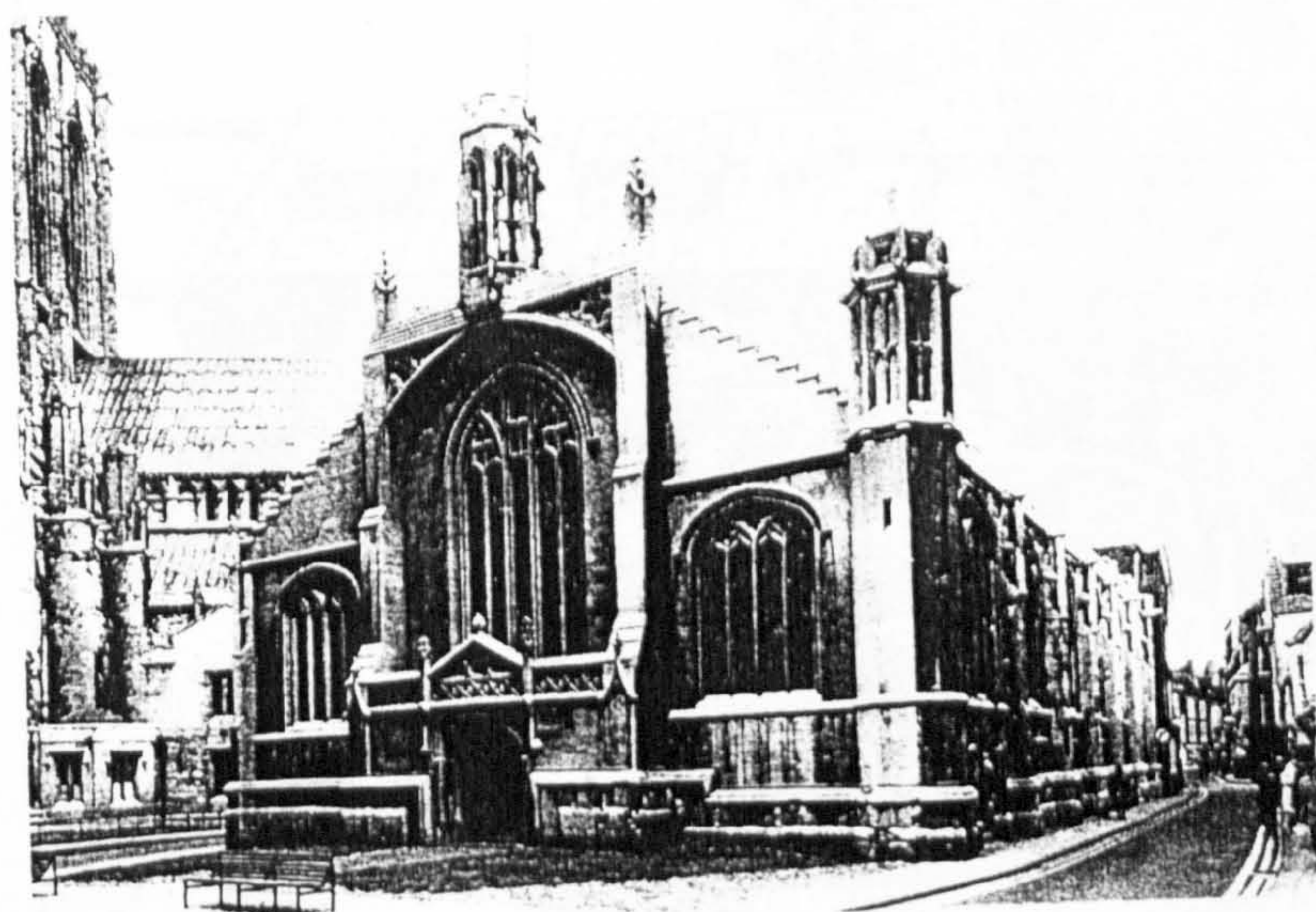


(13) ST. MICHAEL, SPURRIERGATE, from S.E. Mediaeval and 1821.

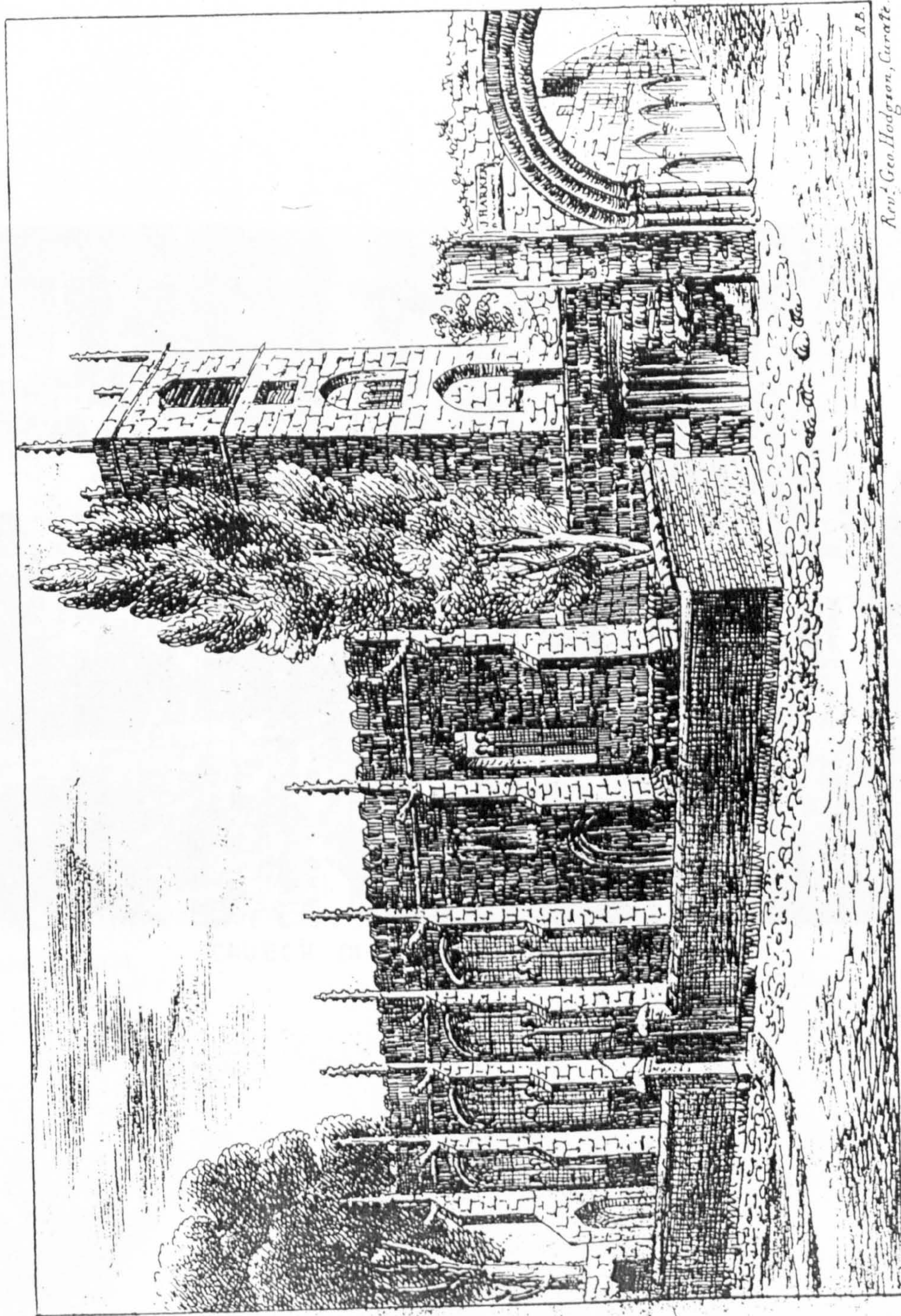

(12) ST. MICHAEL-LE-BELFREY from S.W. 1525-37, restored 19th century.

