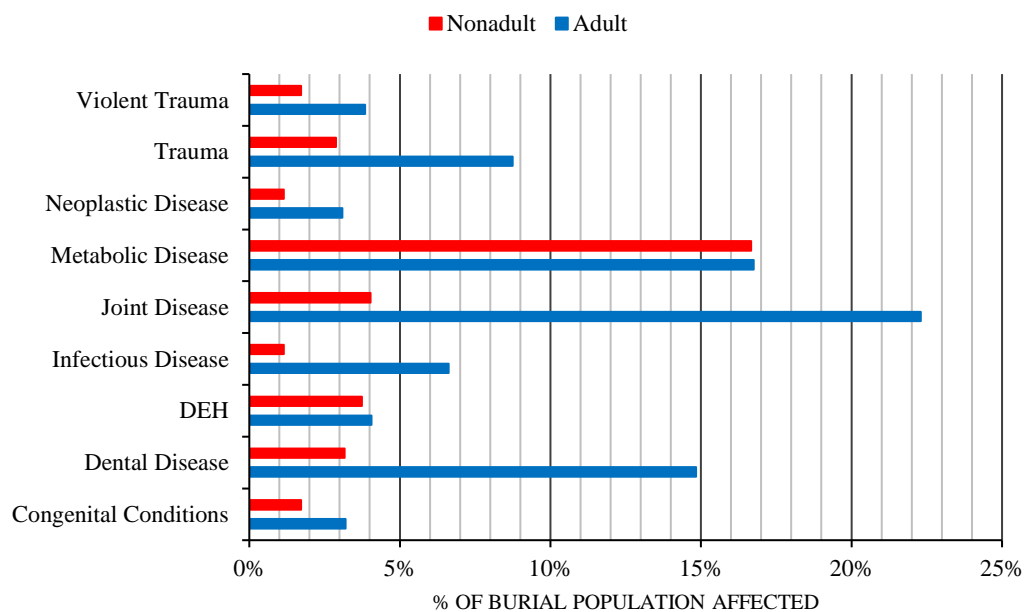
Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in the Neolithic (N=1291)



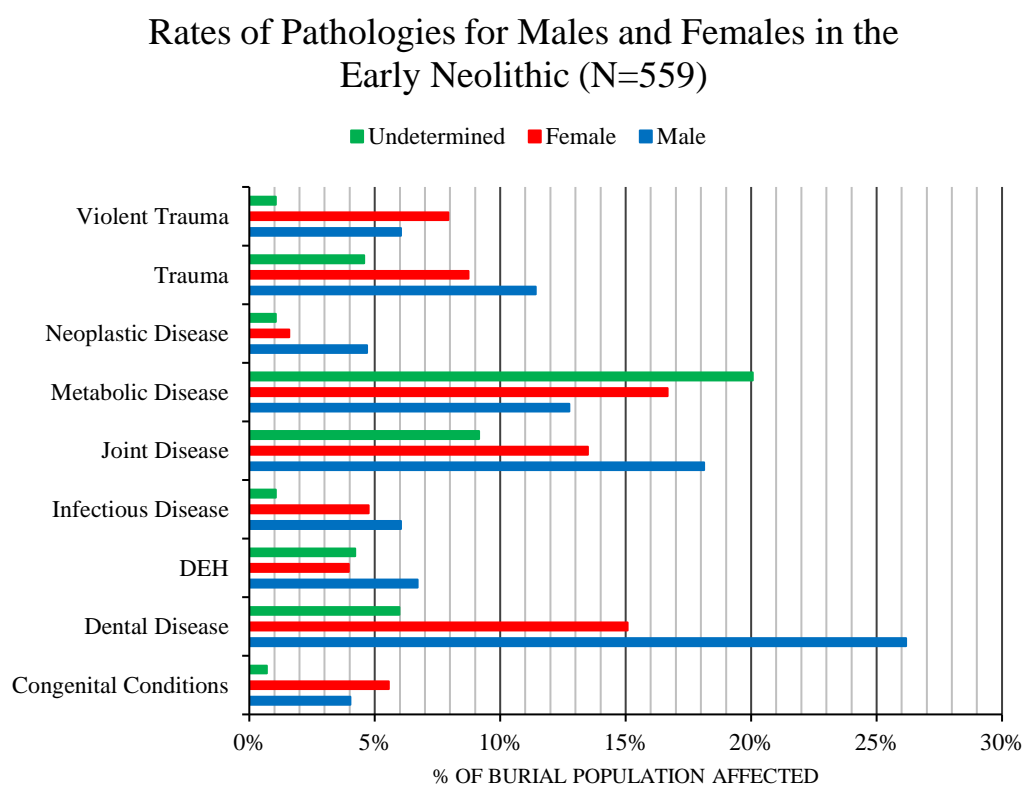
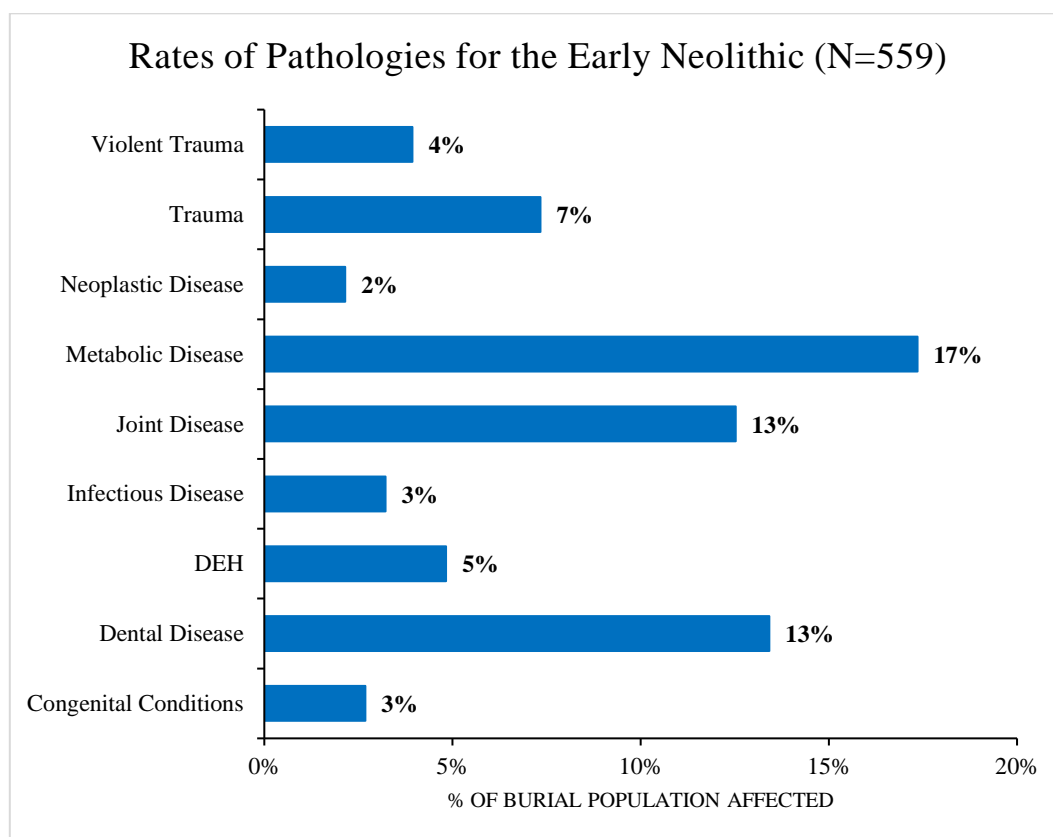
Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in the Neolithic (No Undetermined) (N=572)



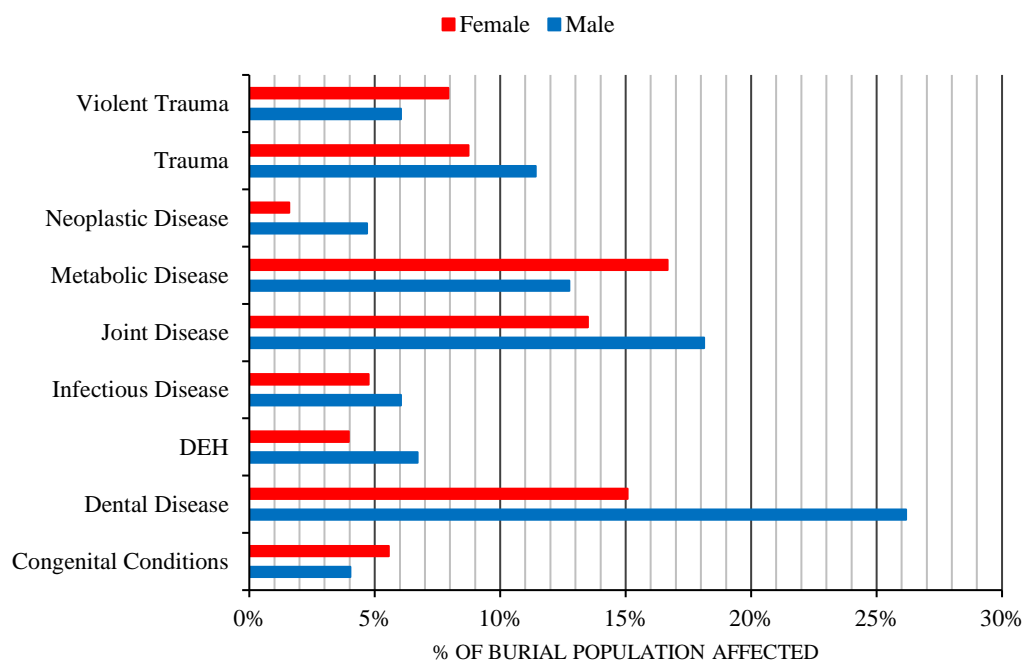
Rates of Pathologies for Adults and Nonadults in the Neolithic (N=1285)



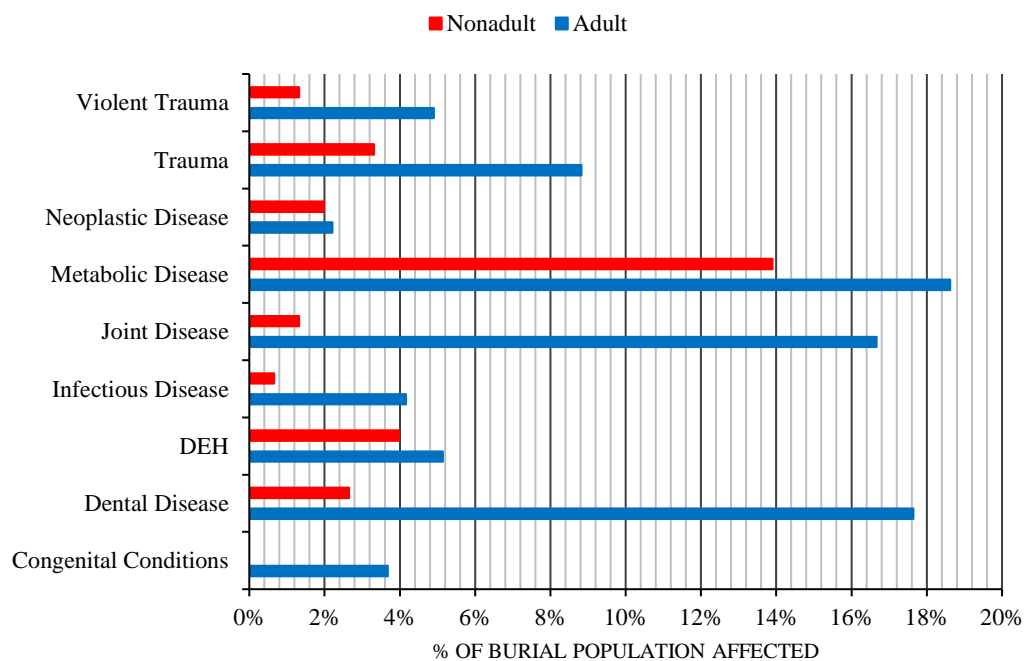

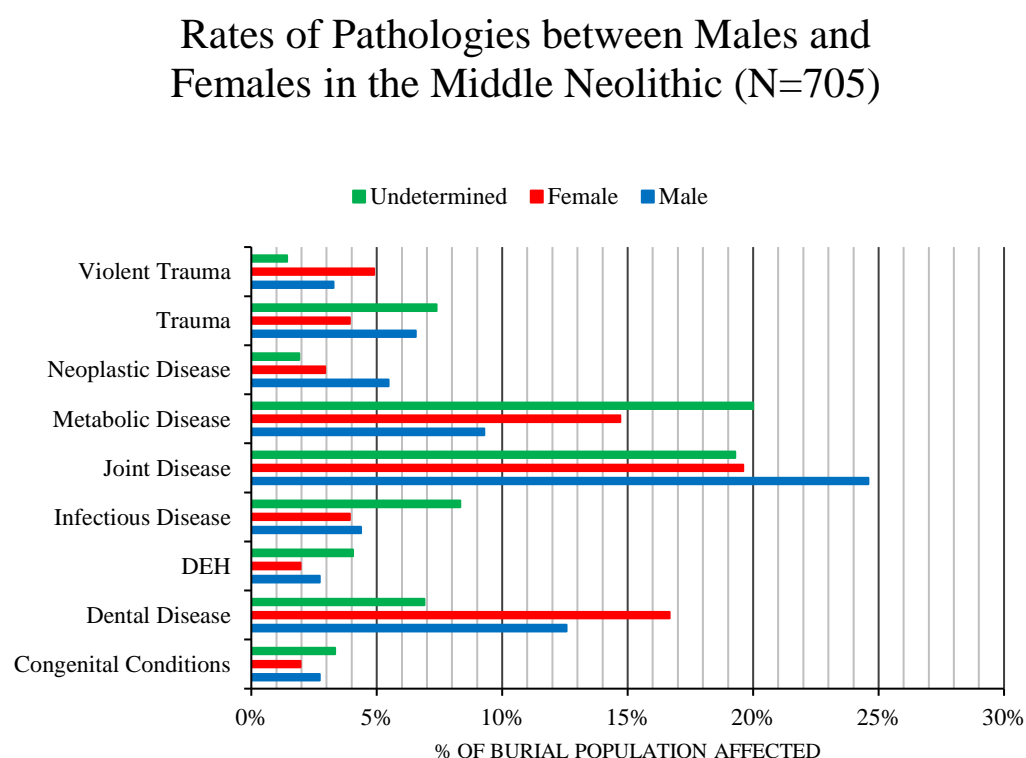
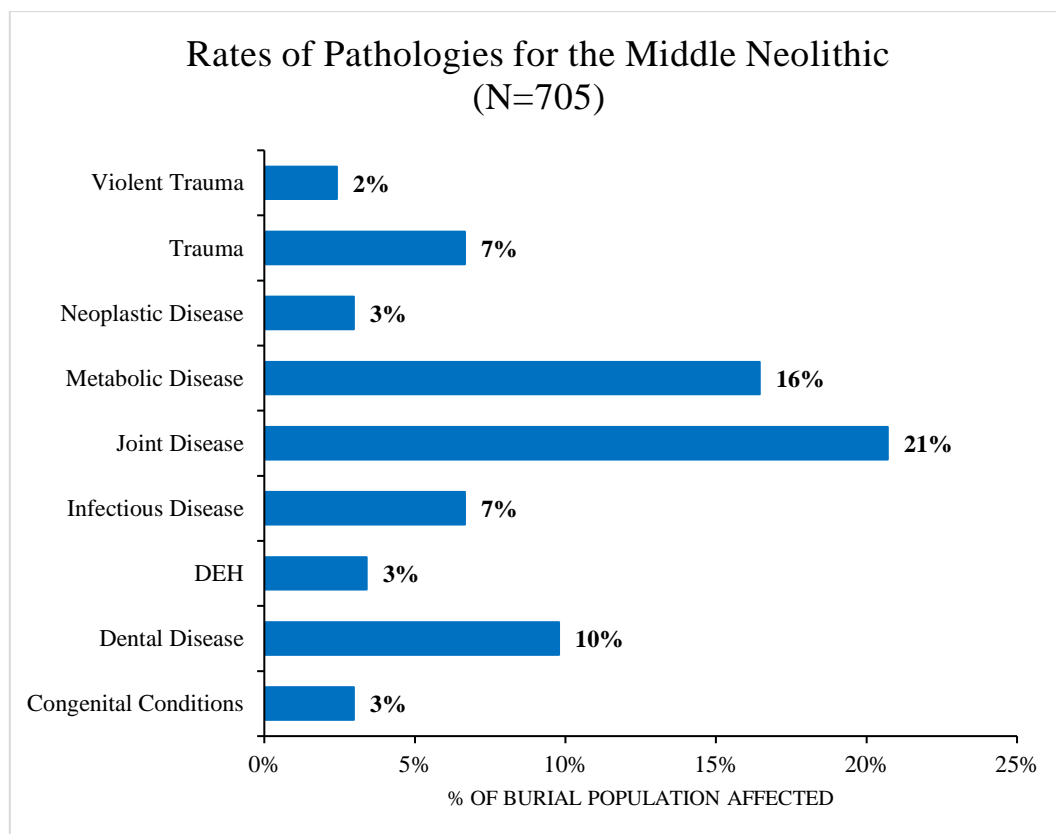


Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in the Early Neolithic (No Undetermined) (N=275)

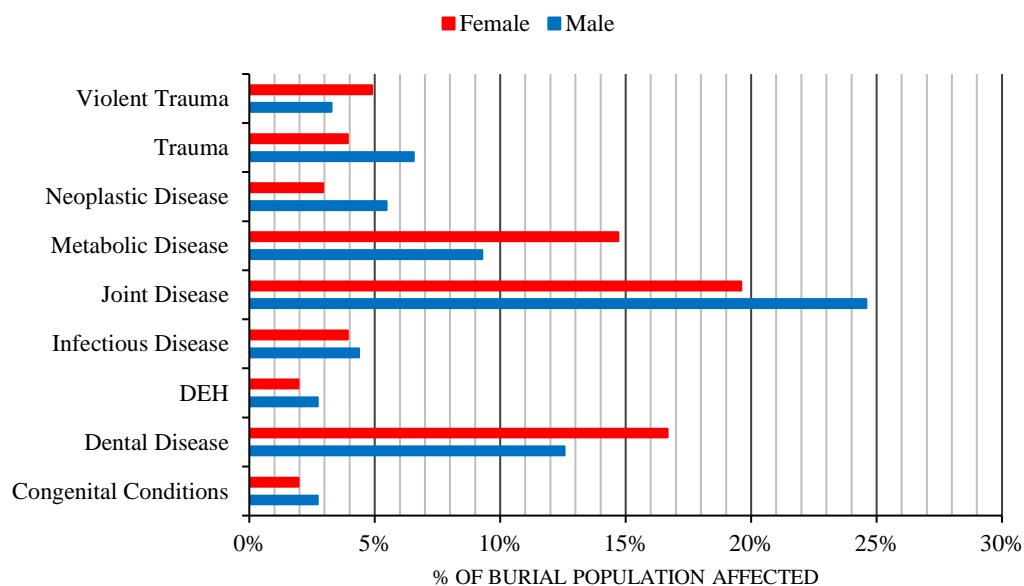


Rates of Pathologies for Adults and Nonadults in the Early Neolithic (N=559)

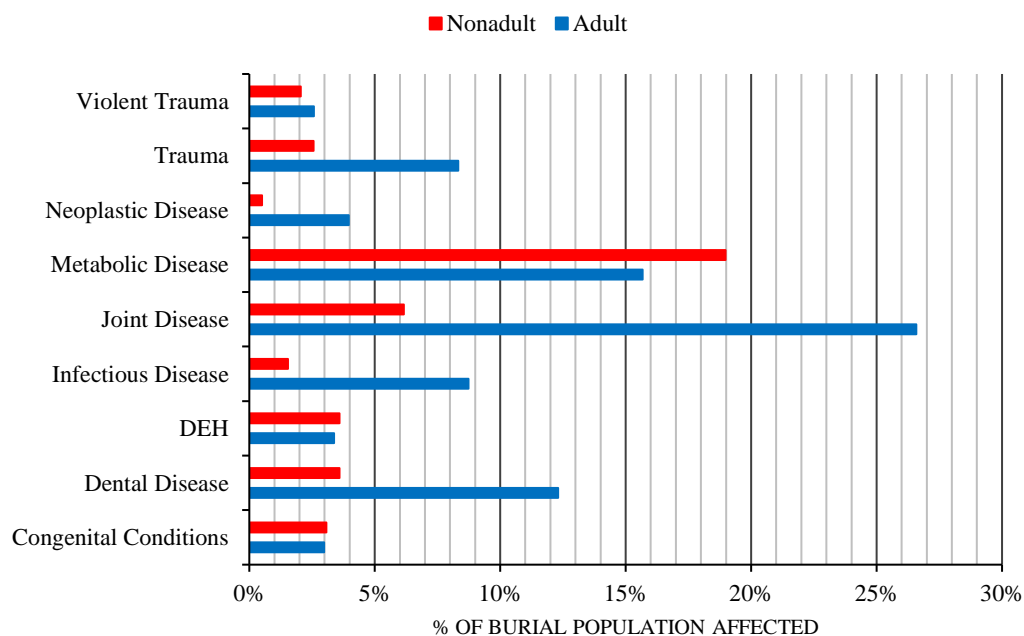


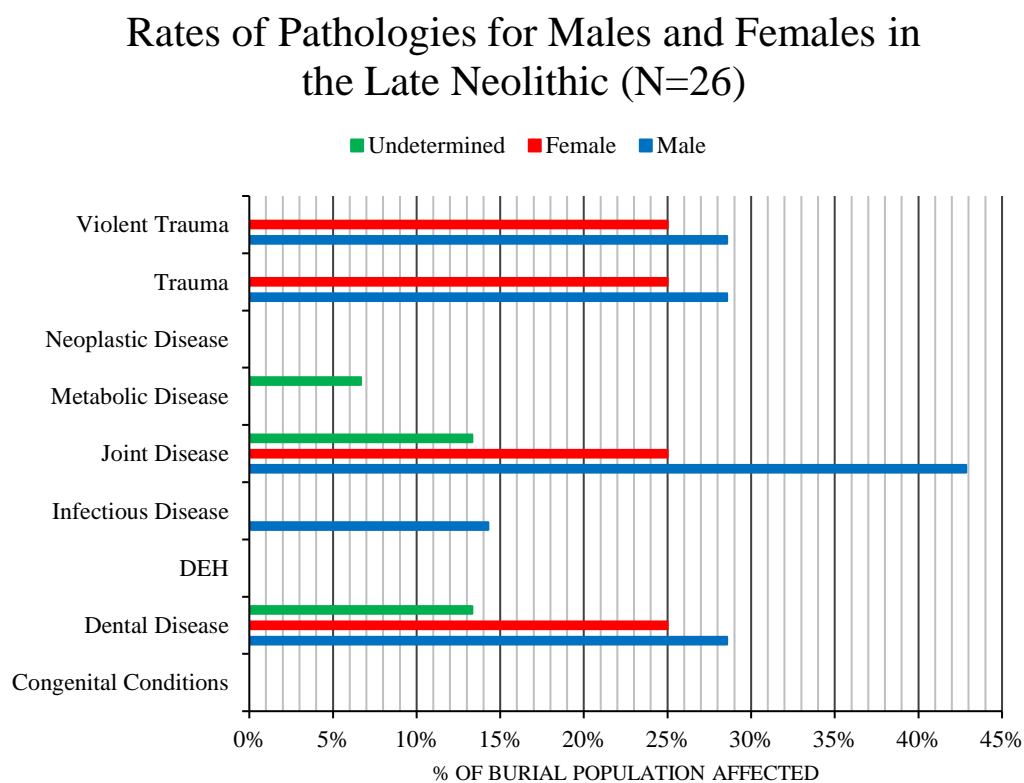
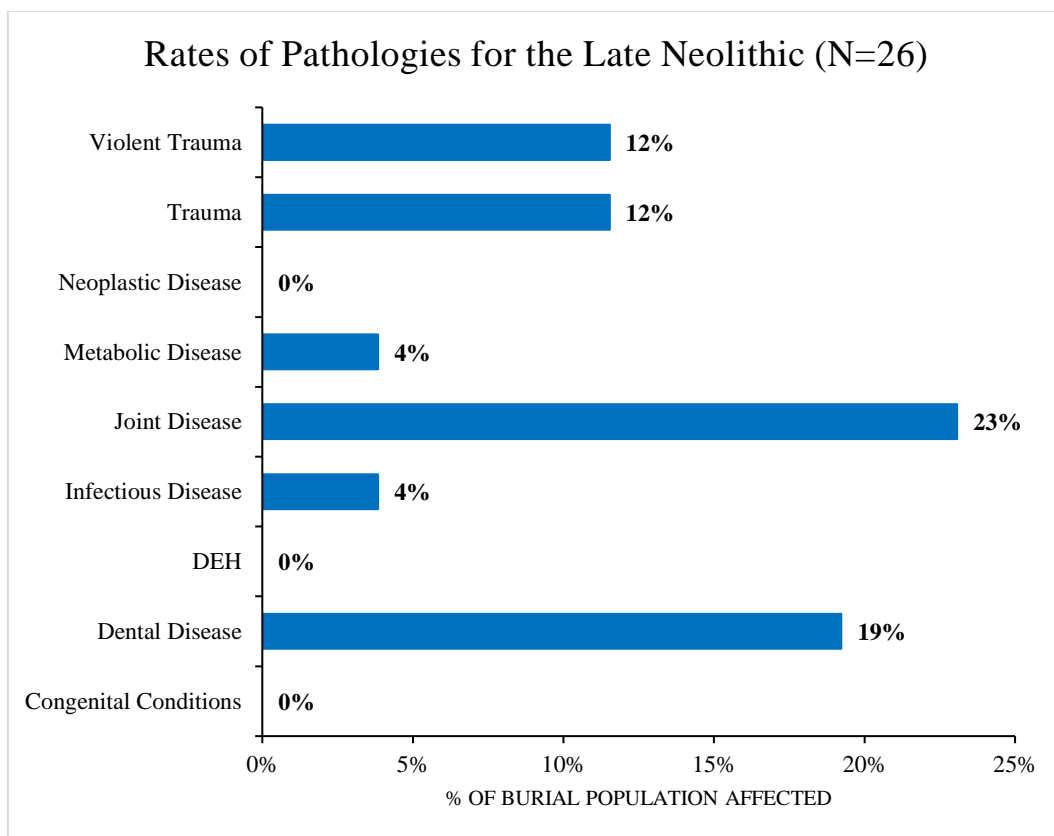


Rates of Pathologies between Males and Females in the Middle Neolithic (No Undetermined) (N=285)

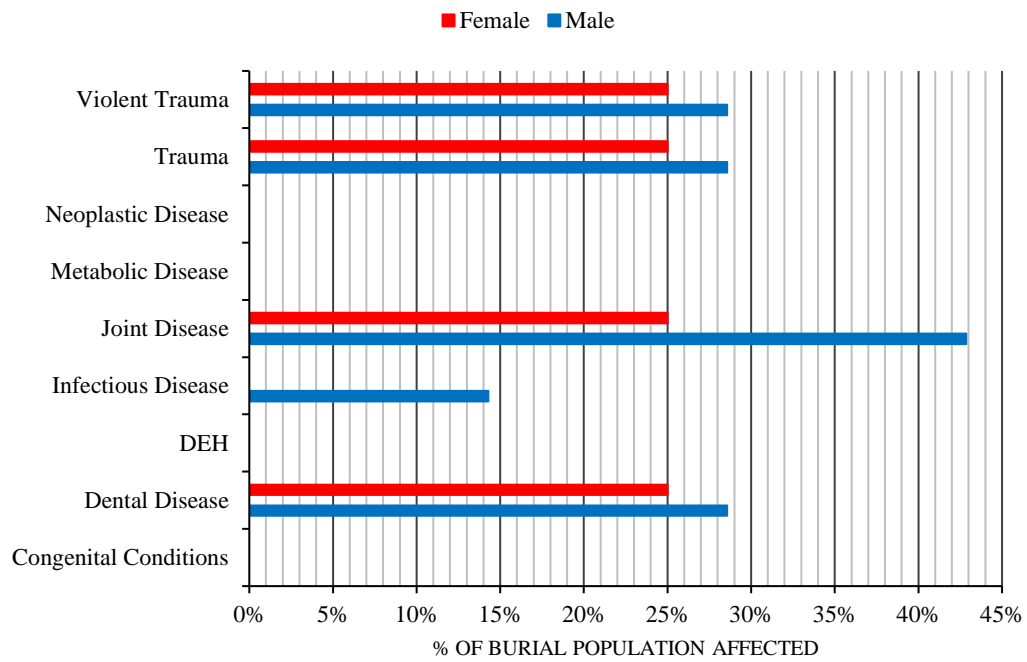


Rates of Pathologies for Adults and Nonadults in the Middle Neolithic (N=699)

