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Peaks is an exploration into different colours and timbres available using a muted trumpet. The opening movement should be very still with lots of dynamic contrast. The second movement plays with note duration and attack, and should be played with precise articulation. The final movement is a little bi-polar in structure and the contrasts between the two sections should be exaggerated