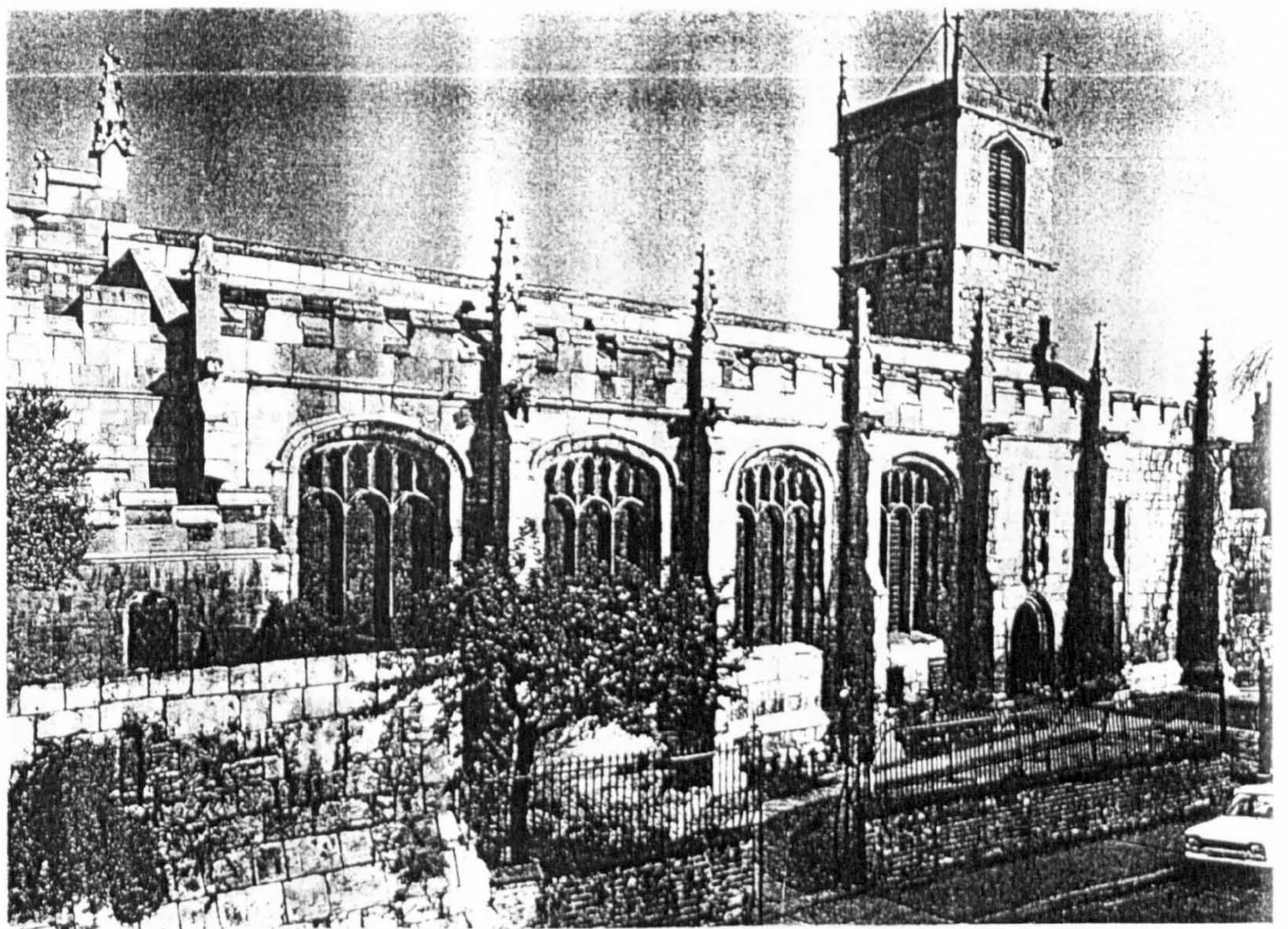

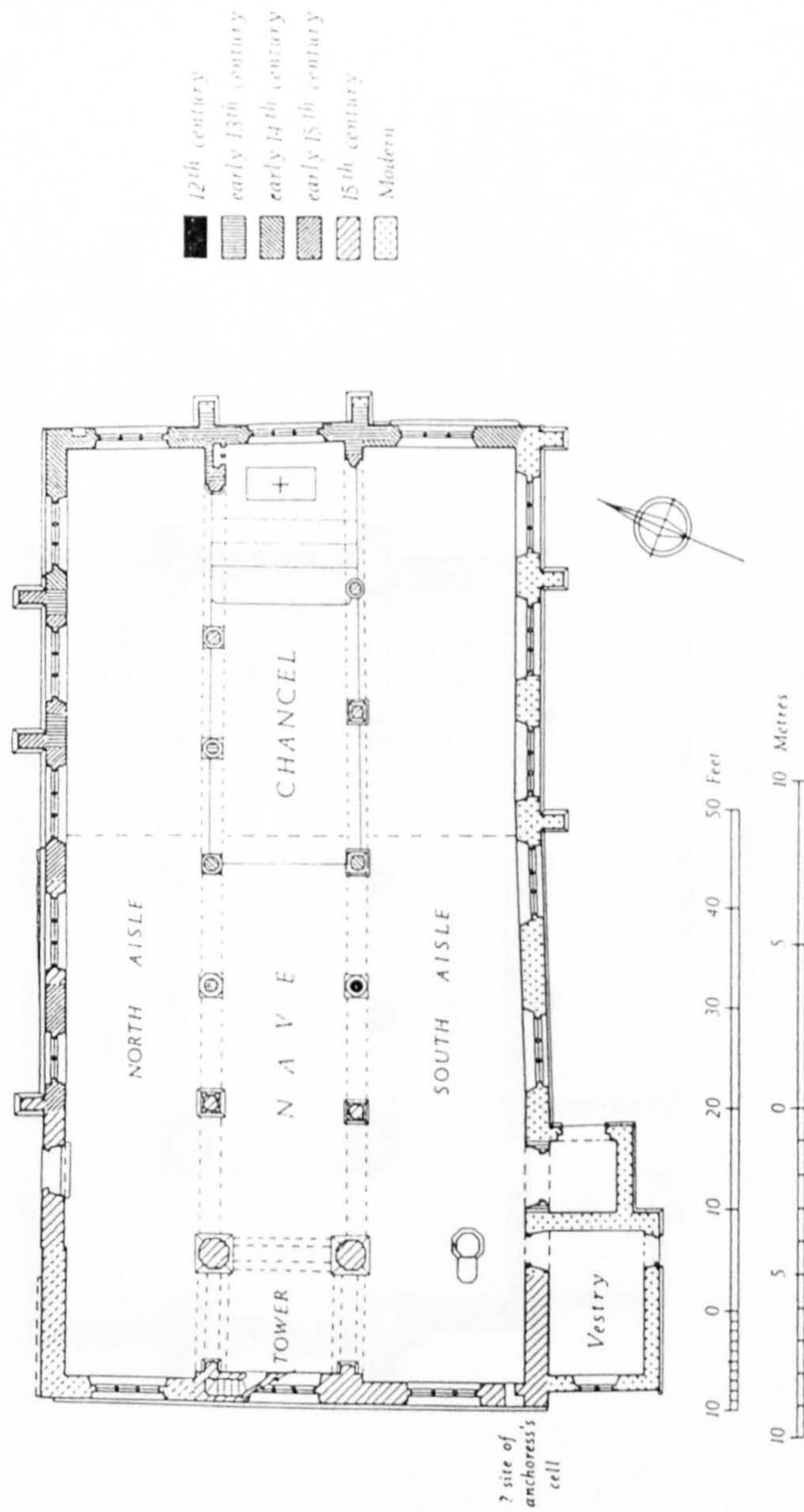


Fig. 25. (4) Church of All Saints, North Street.

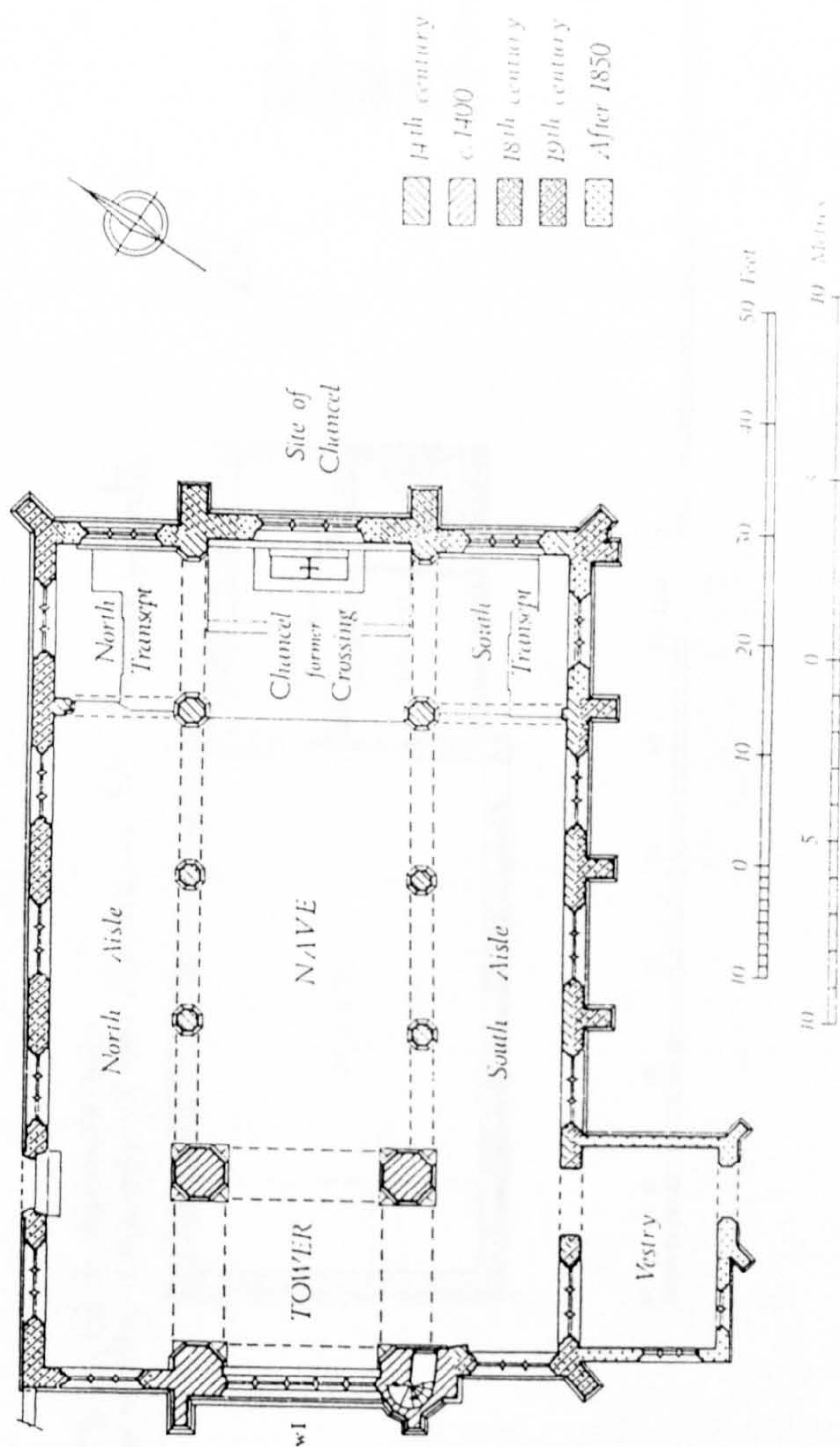
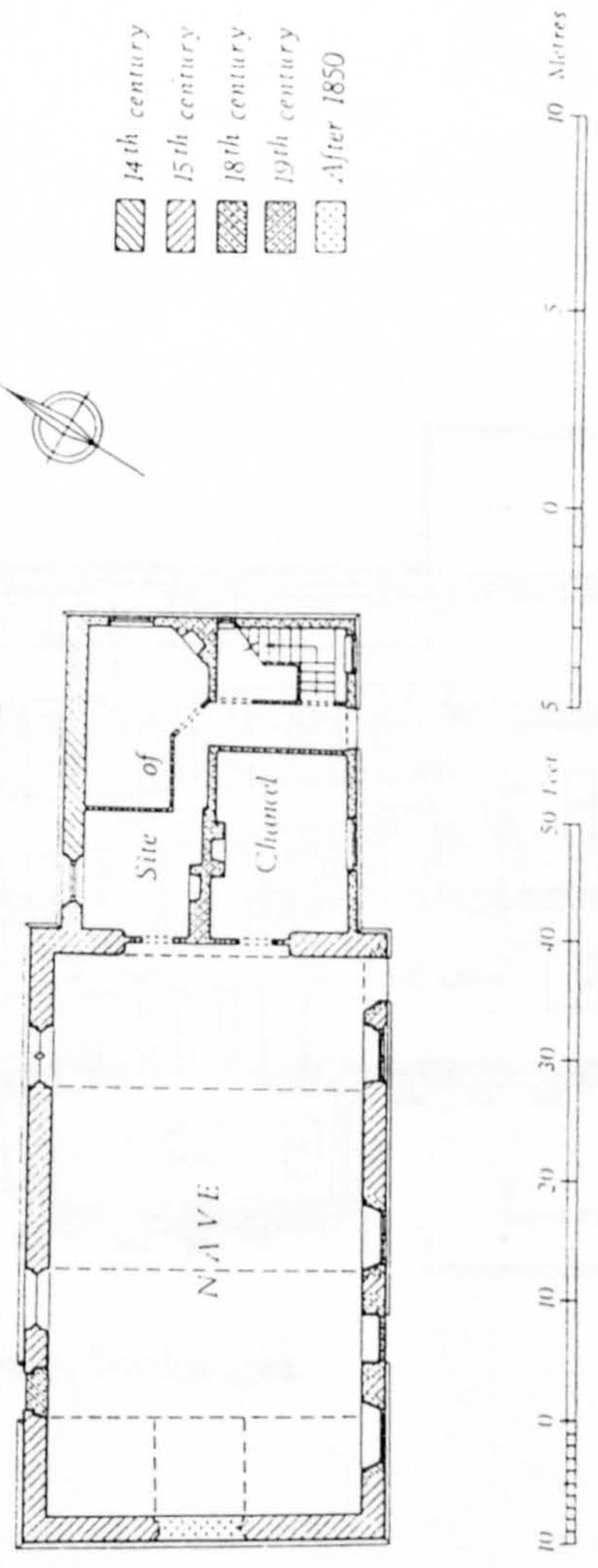


Fig. 12. (1) Church of All Saints, Pavement.