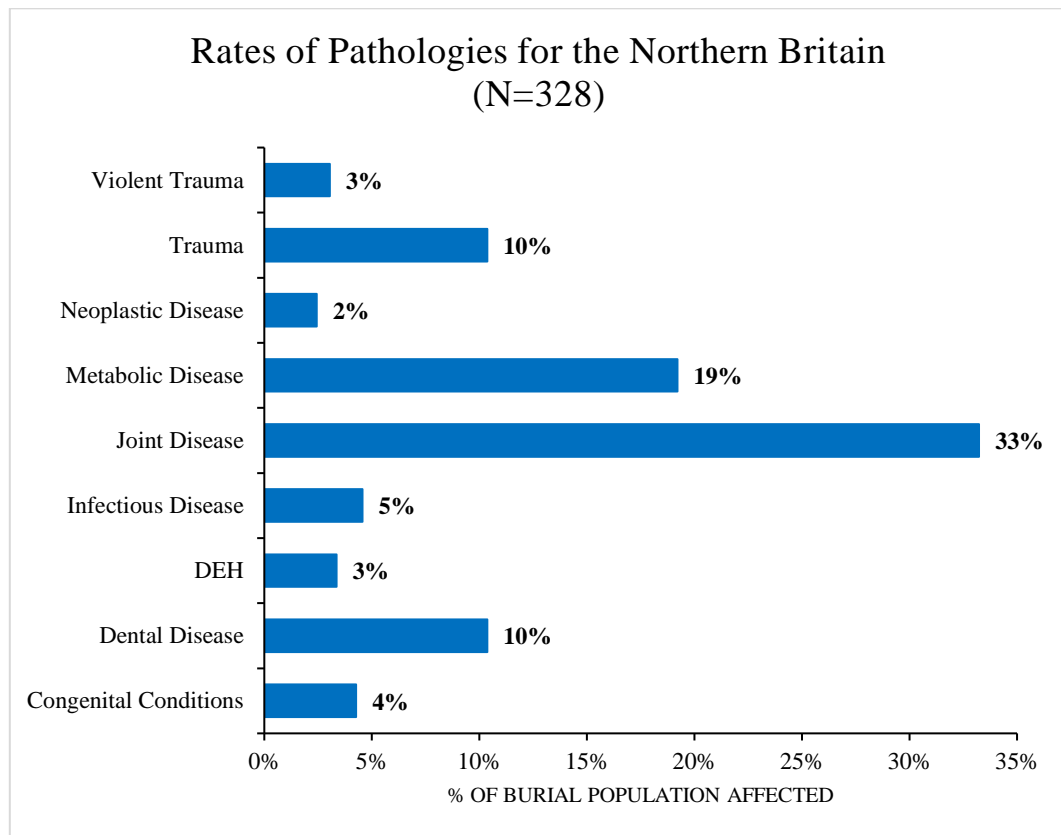




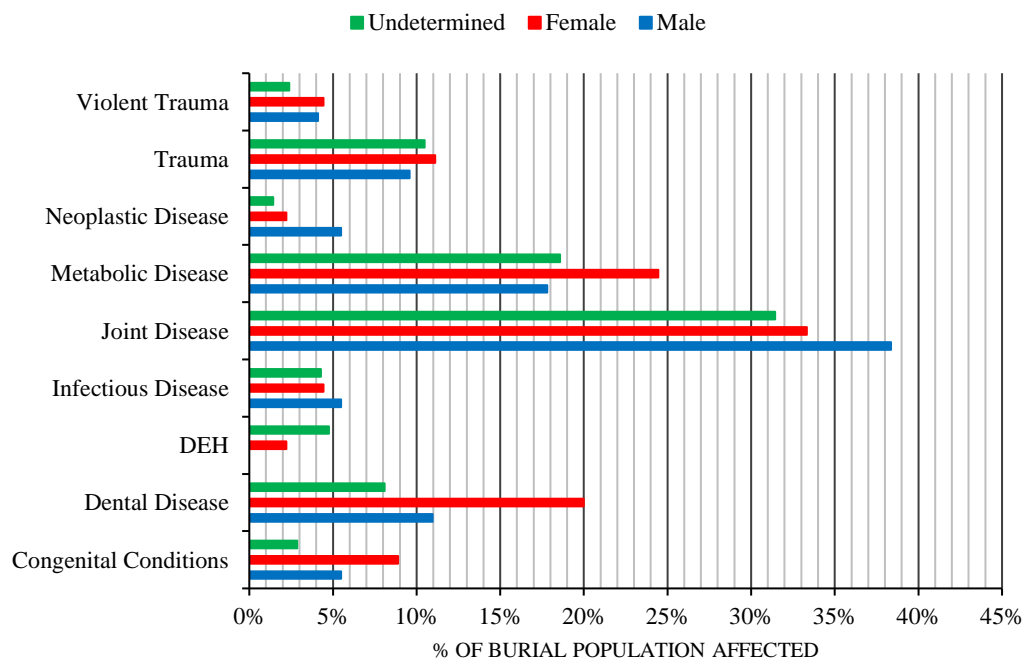
Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in the Late Neolithic (No Undetermined) (N=11)



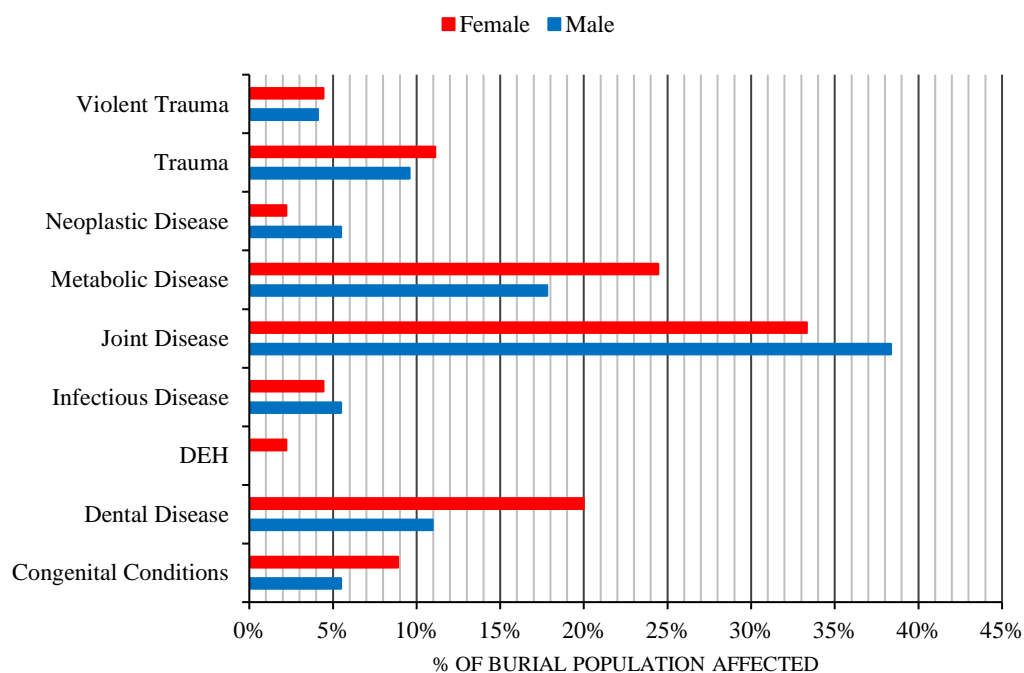

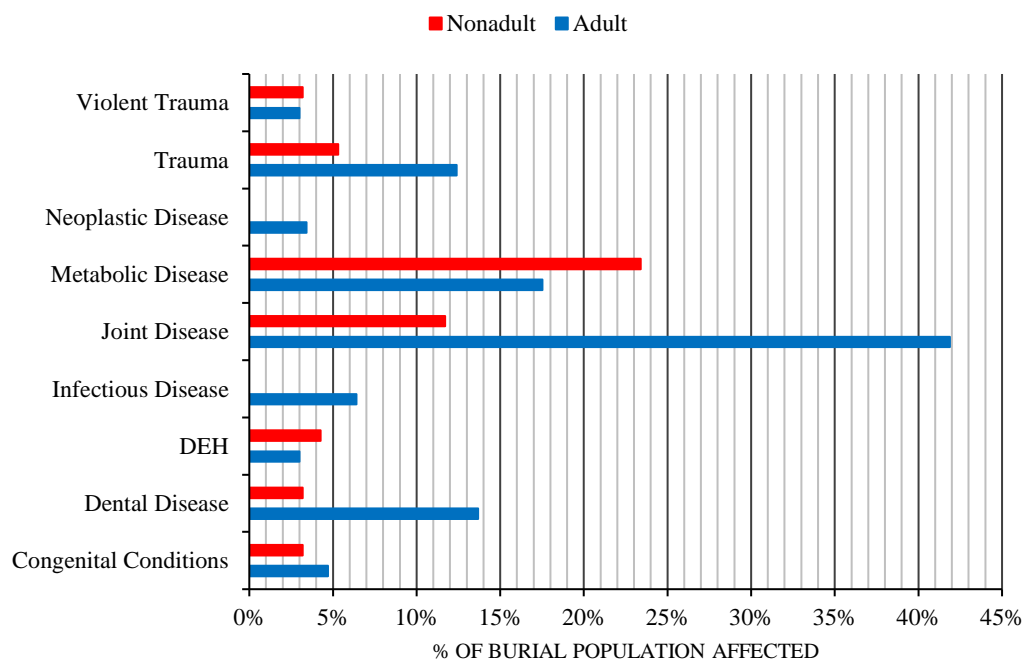
Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in Northern Britain (N=328)

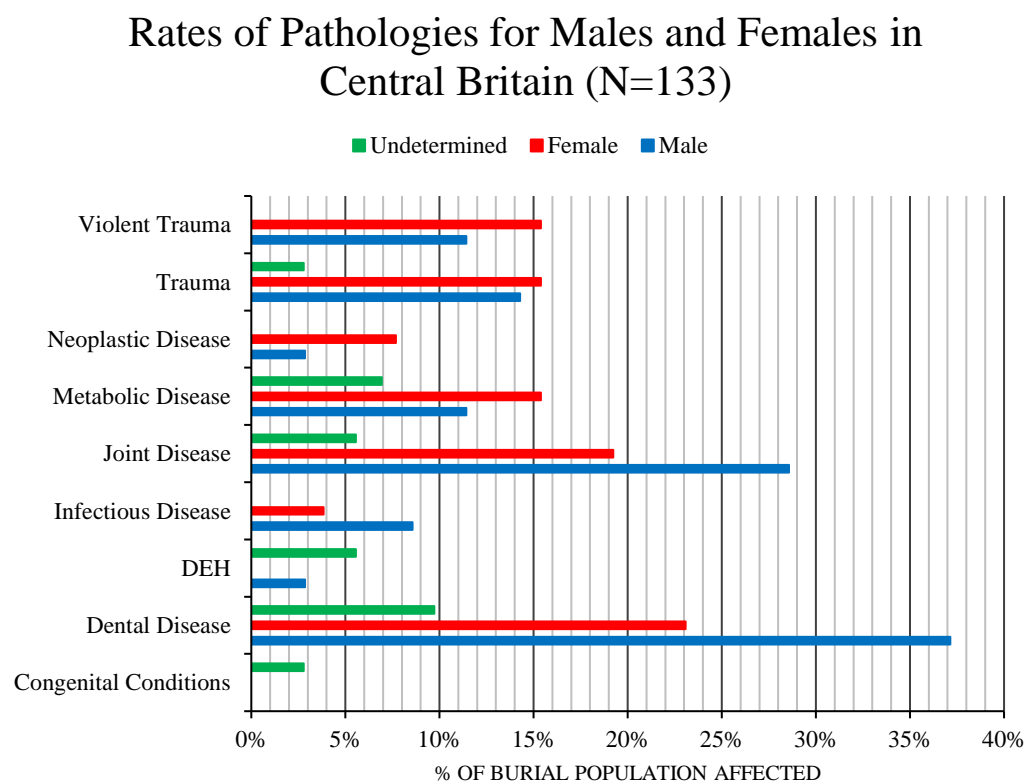
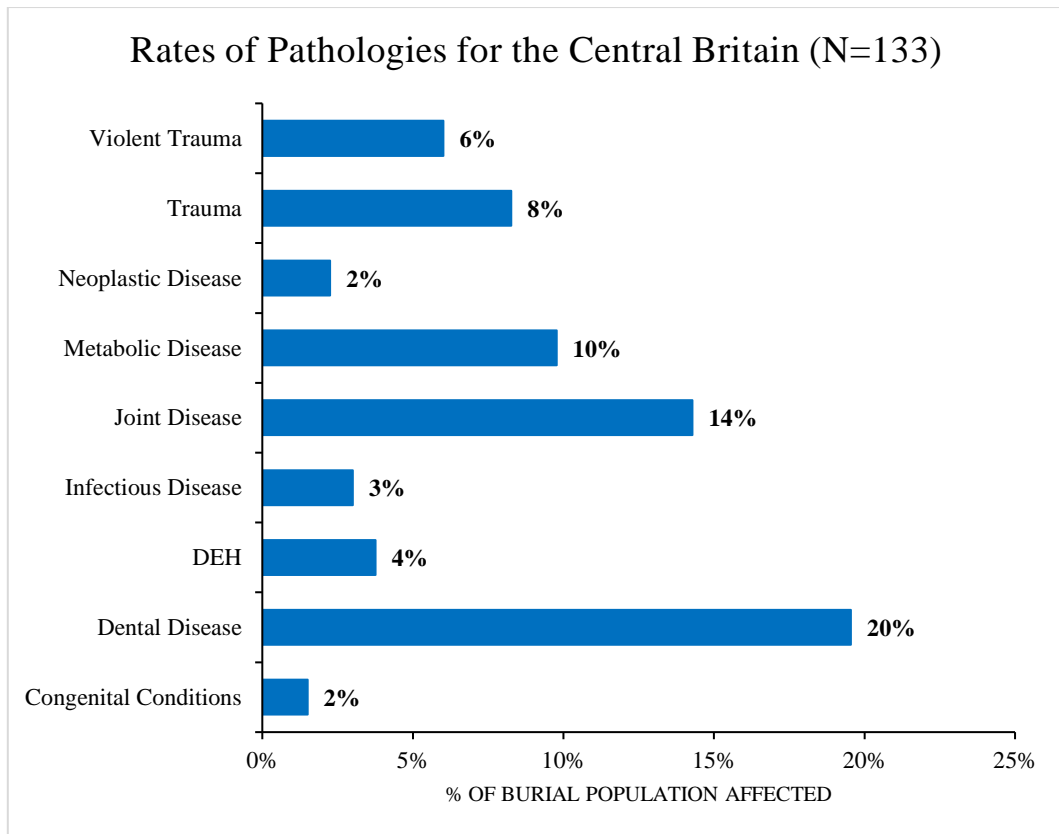


Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in Northern Britain (No Undetermined) (N=118)

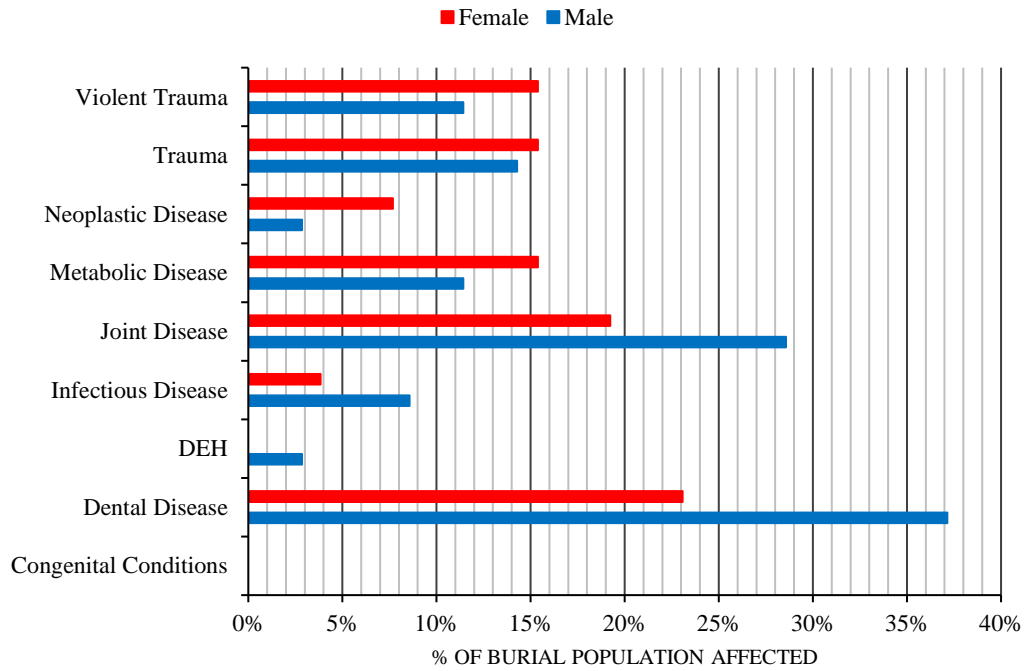


Rates of Pathologies for Adults and Nonadults in Northern Britain (N=328)

