
- Fig. 28 Book of Hours, Matins, *Annunciation with Birth of the Virgin*, and related scenes, printed by Jehannot in [Paris], 1492/93






**FIGURE 21**




**FIGURE 43**








Workshop of Andrea del Verrocchio, Marble relief showing death of Francesca Tornabuoni in childbirth, 1477