formerly church of St. Andrew, St. Andrewgate



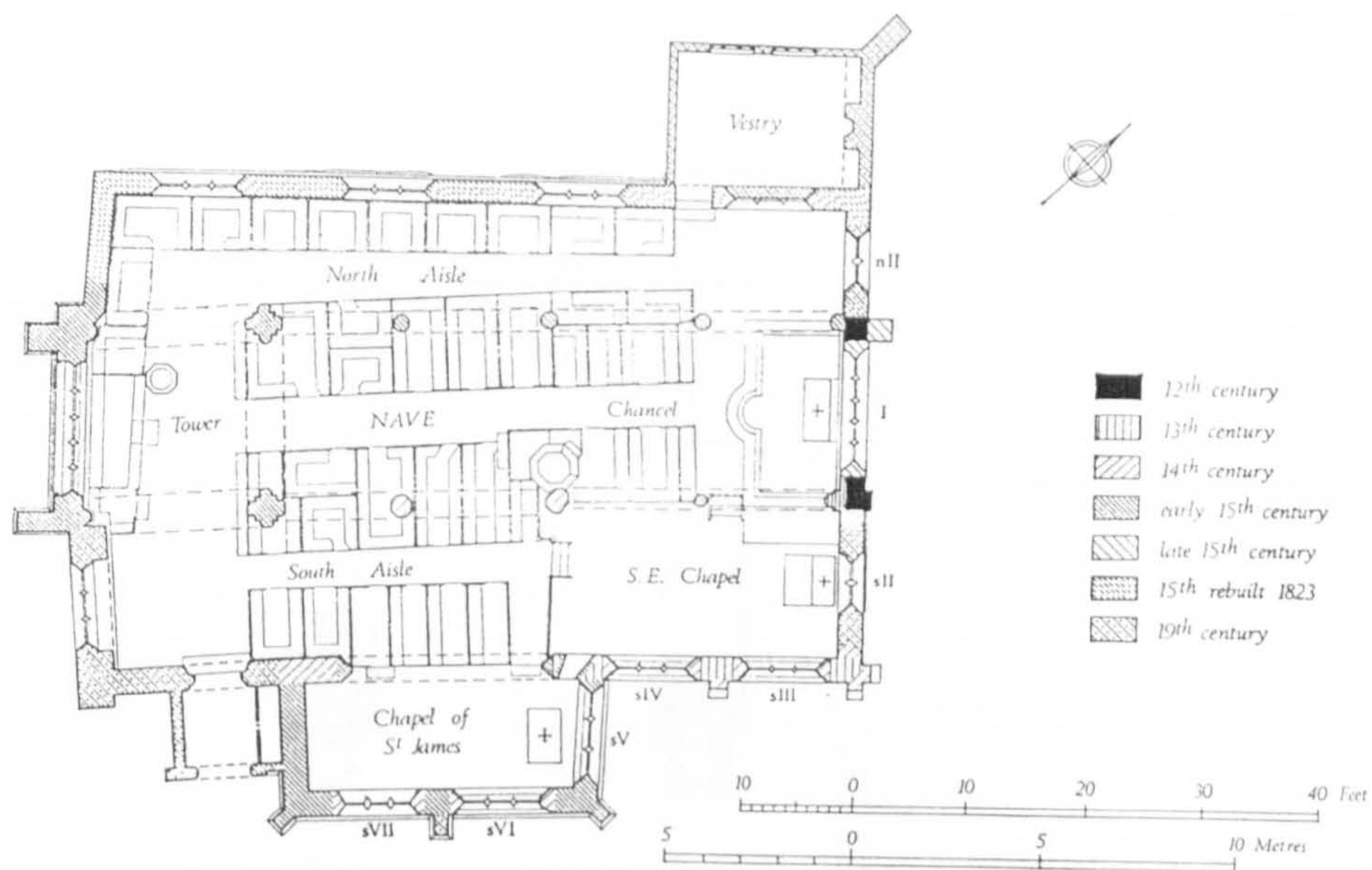
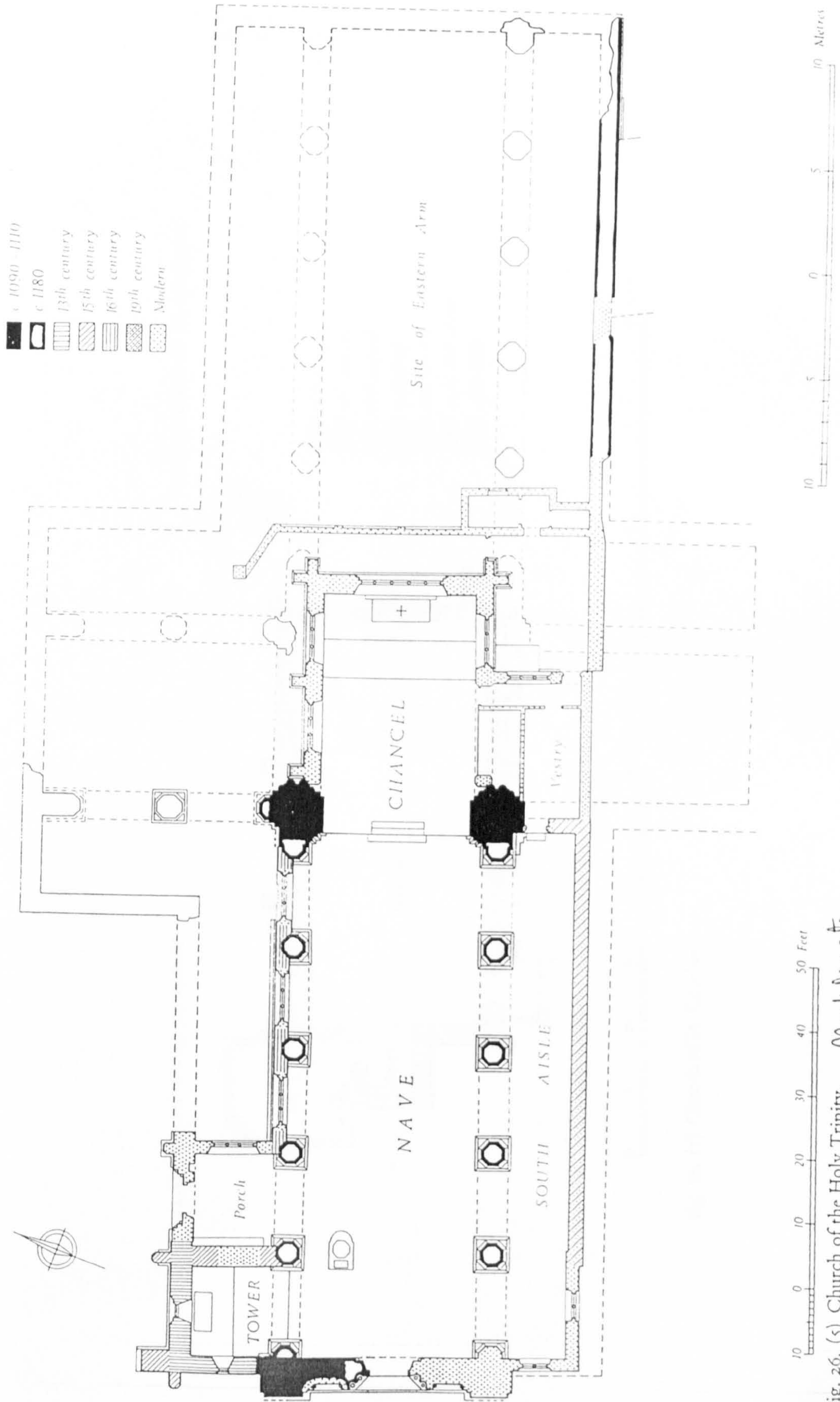


Fig. 14. (2) Church of Holy Trinity, Goodramgate.

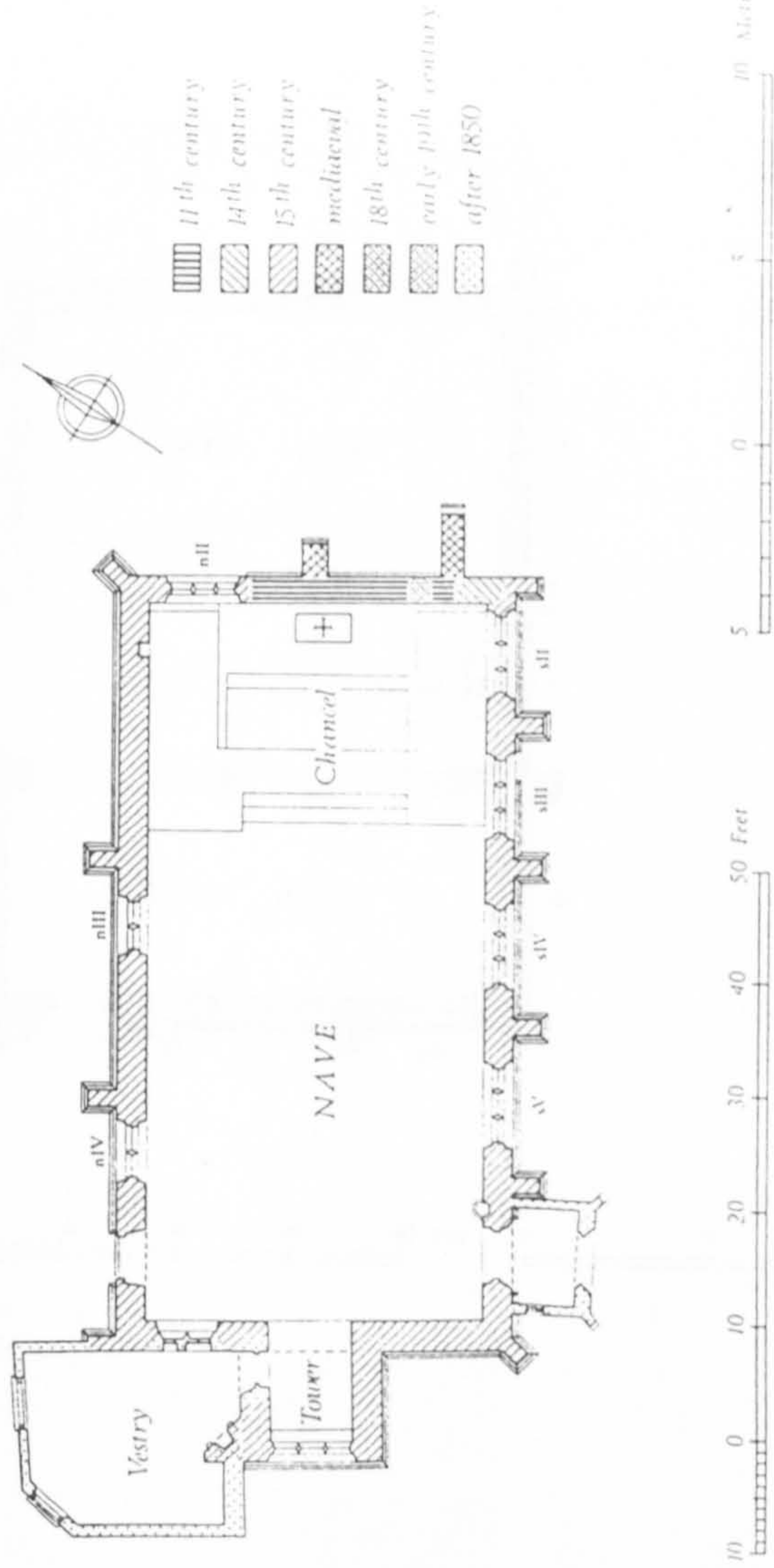


Fig. 16. (5) Church of St. Cuthbert.

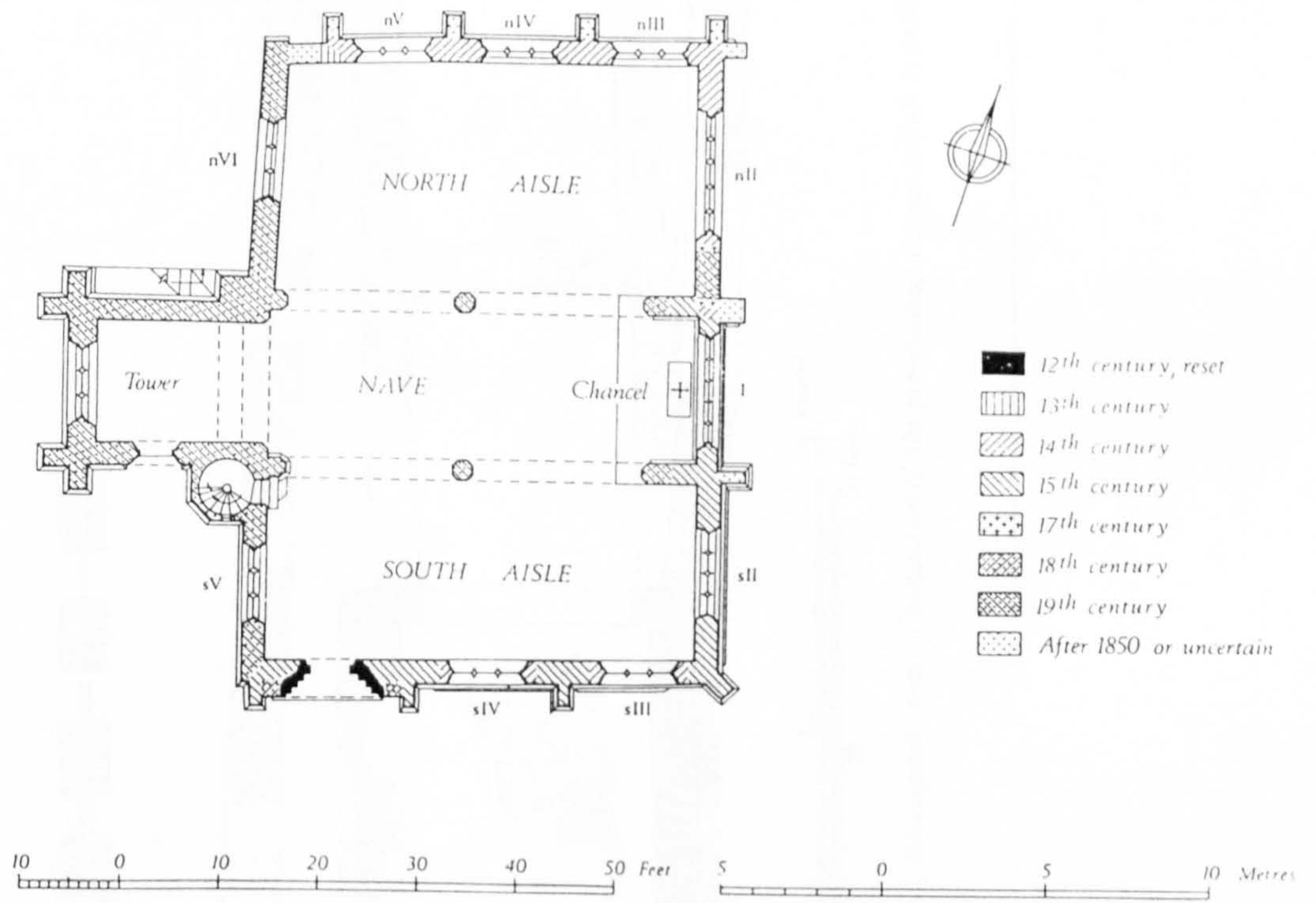


Fig. 17. (6) Church of St. Denys.