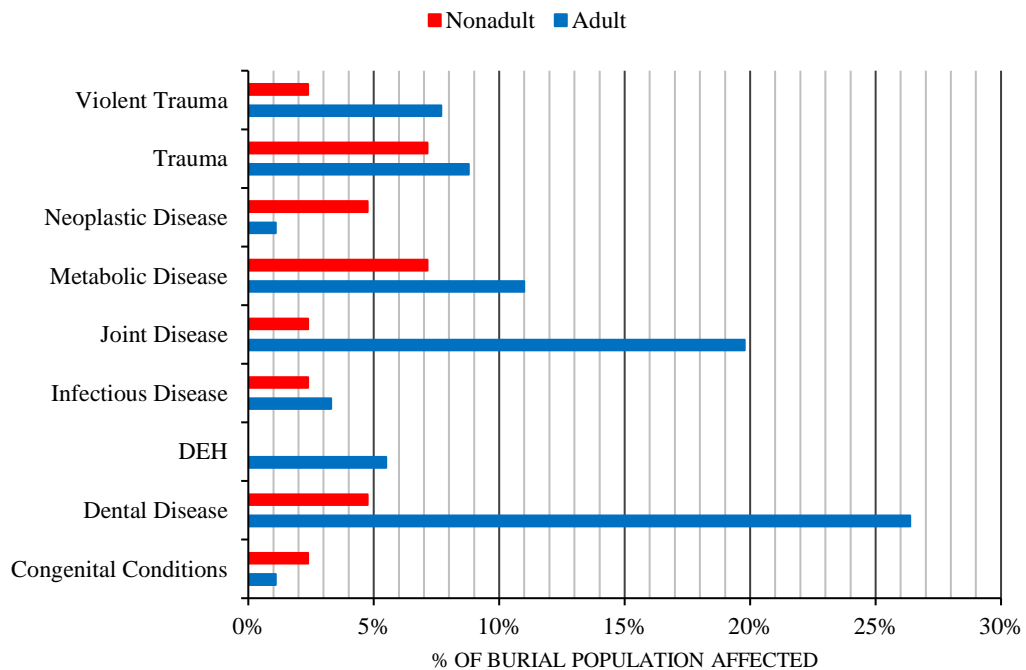


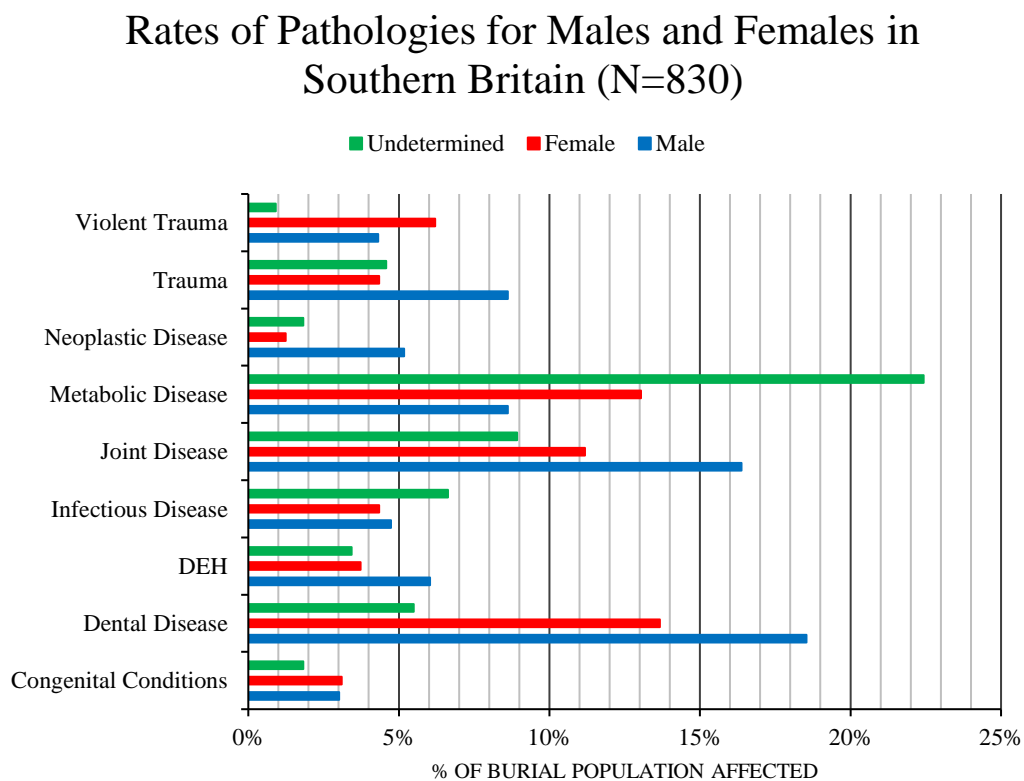
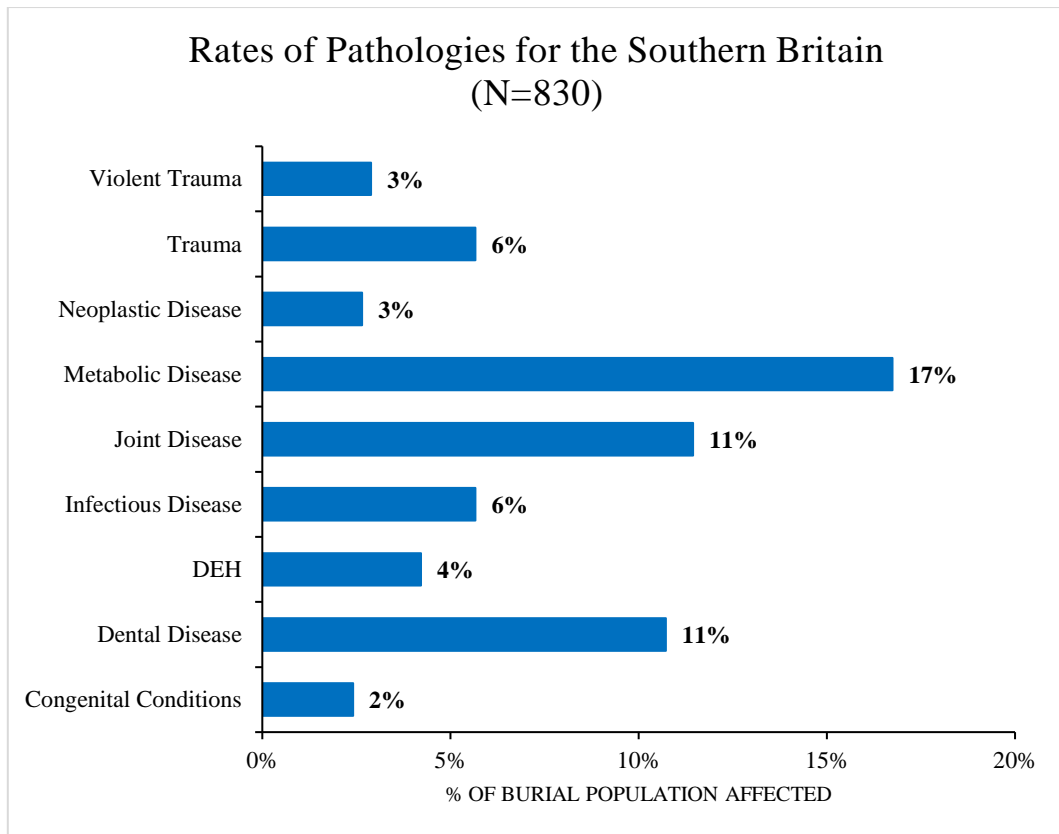


Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in Central Britain (No Undetermined) (N=61)

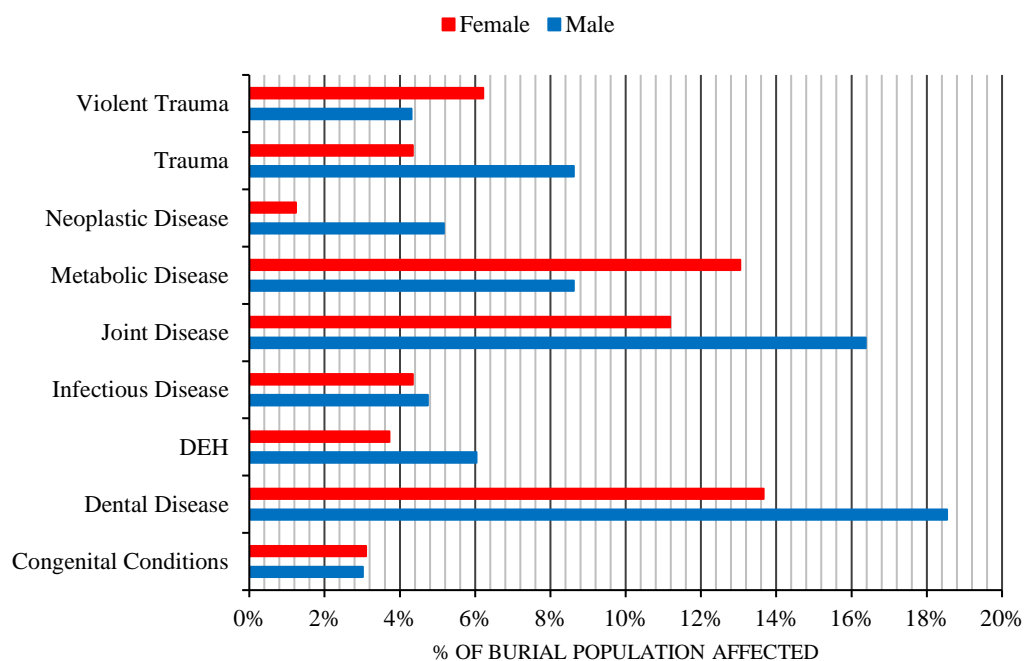


Rates of Pathologies for Adults and Nonadults in Central Britain (N=133)

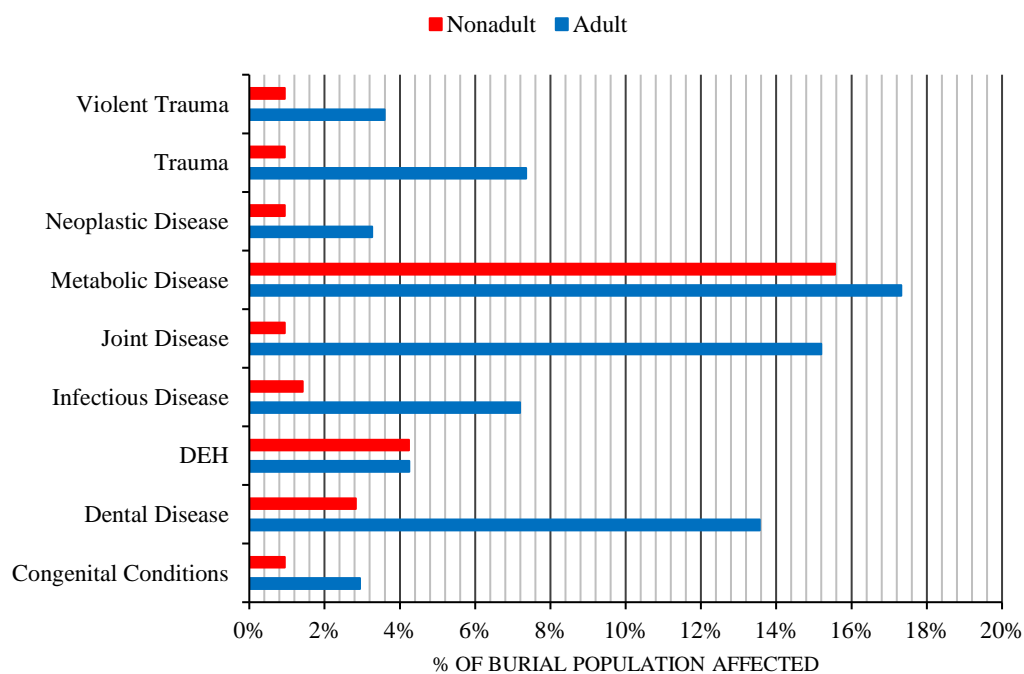




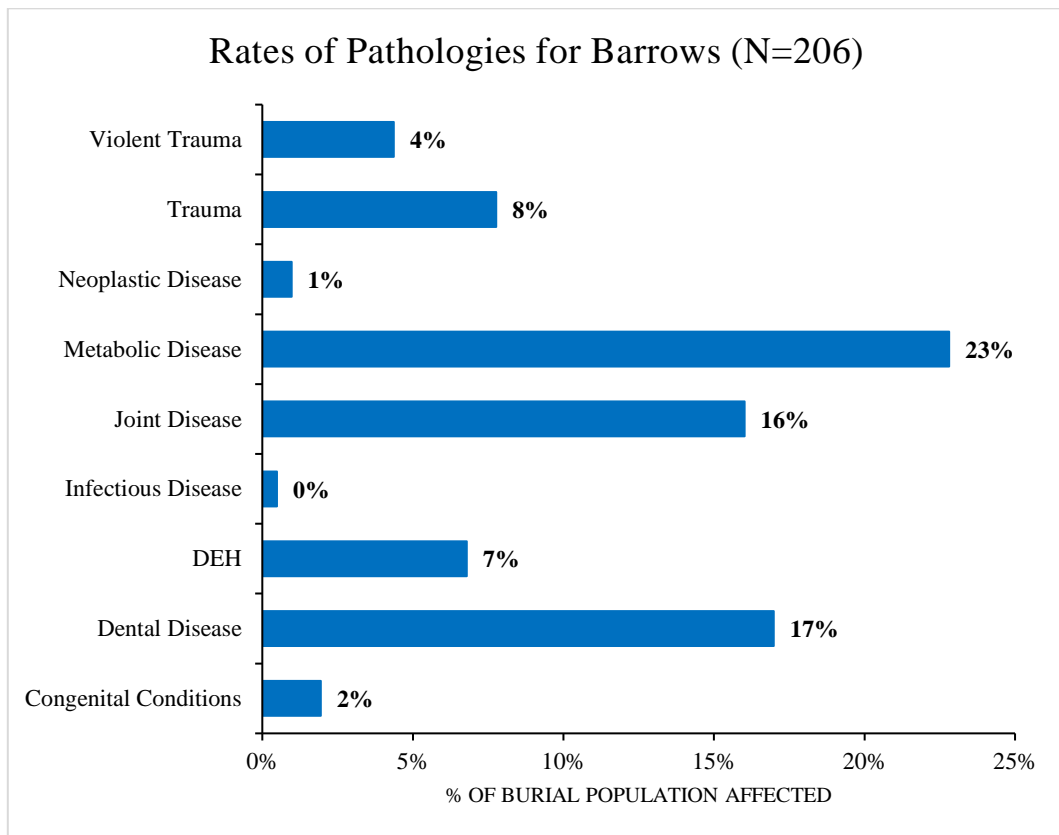
Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in Southern Britain (No Undetermined) (N=393)



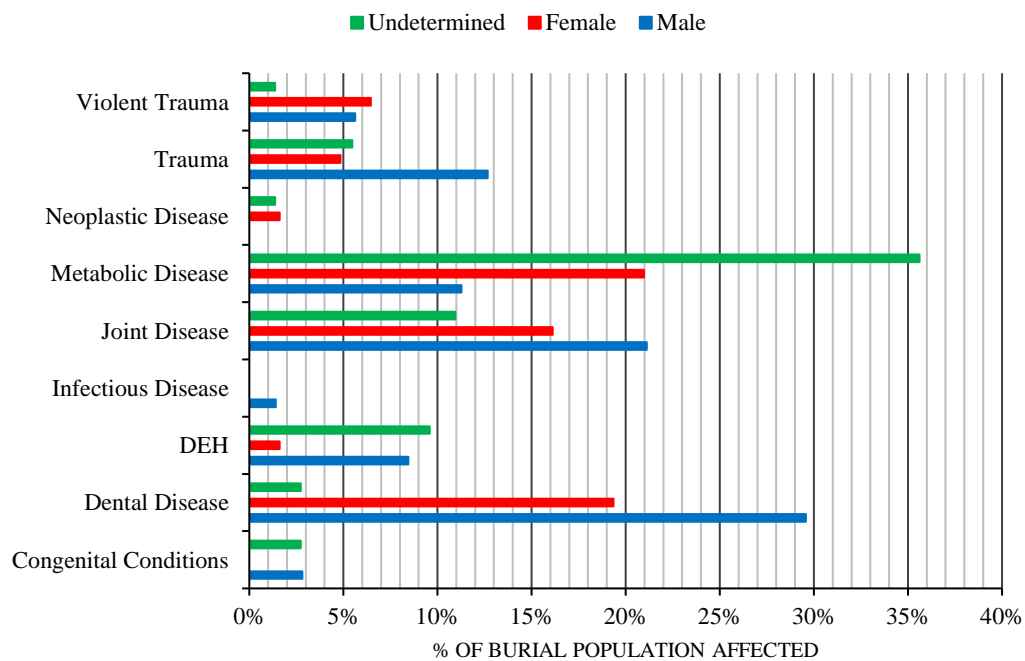
Rates of Pathologies for Adults and Nonadults in Southern Britain (N=824)