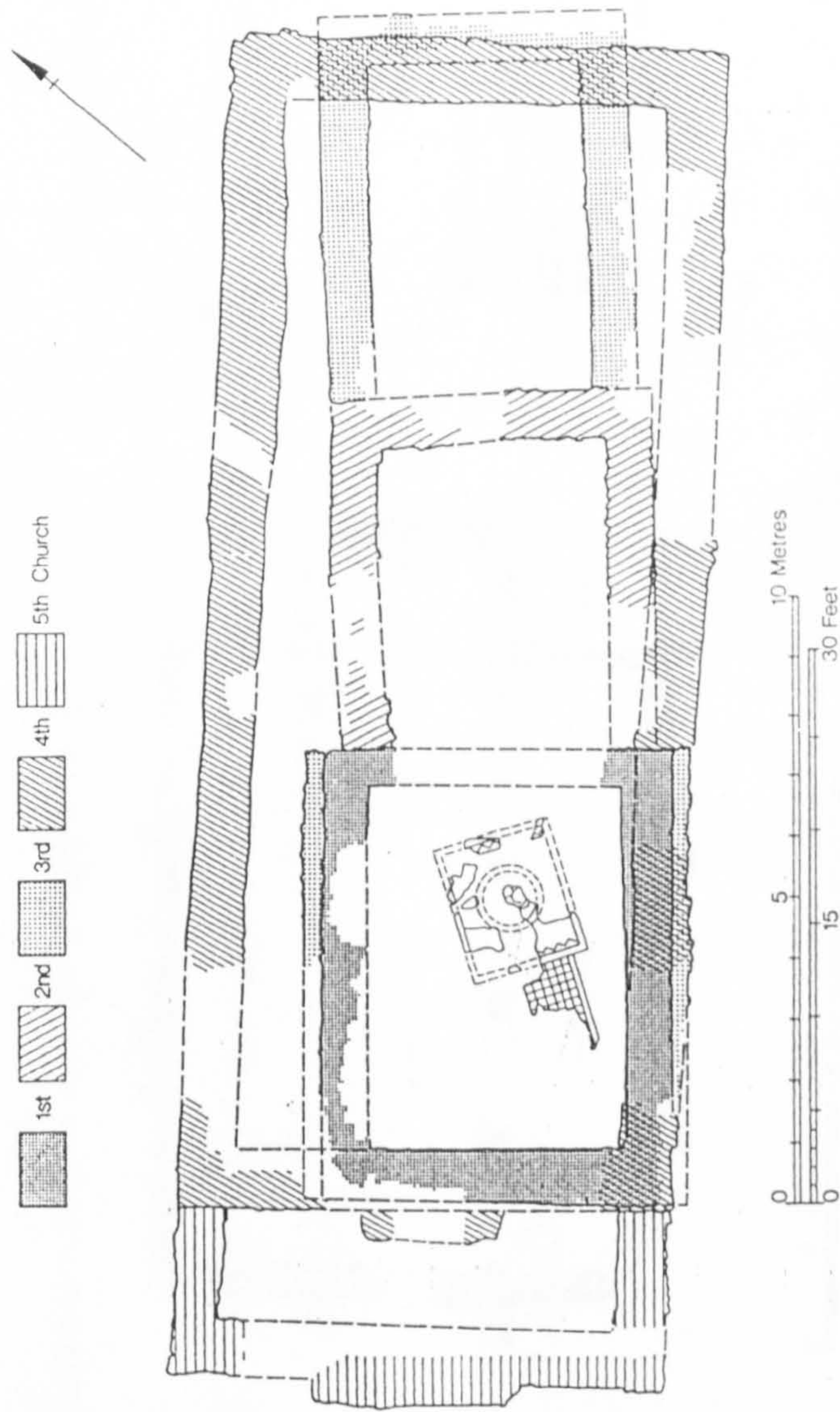


Fig. 4 St Helen's church, development plan. The position of the pre-existing Roman mosaic is indicated.

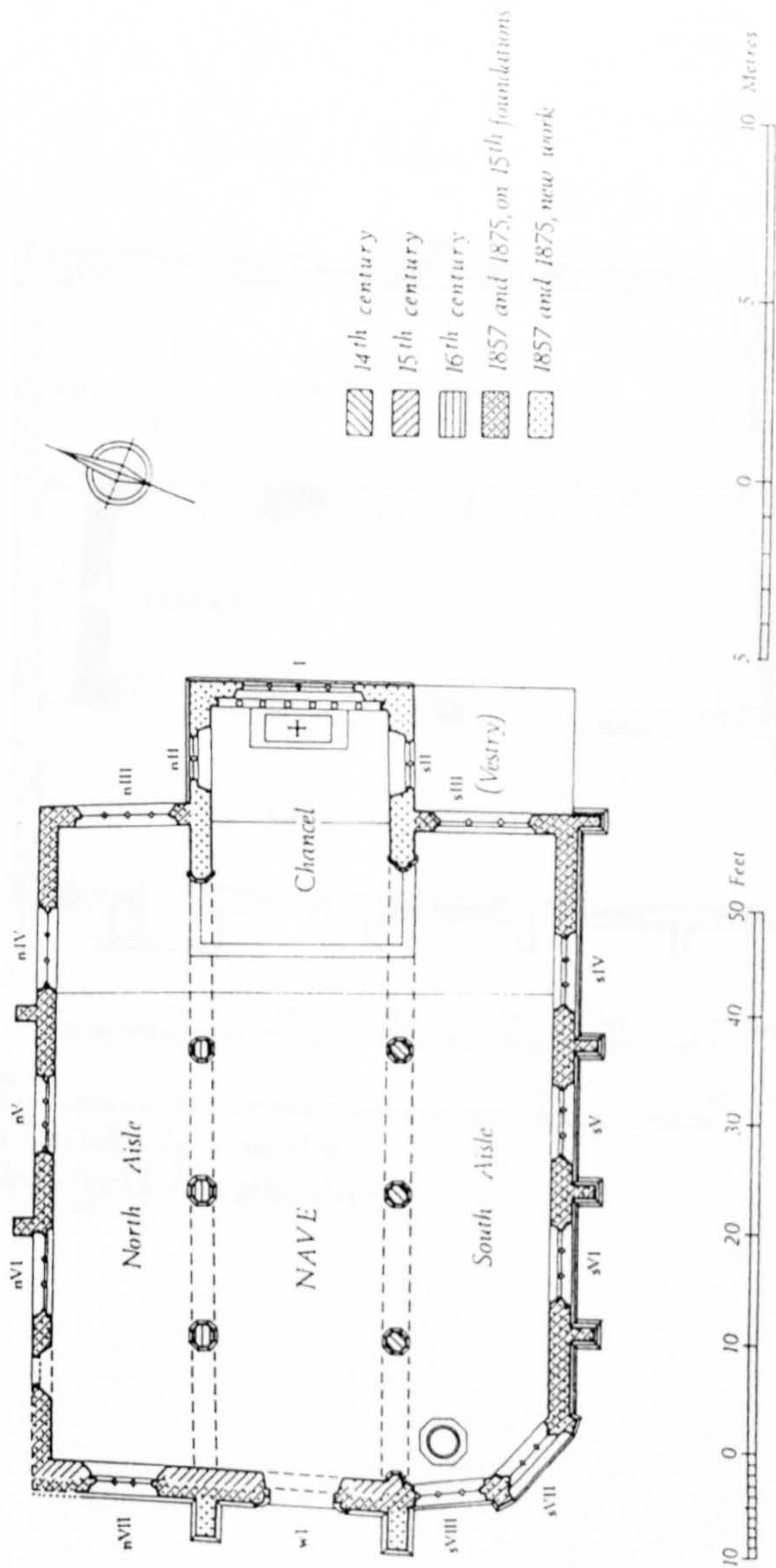


Fig. 20. (8) Church of St. Helen.

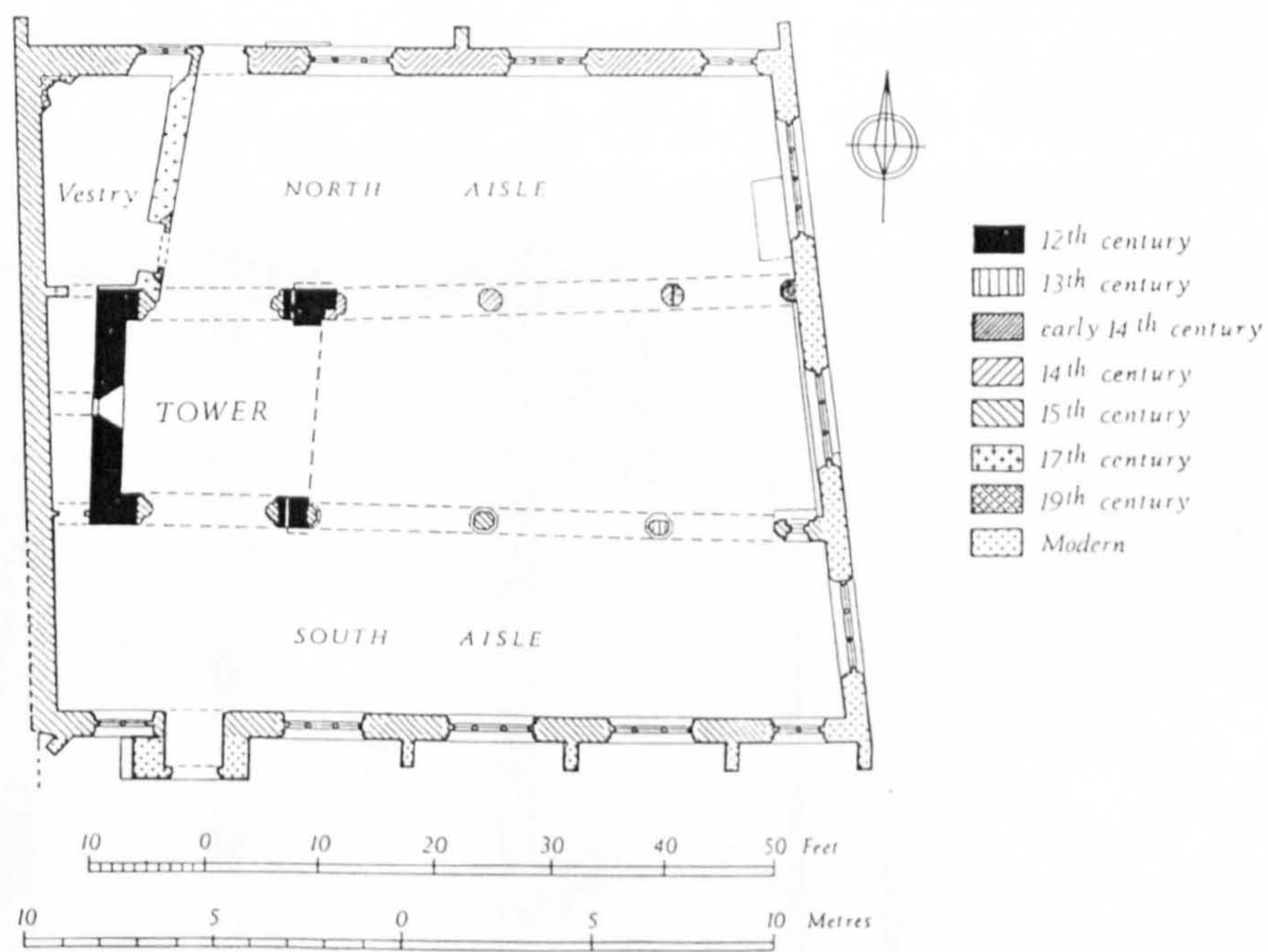


Fig. 29. (6) Church of St. John the Evangelist.

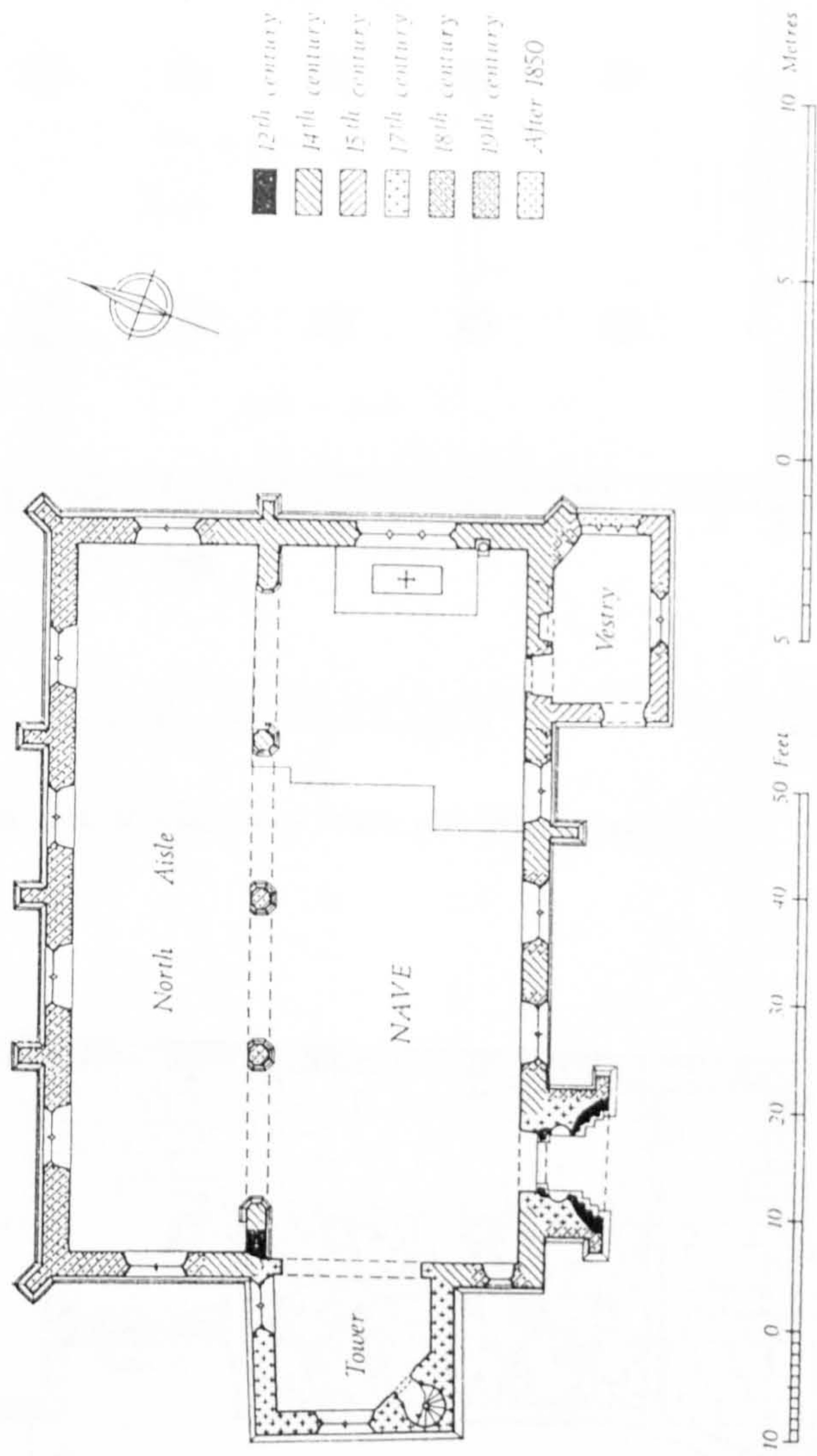


Fig. 21. (9) Church of St. Margaret.

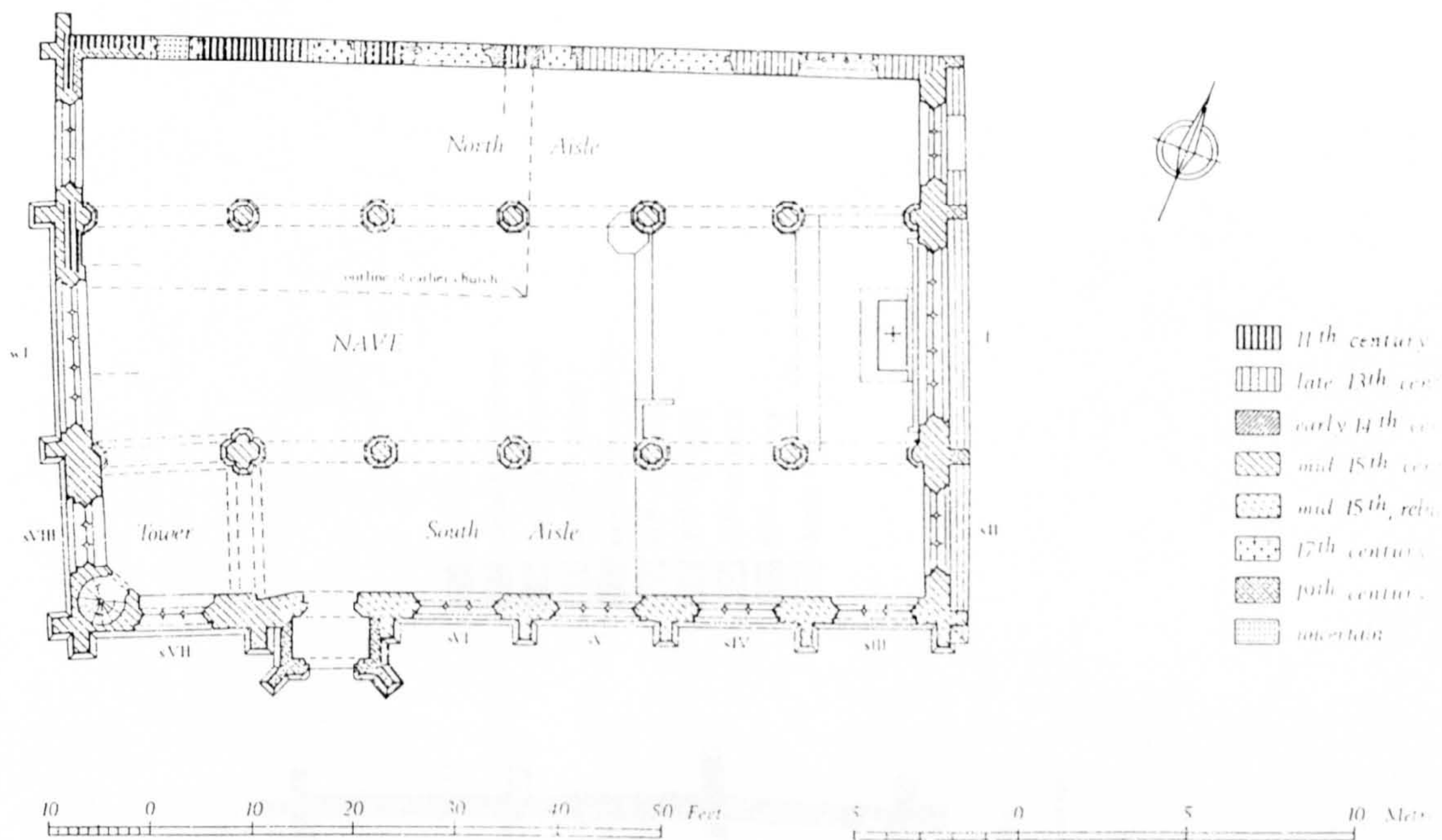


Fig. 22. (10) Church of St. Martin, Coney Street, plan before 1942.

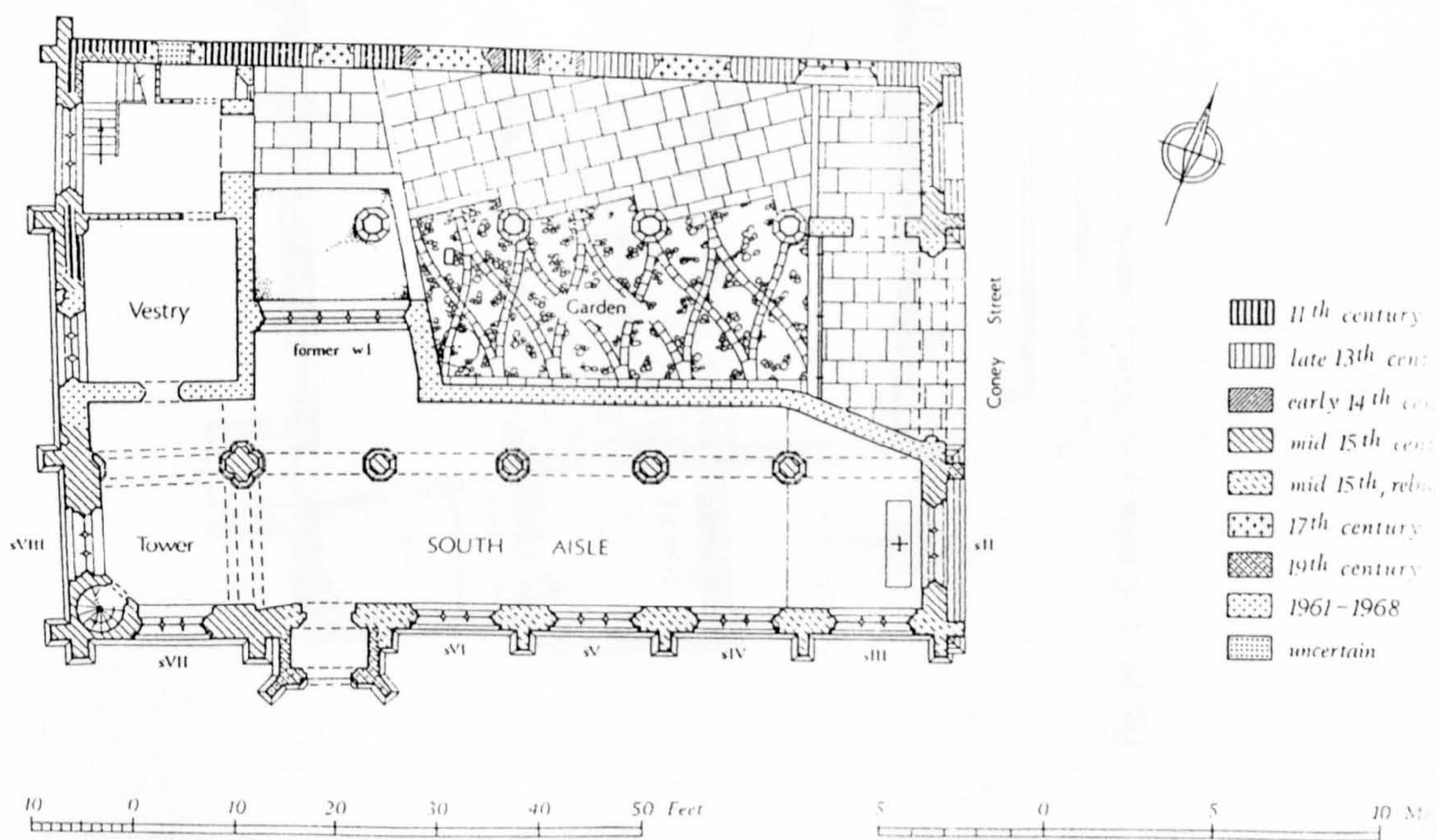


Fig. 23. (10) Church of St. Martin, Coney Street, as existing.