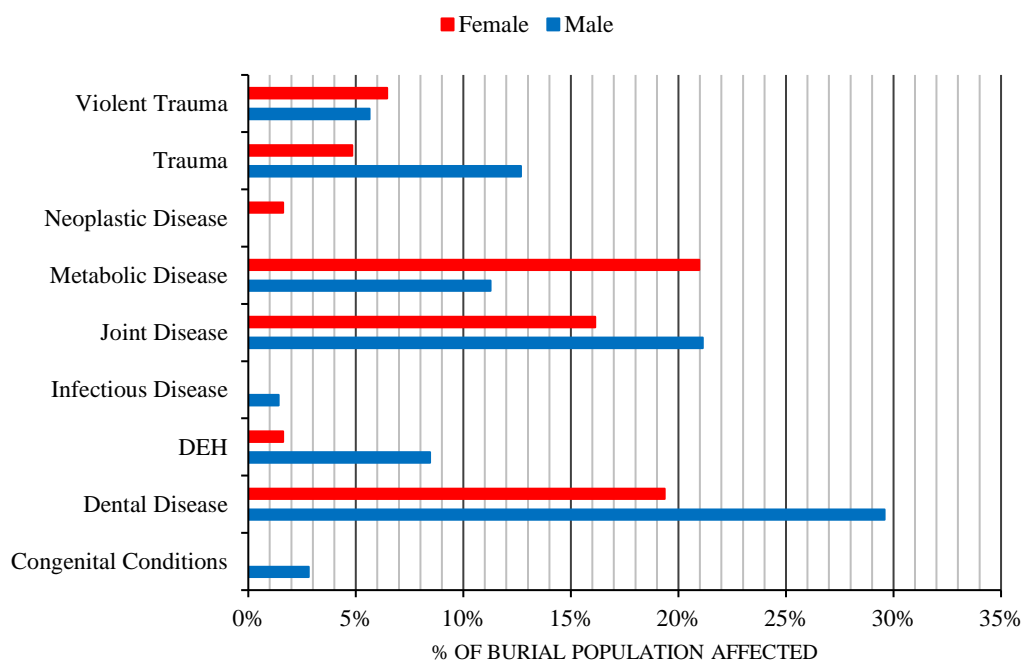

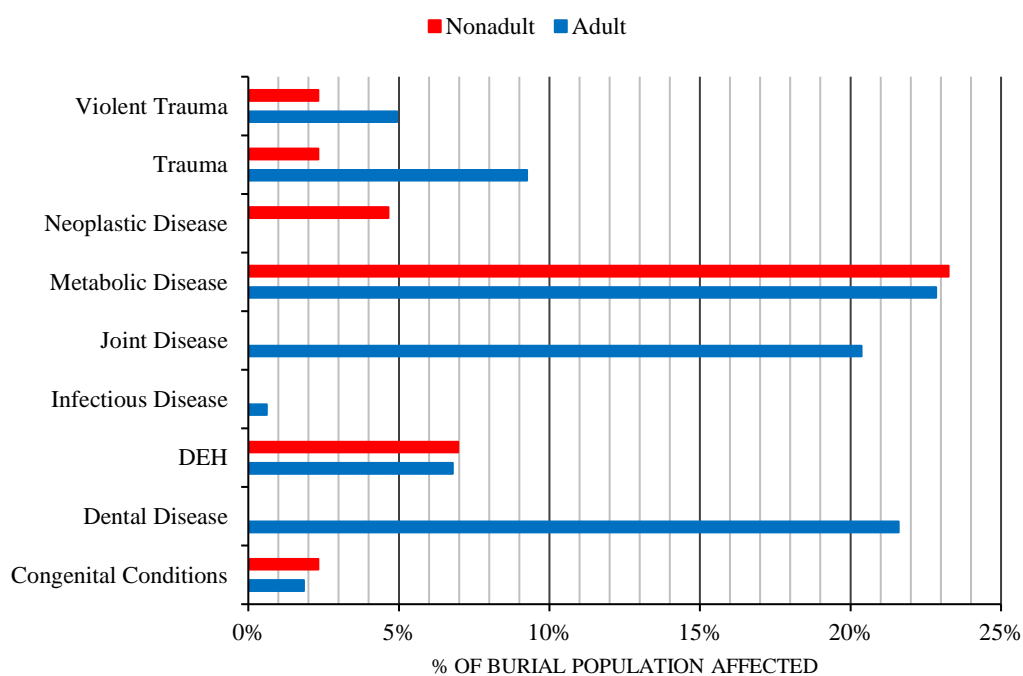
Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in Barrows (N=206)

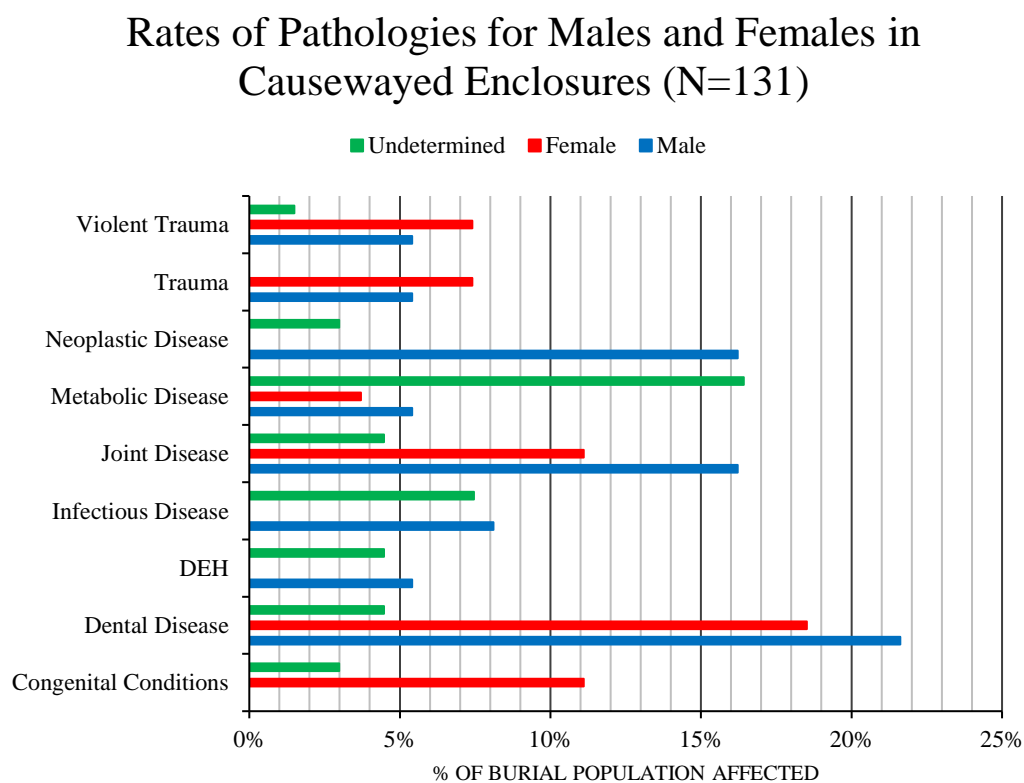
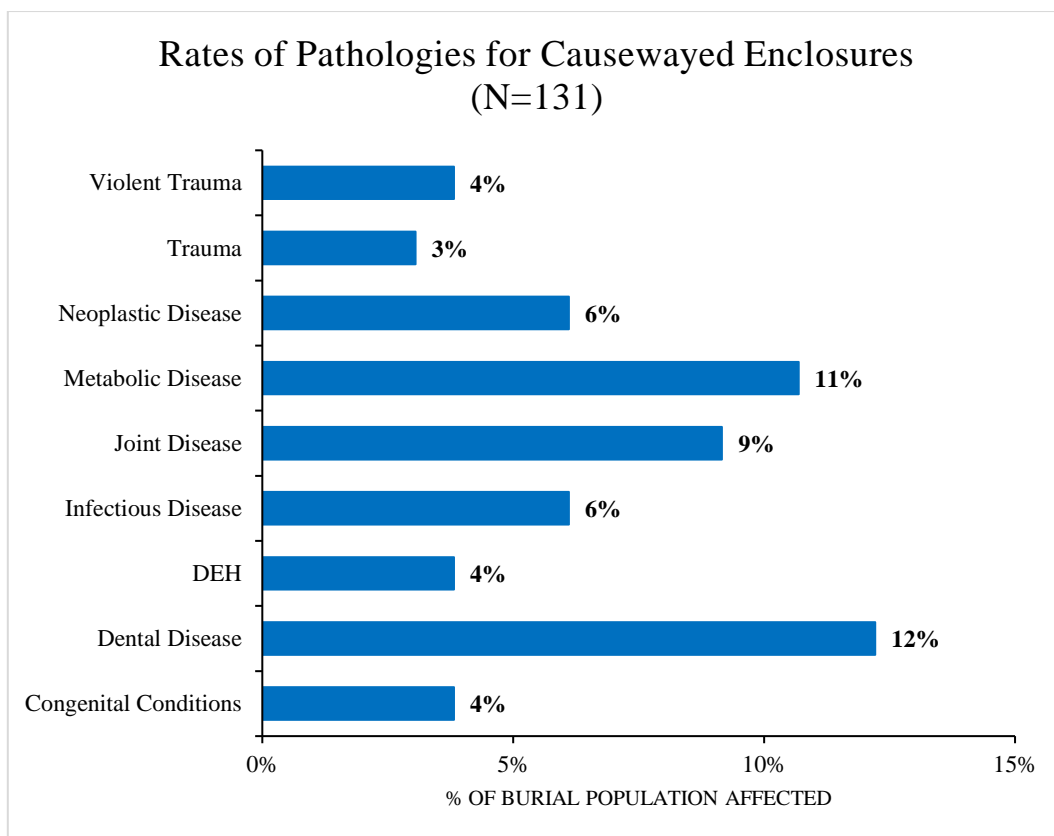


Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in Barrows (No Undetermined) (N=133)

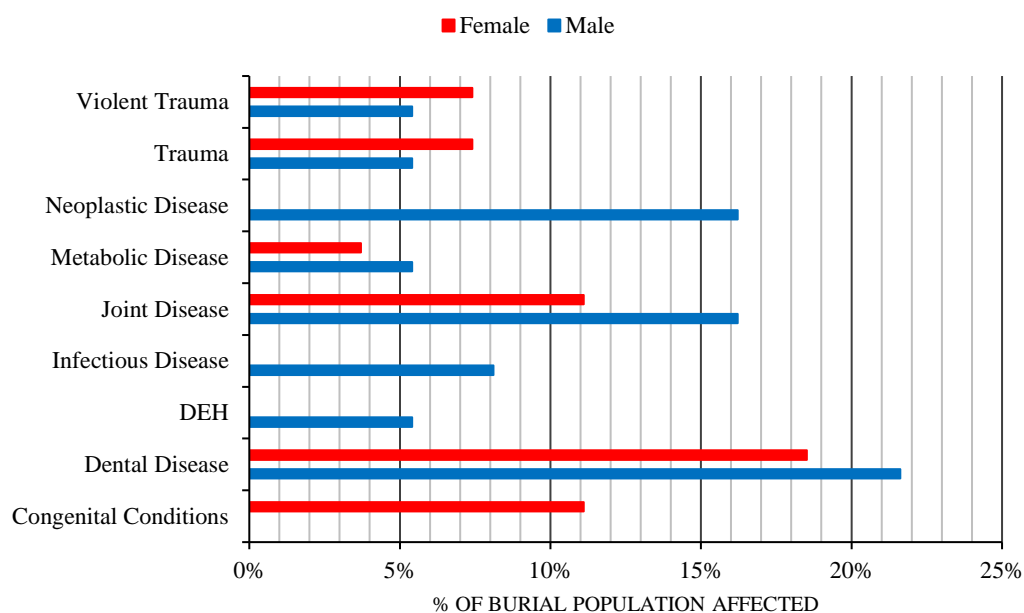


Rates of Pathologies for Adults and Nonadults in Barrows (N=205)

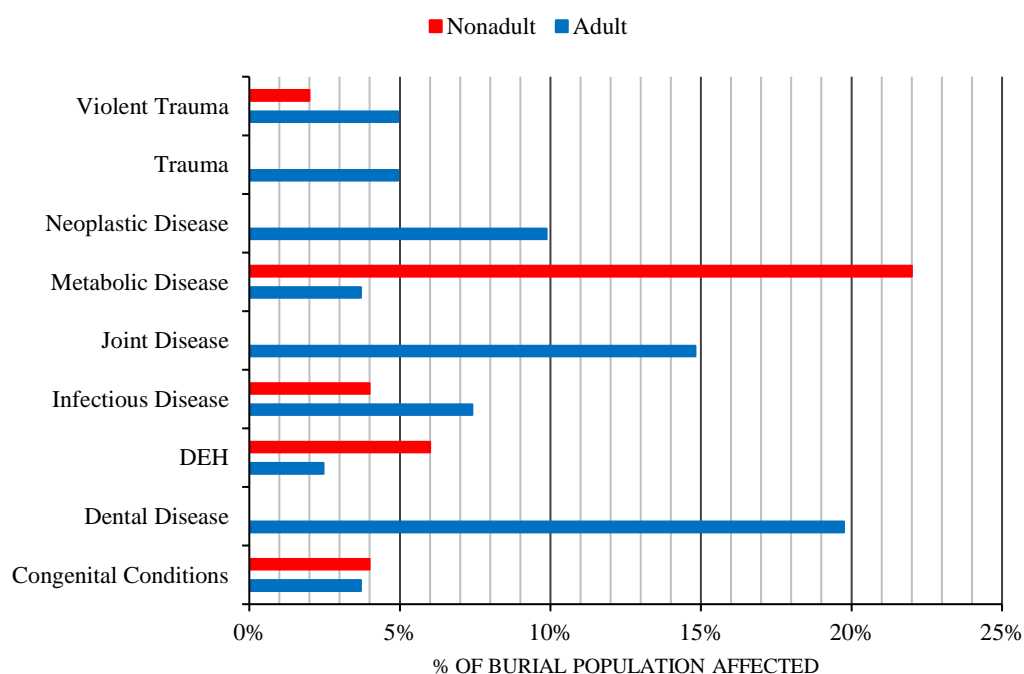


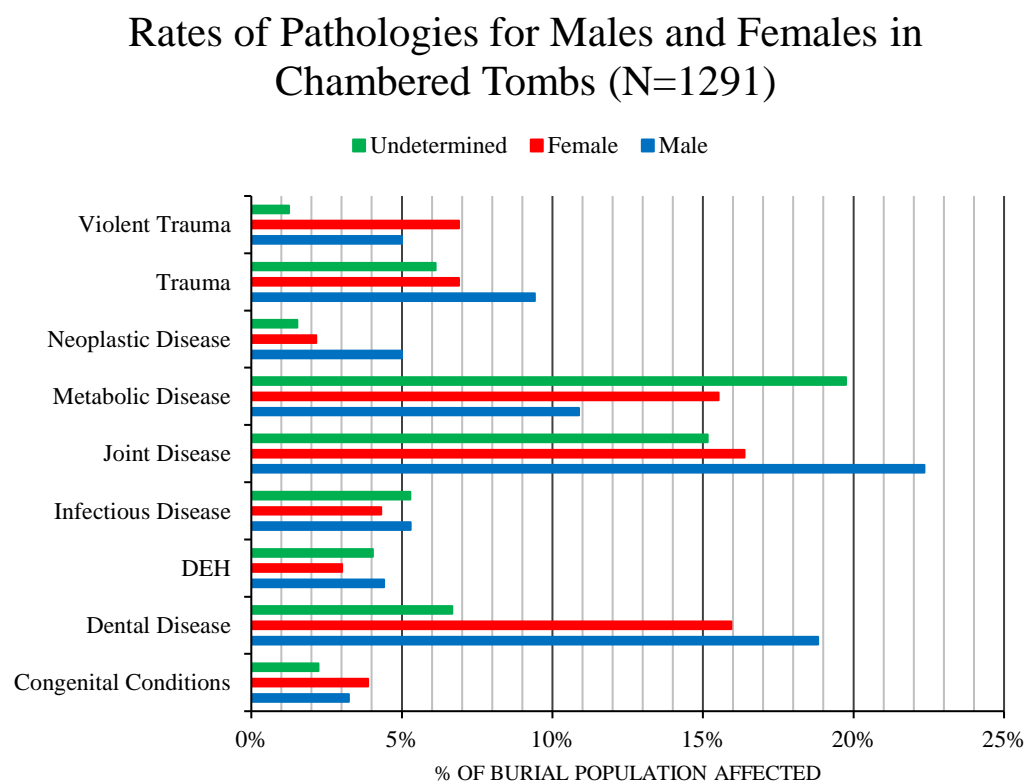
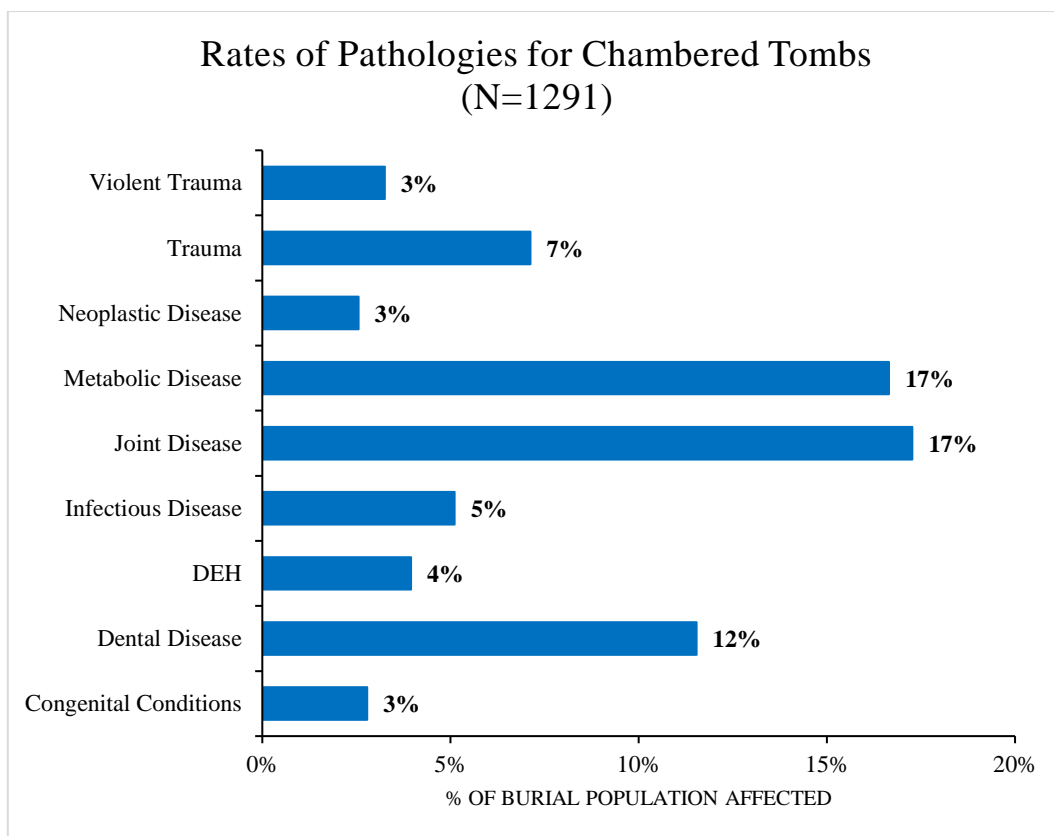


Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in Causewayed Enclosures (No Undetermined) (N=64)

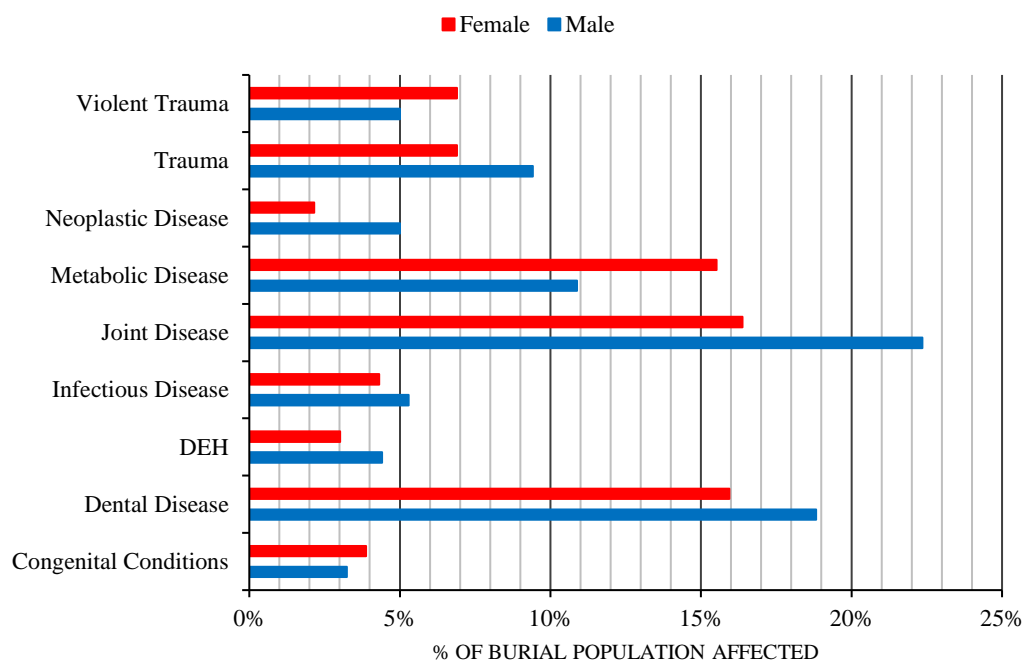


Rates of Pathologies for Adults and Nonadults in Causewayed Enclosures (N=131)

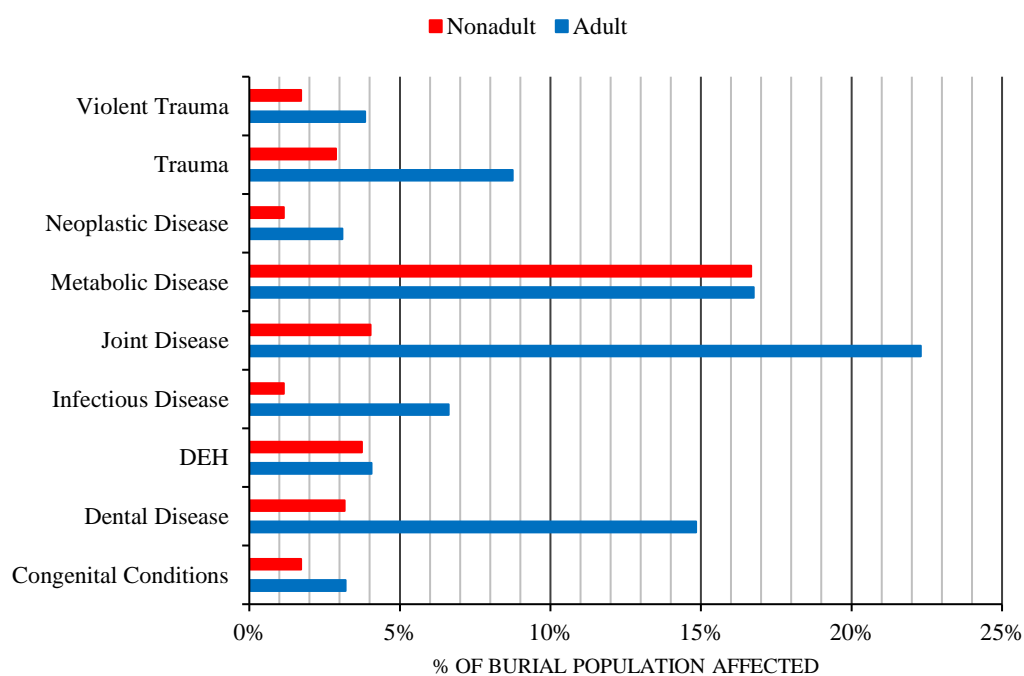


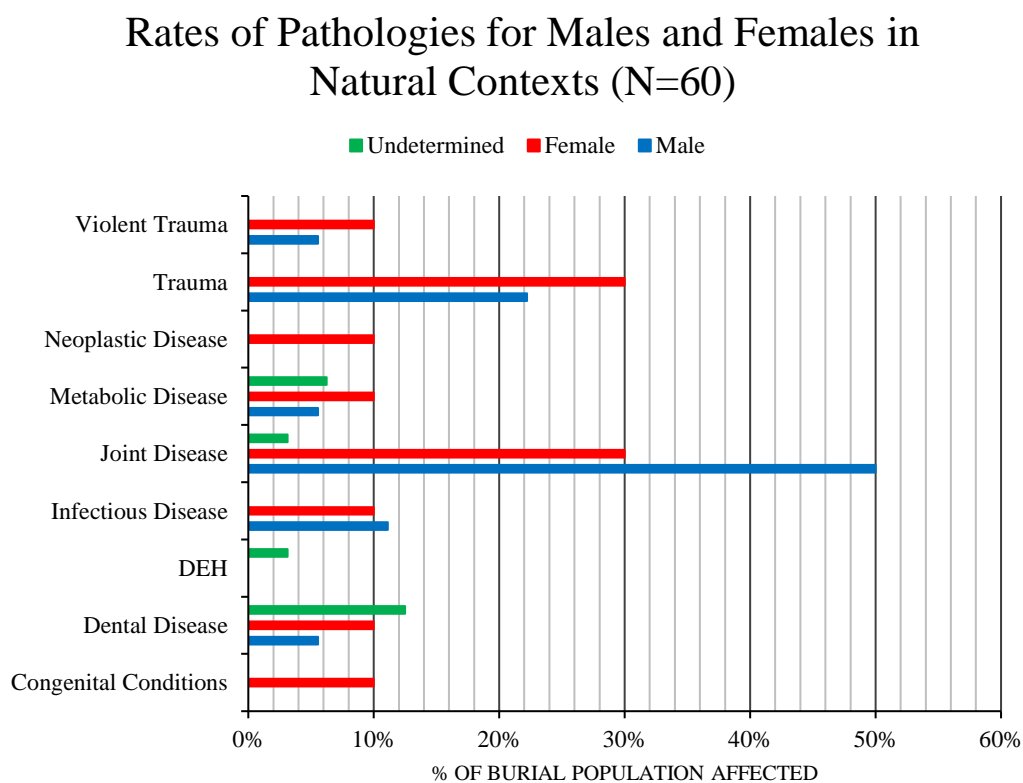
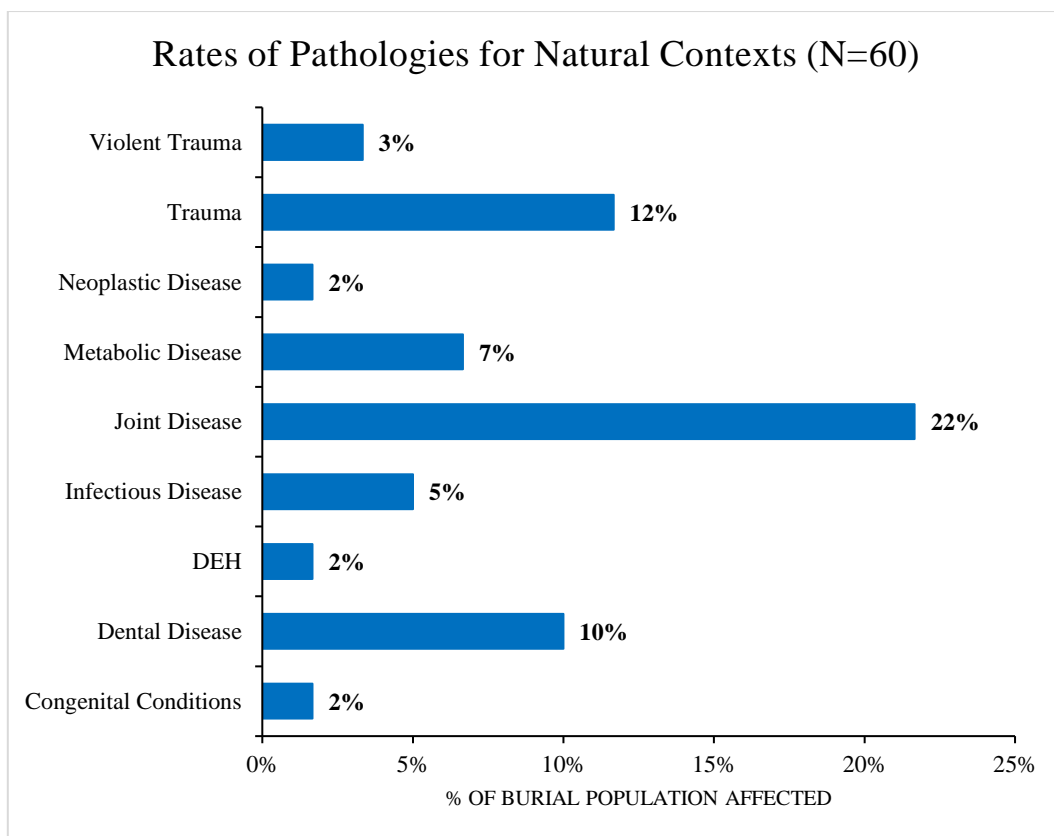


Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in Chambered Tombs (No Undetermined) (N=572)