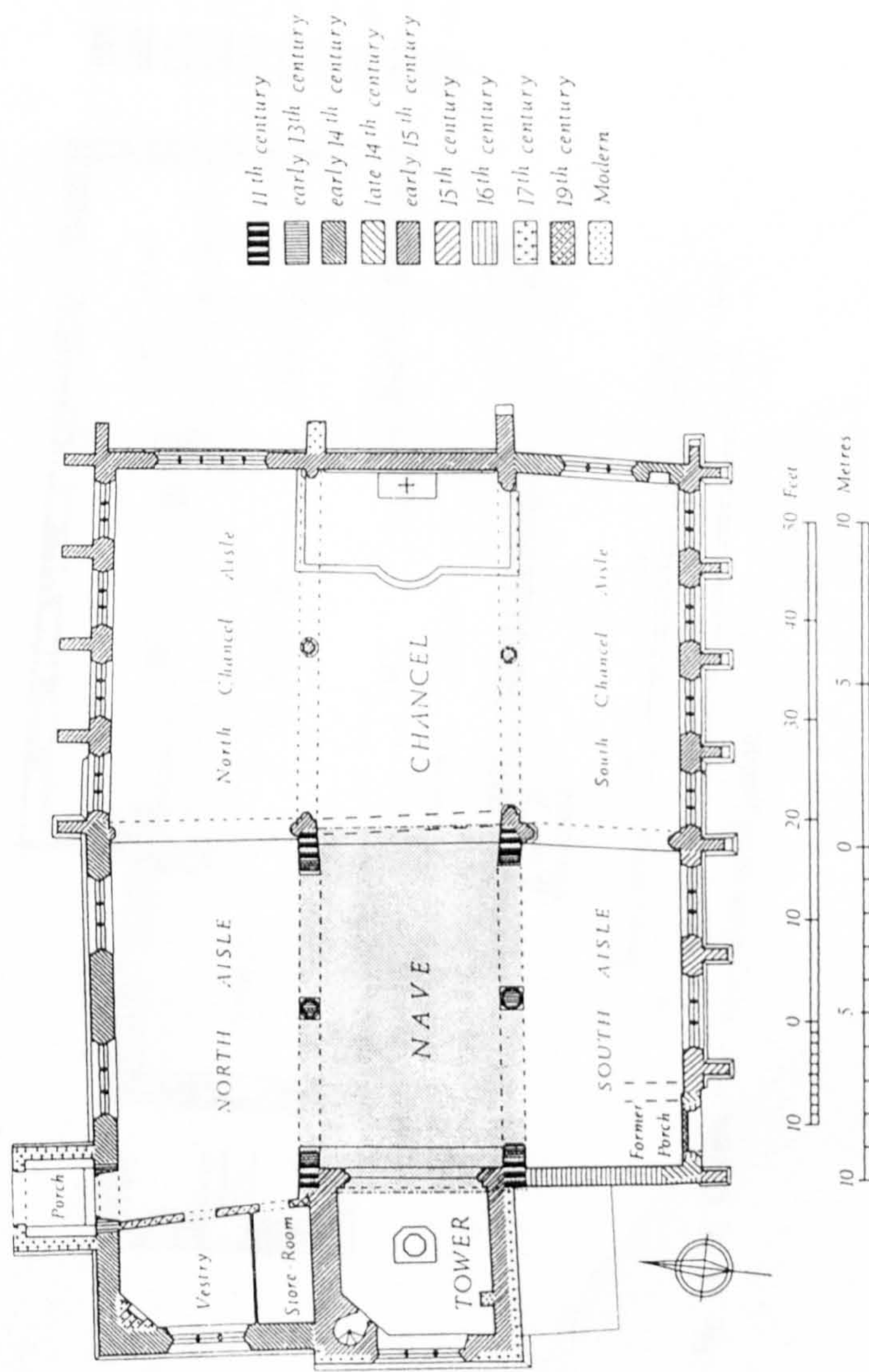


Fig. 30. (7) Church of St. Martin-in-cum-Gregory. Micklegate

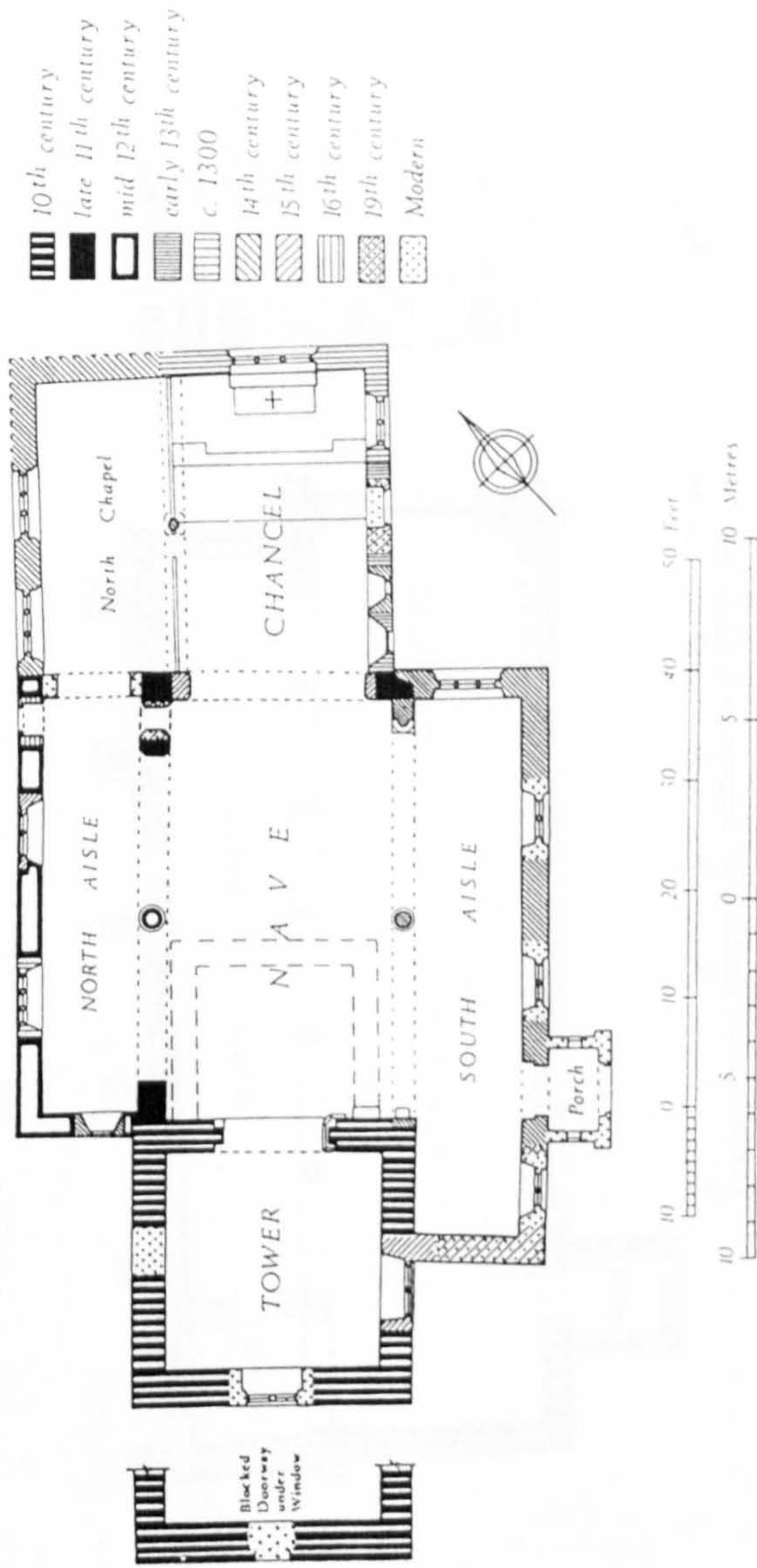


Fig. 31. (8) Church of St. Mary Bishophill Junior.

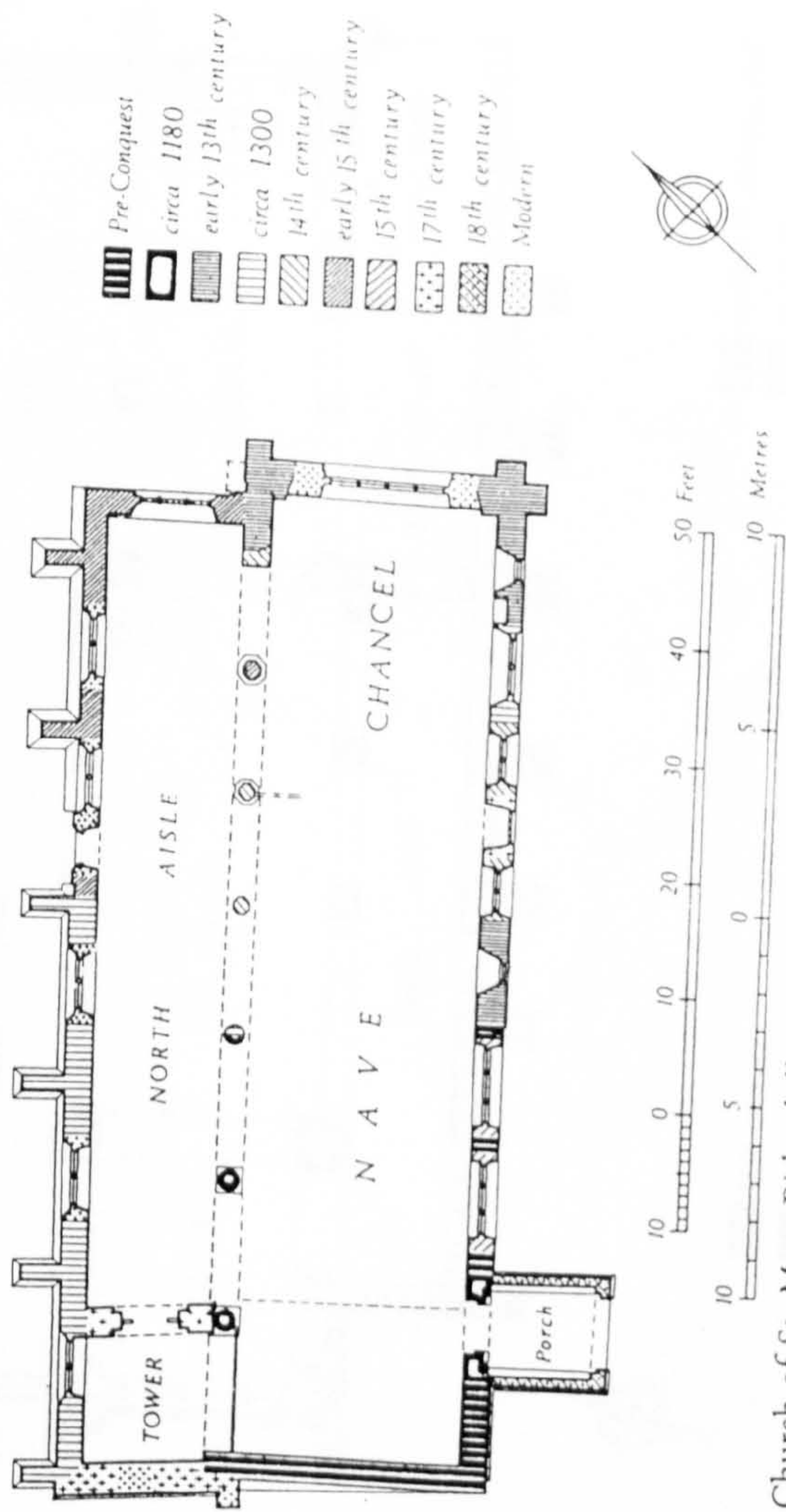


Fig. 35. (9) Church of St. Mary Bishophill Senior.