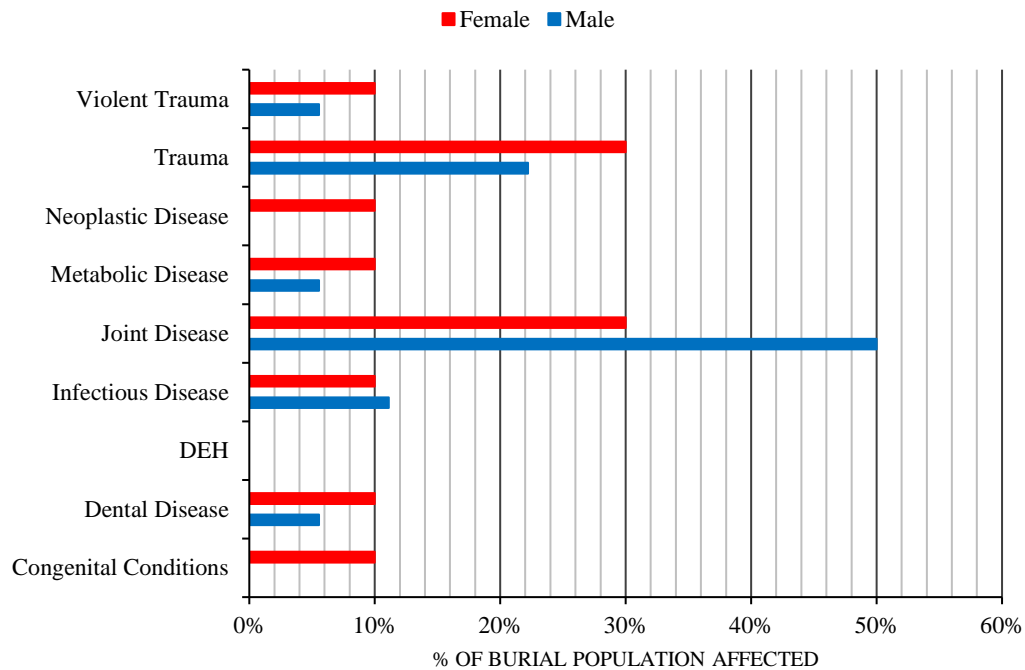


Rates of Pathologies for Adults and Nonadults in Chambered Tombs (N=1285)

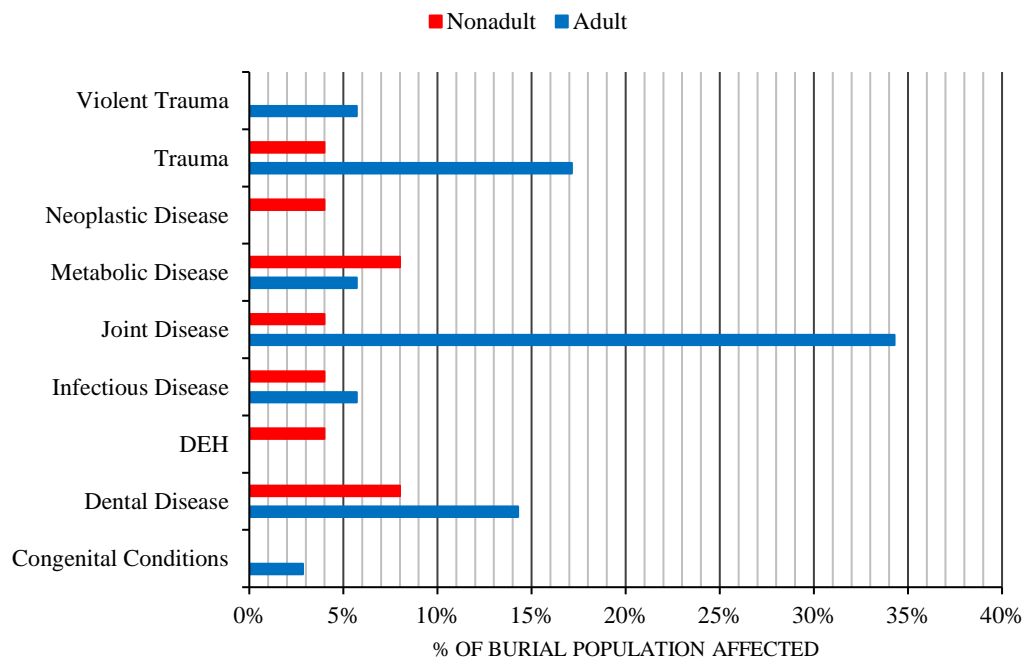




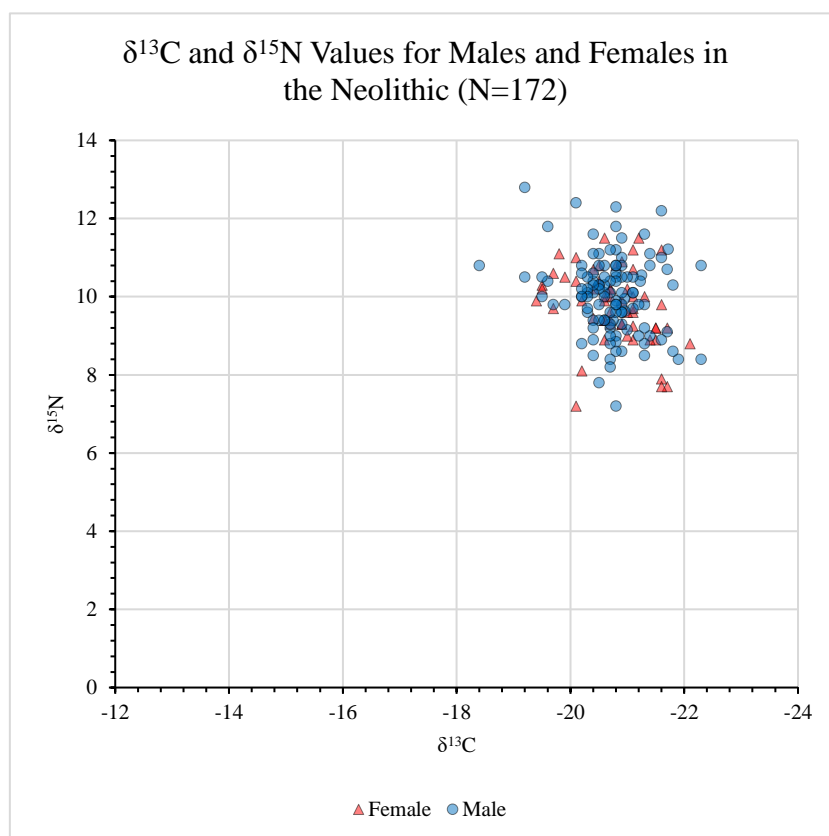
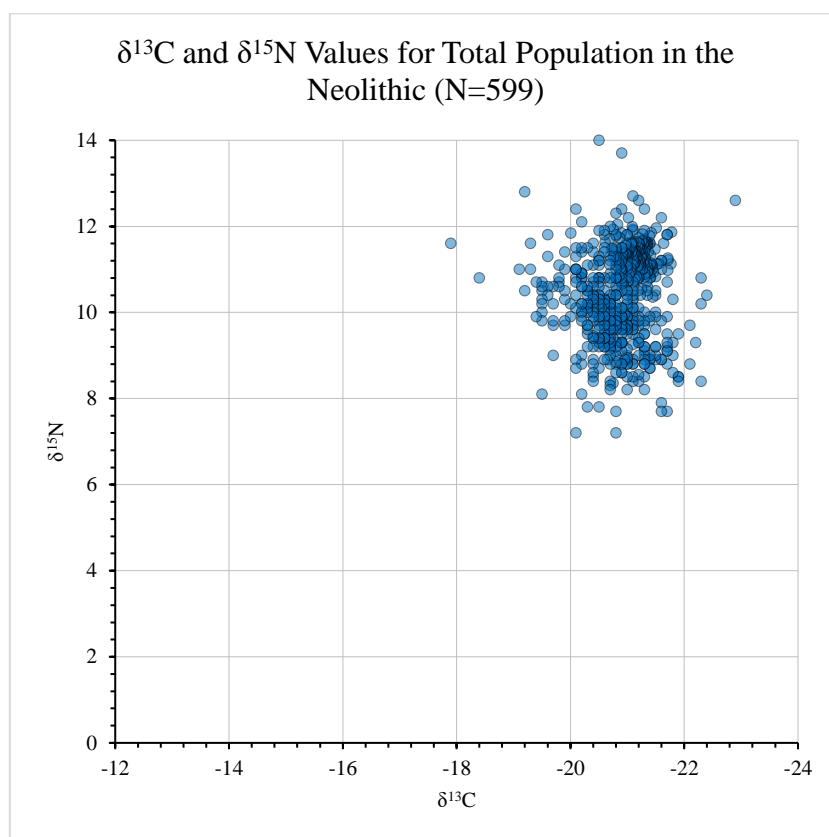
Rates of Pathologies for Males and Females in Natural Contexts (No Undetermined) (N=28)

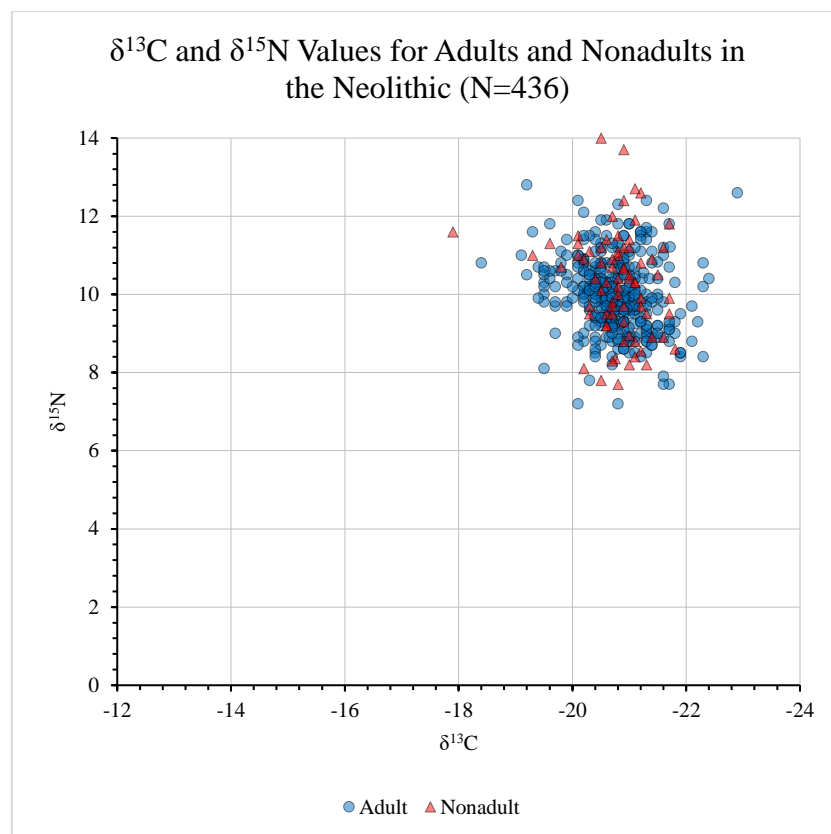


Rates of Pathologies for Adults and Nonadults in Natural Contexts (N=60)

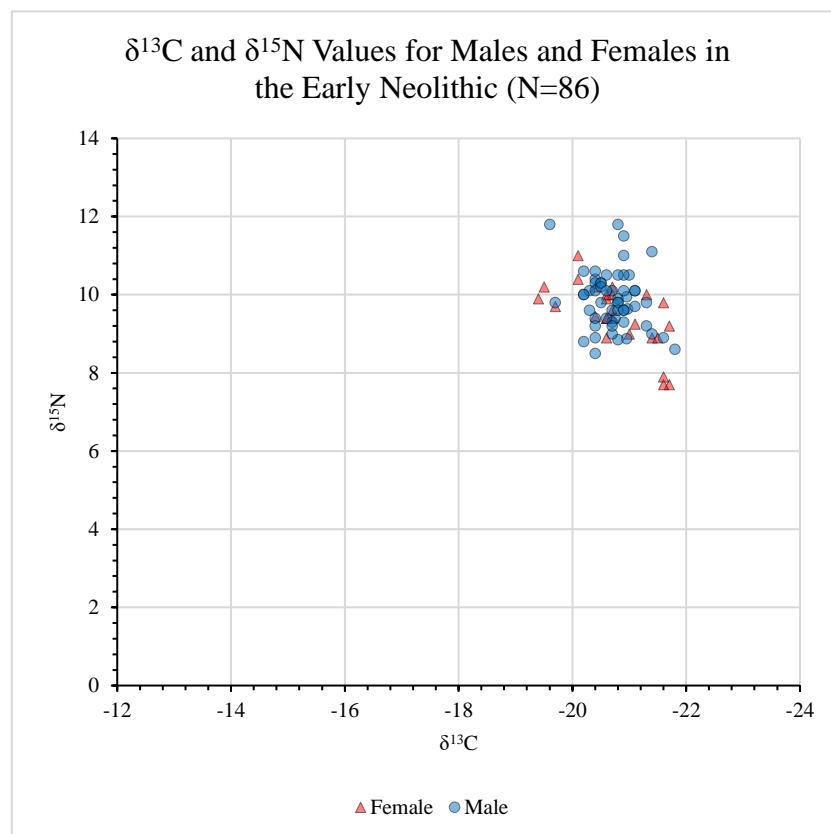
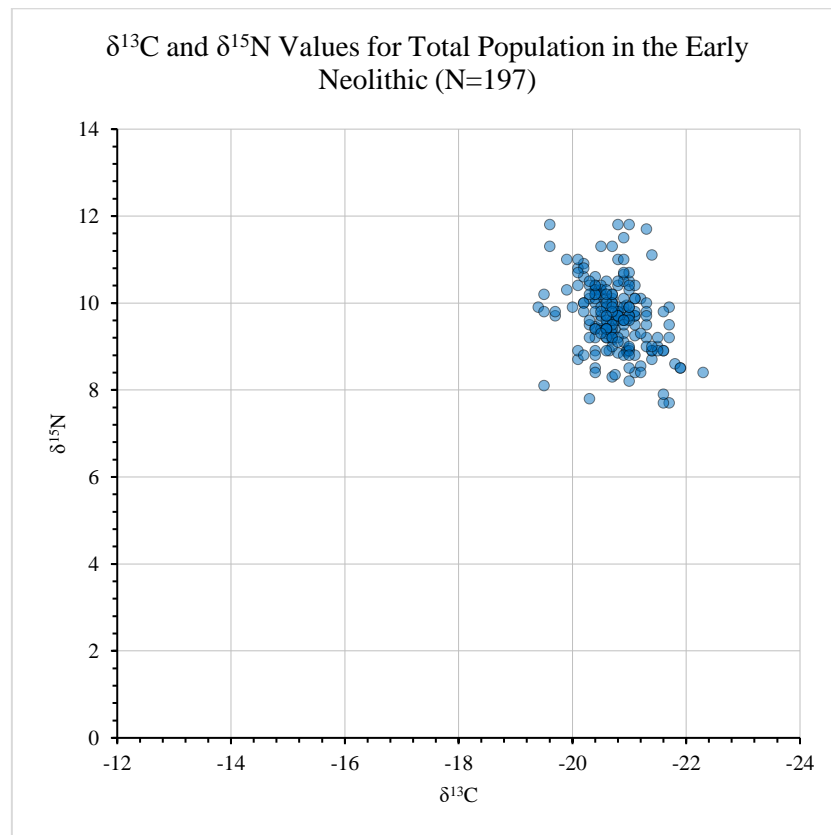


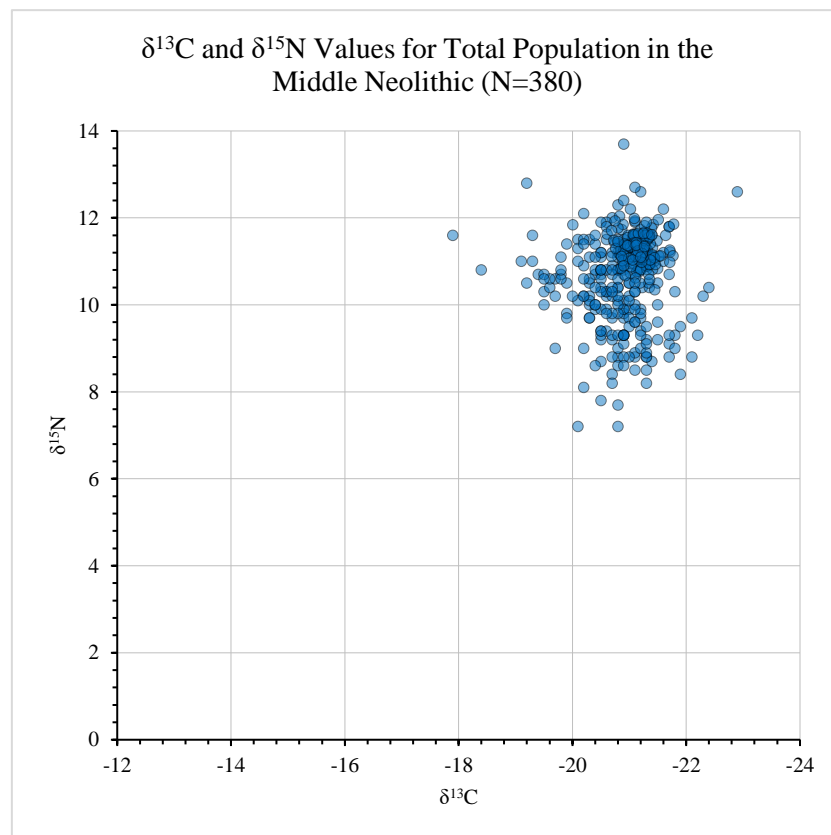
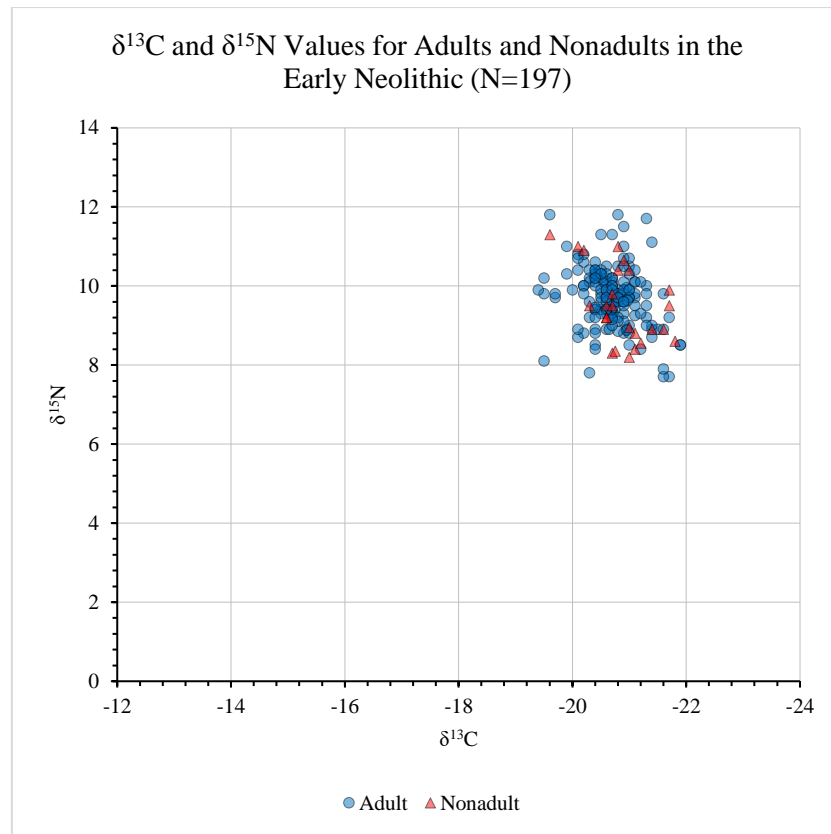

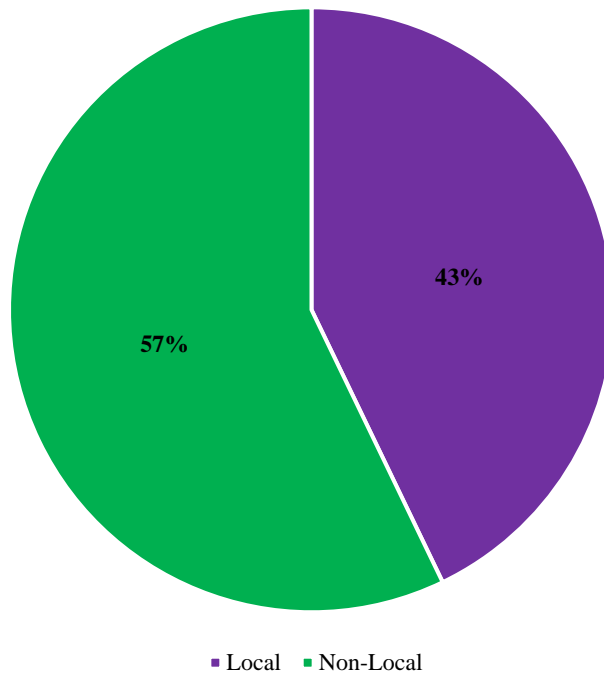
Local vs Non-Local for Males in the Neolithic

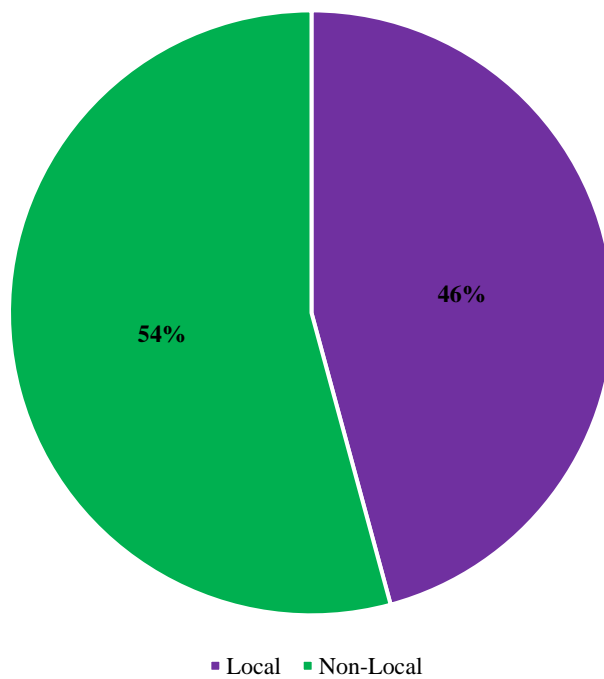
Local vs Non-Local for Females in the
Neolithic (N=9)



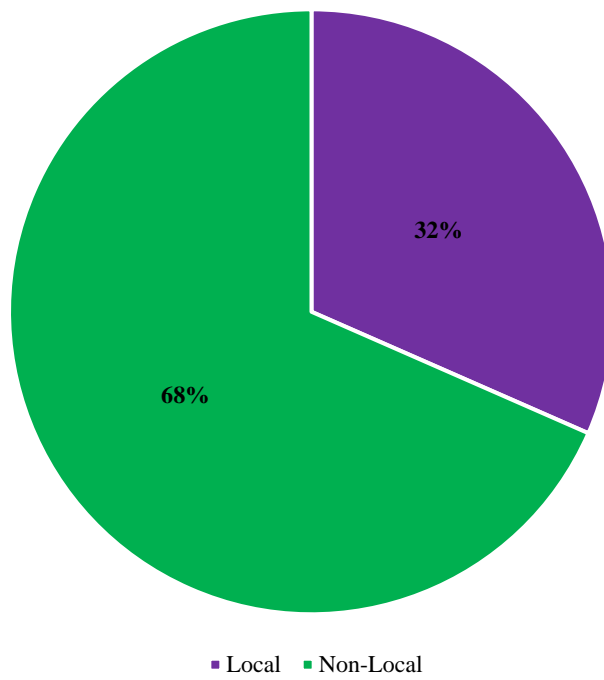

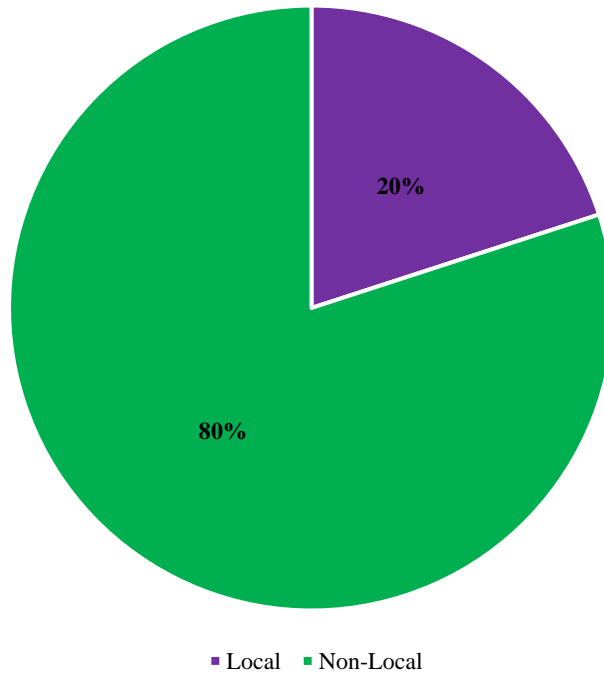


Local vs Non-Local for Nonadults in the Neolithic (N=38)

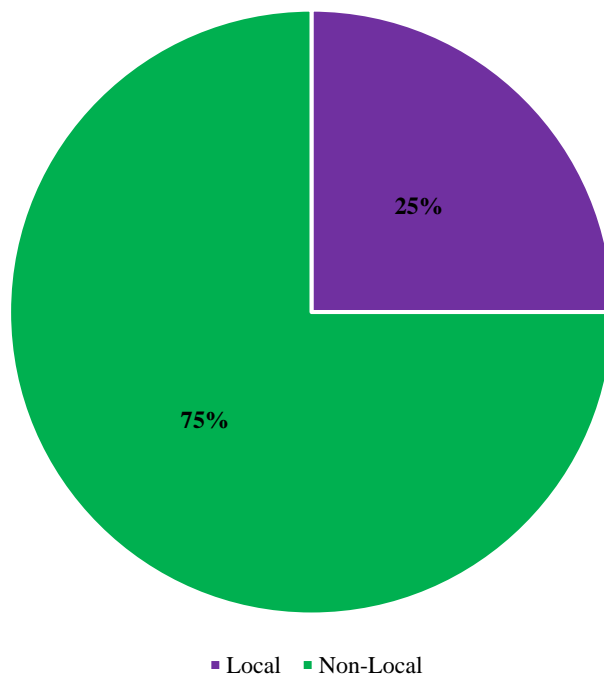

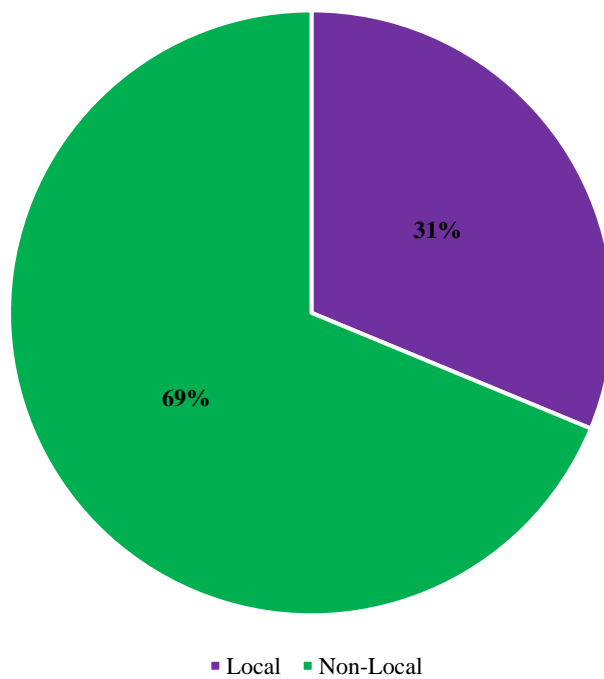

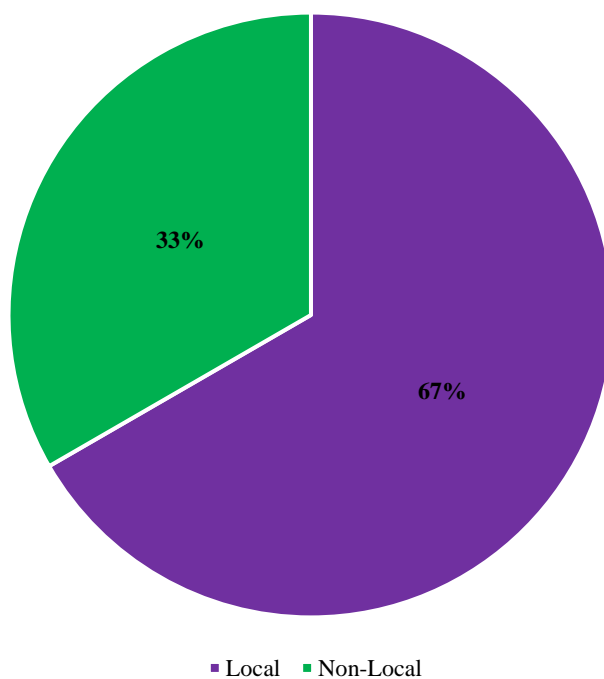


Local vs Non-Local for Nonadults in the Middle Neolithic (N=11)

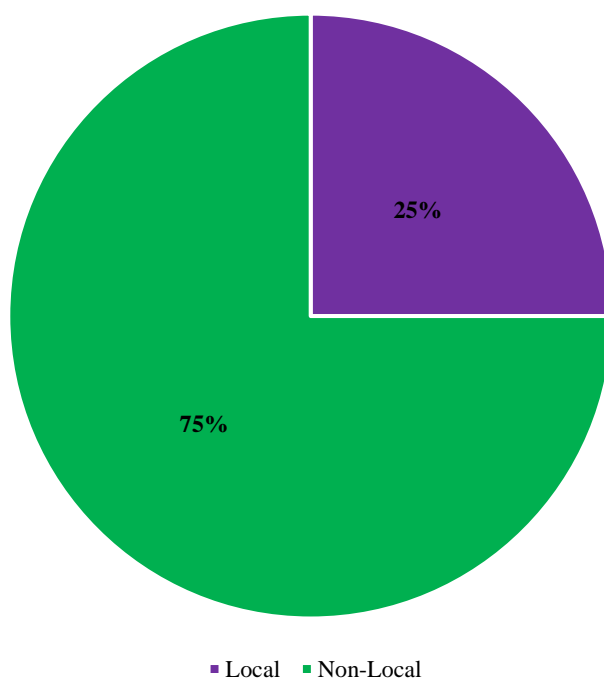

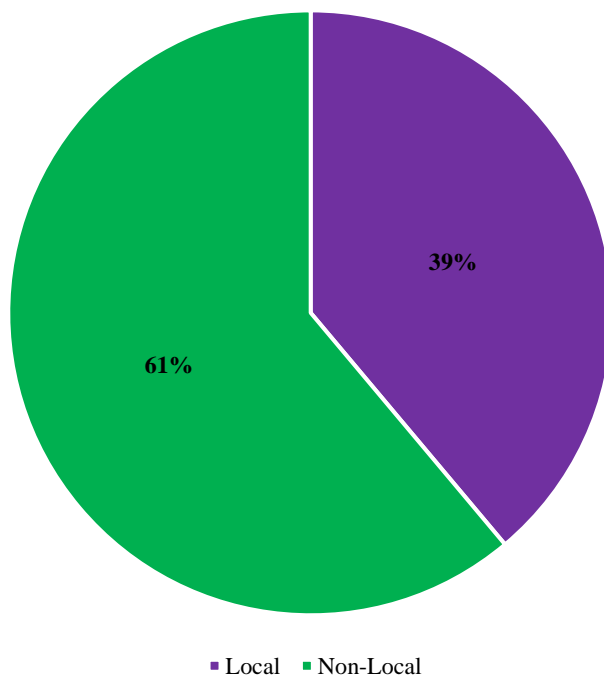