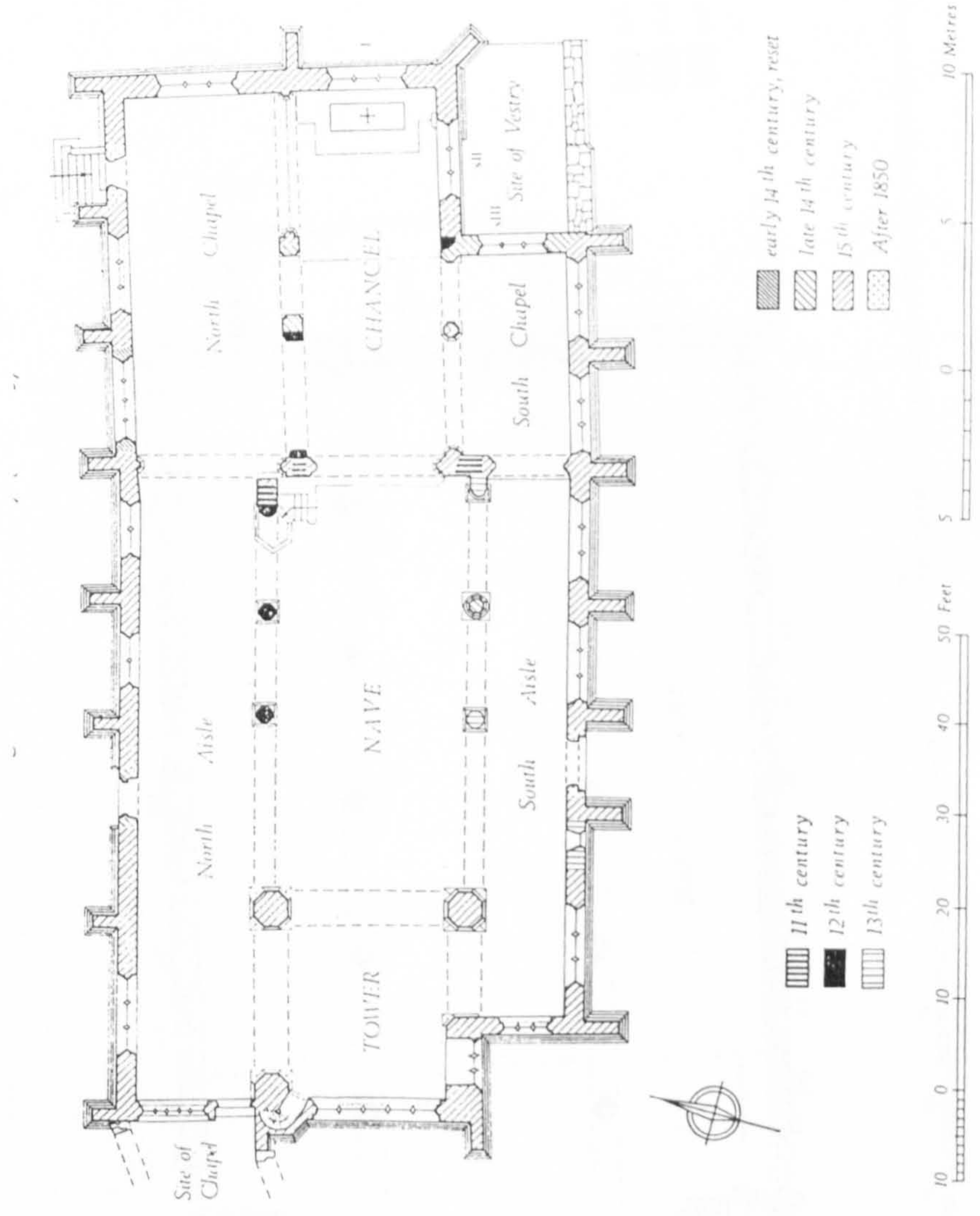


Fig. 24. (11) Church of St. Mary, Castlegate, plan before 1974.

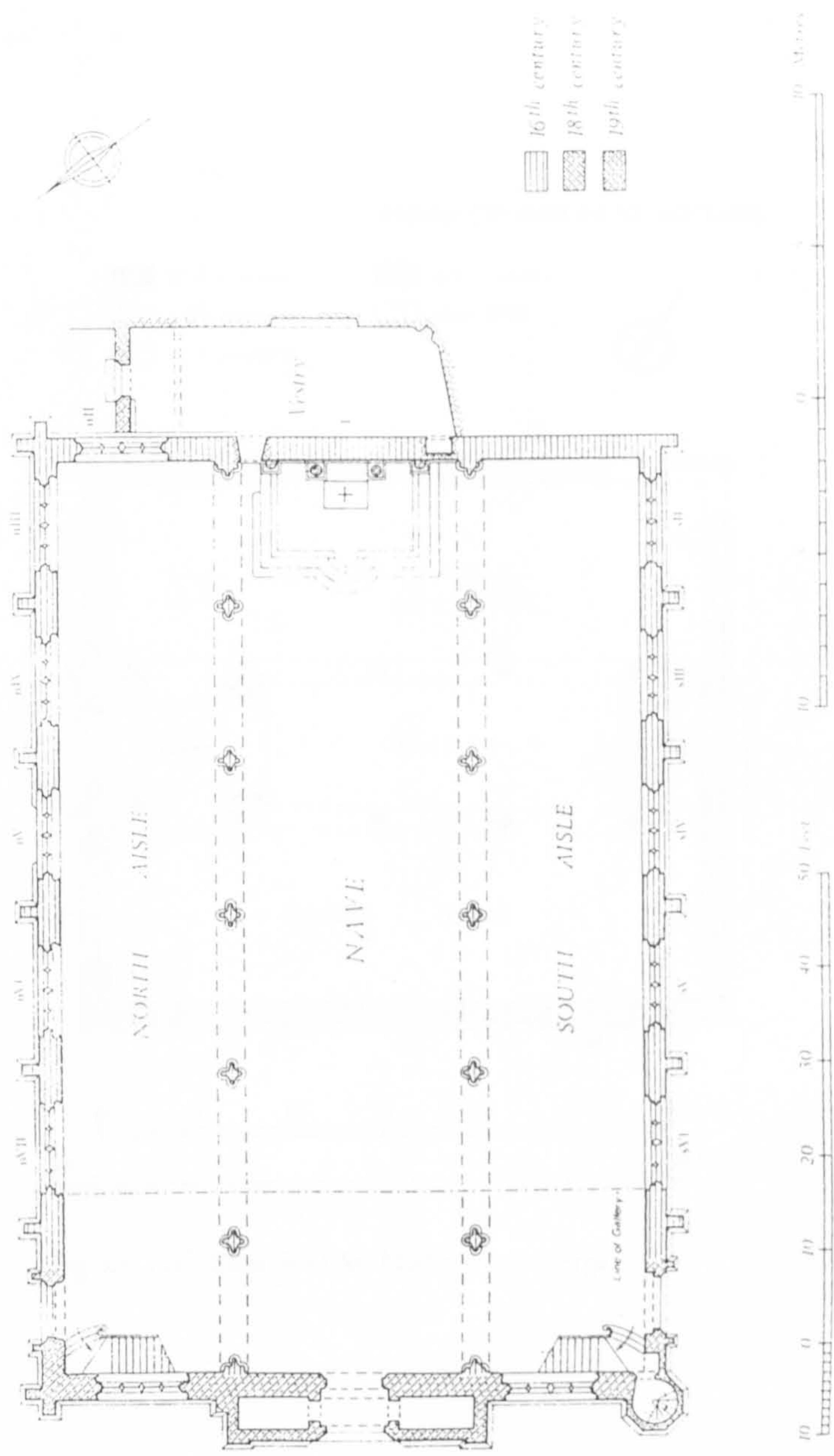


Fig. 26. (12) Church of St. Michael-le-Belfrey.

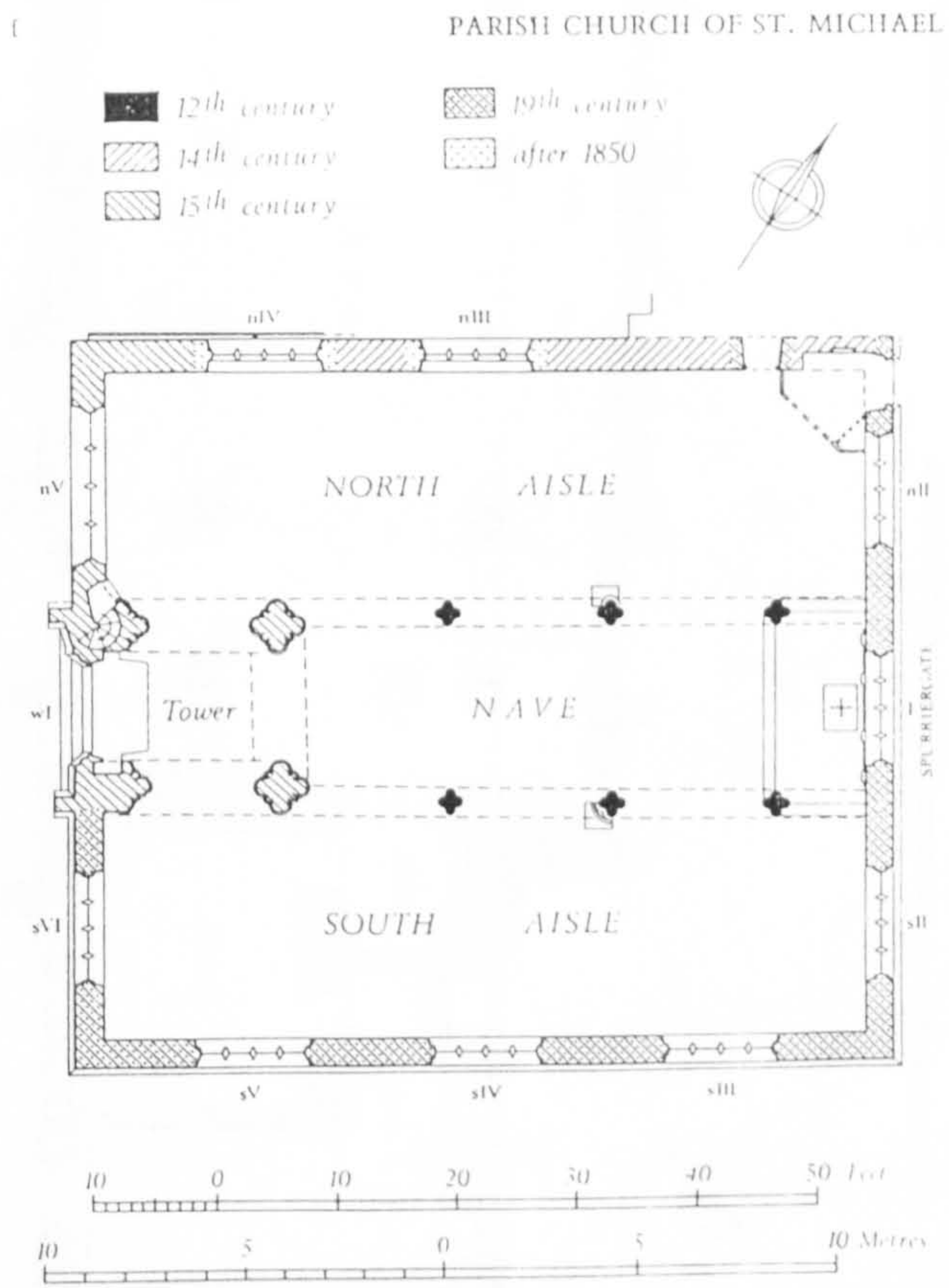


Fig. 27. (13) Church of St. Michael, Spurrergate.

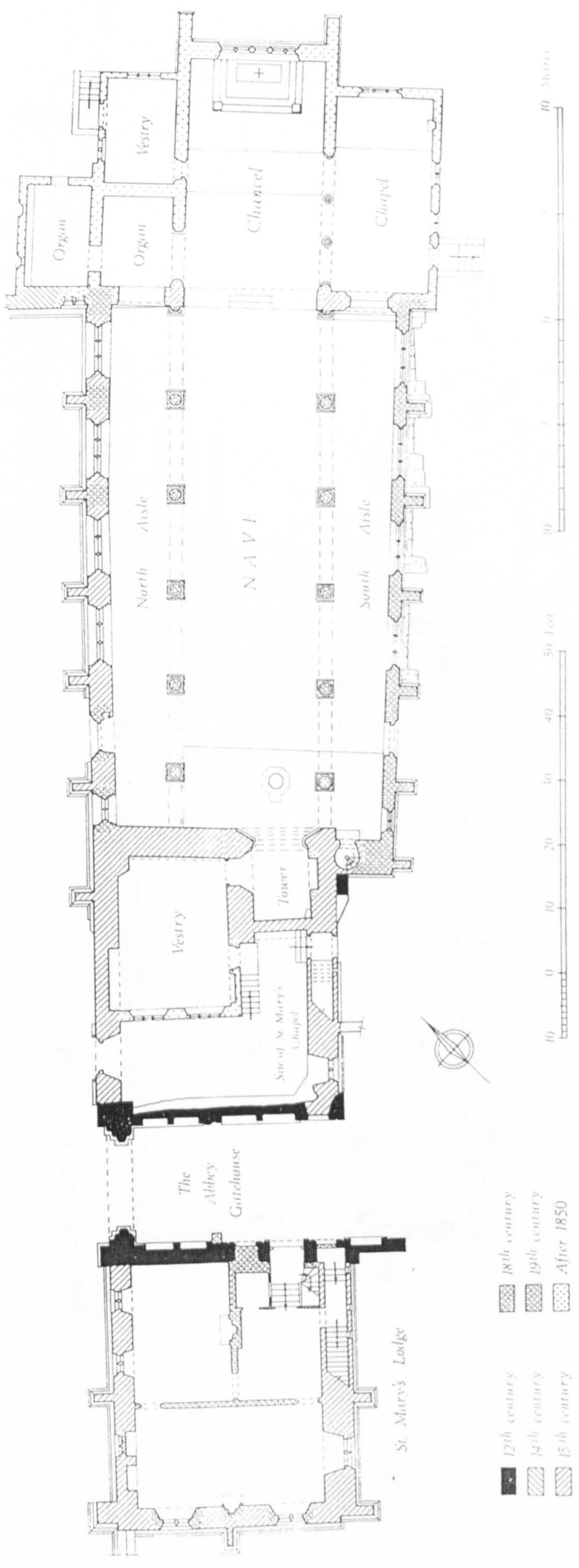


Fig. 28. (4) St. Mary's Abbey, Gatchouse. (9) Church of St. Olave.

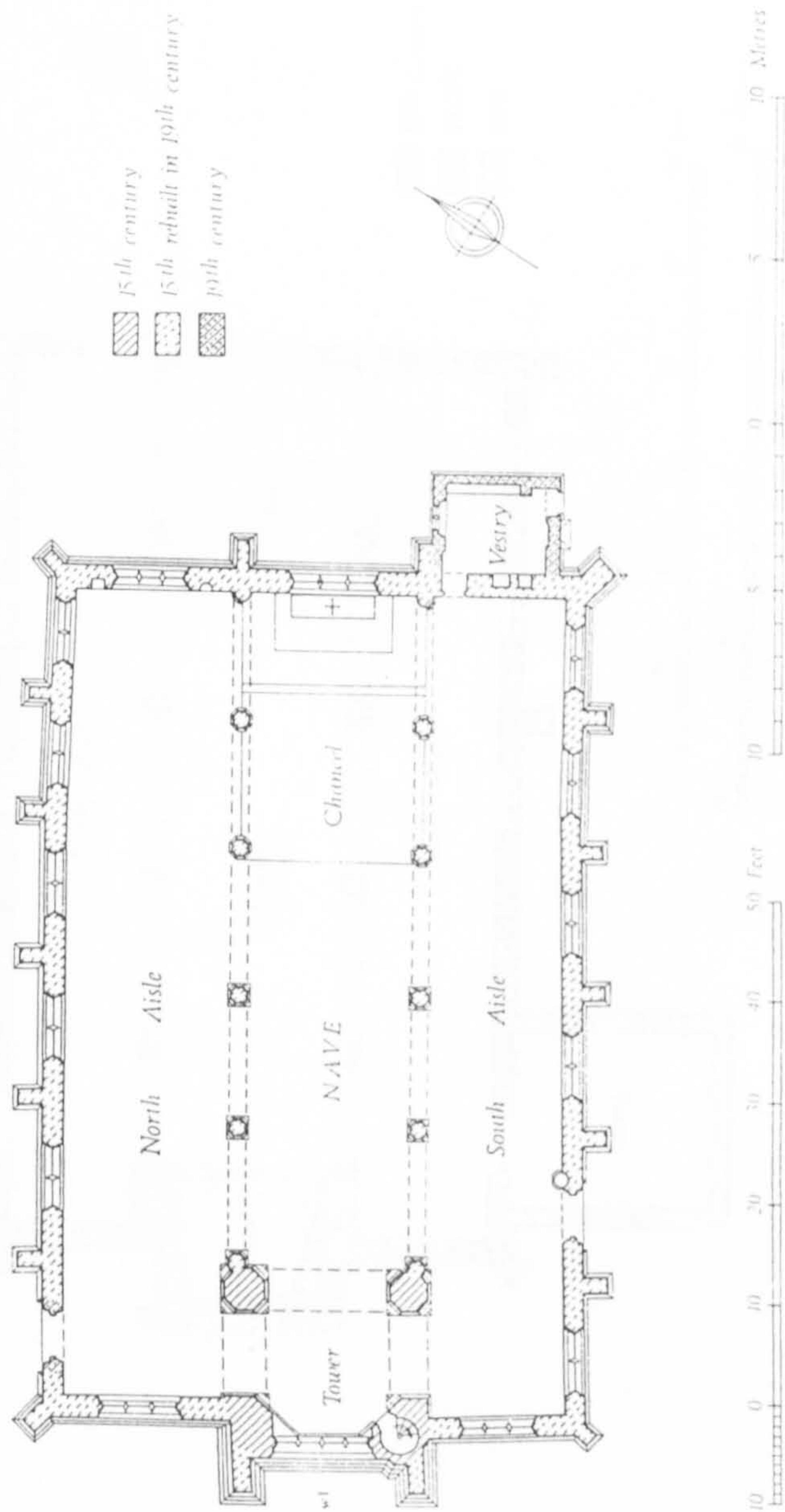


Fig. 28. (14) Church of St. Sampson, before conversion.

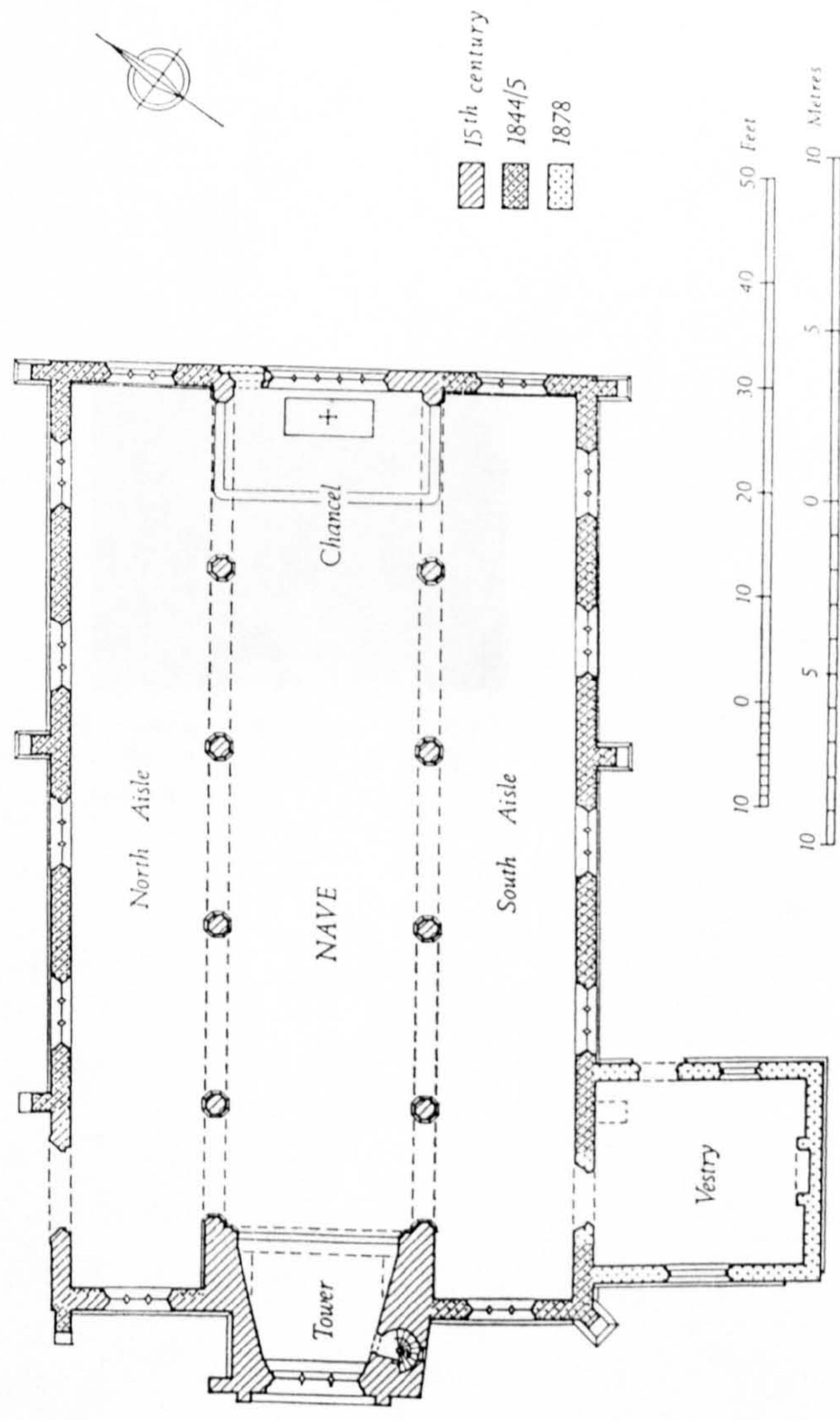


Fig. 29. (15) Church of St. Saviour.

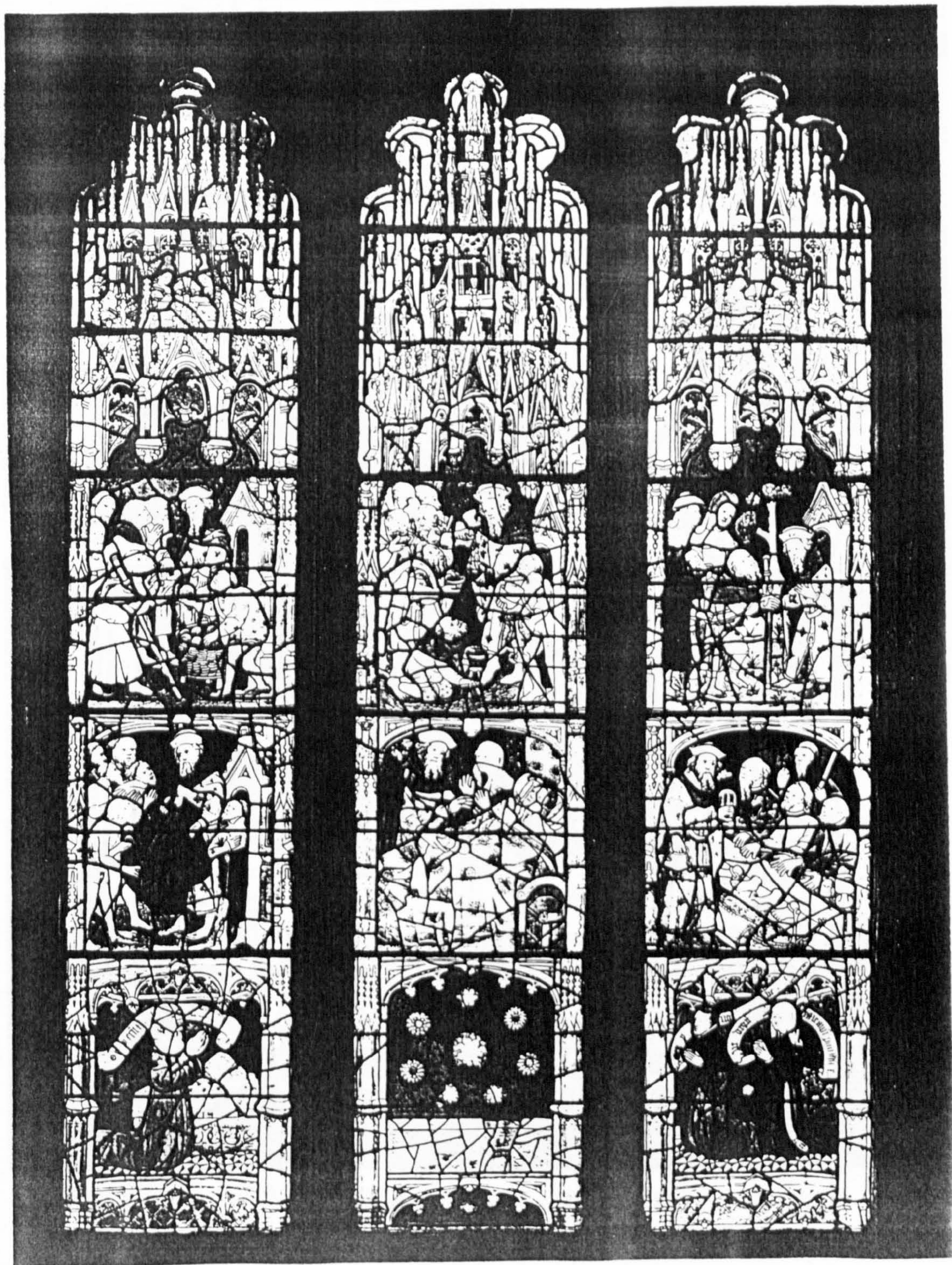


Window III. The Prick of Conscience. n III
